**THE HERTFORDSHIRE (HIGH STREET, WALTHAM CROSS)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING EXCEPT TAXIS AND LOADING) ORDER 2005**

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and Part IV of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (High Street, Waltham Cross) (Prohibition of Driving except Taxis and Loading) Order 2005" and shall come into operation on Friday 25 August 2006.
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle other than a taxi to enter, drive through, or wait in that length of High Street Service Road fronting properties 89 to 97 High Street from its junction with Regent Gate Estate Road northwards and north eastwards for 25 metres.

In this Article 'taxi' shall have the meaning as –

'a vehicle licensed by the Borough of Broxbourne Council under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or any other similar enactment'.

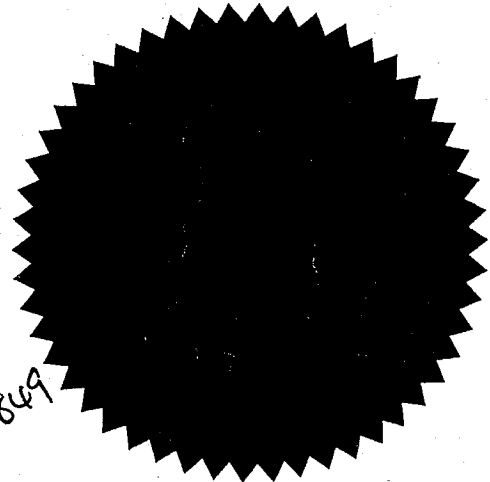
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the length of road restricted by that Article (which said length of road is referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to enter and wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area.
4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the length of road restricted by that Article (which said length of road is referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to –
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes during the course of an emergency.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
4. The Hertfordshire County Council in making this order is satisfied that this Order is required to avoid the likelihood of danger to persons using that length of road specified in Article 2 of this Order.
5. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order;

The Borough of Broxbourne (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2005

6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
