THE BURNLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2014

Burnley Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Lancashire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby makes the following Order:

General

- 1. The following Orders are hereby revoked:
 - a) "The Borough of Burnley (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2010"
 - b) "The Borough of Burnley (Thomas Street) (Off Street Parking Places)Order 2011"
 - c) "The Borough of Burnley (Woodgrove Car Park, Towneley) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012"
 - d) The Borough of Burnley (Markets Service Area) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012"

- a) Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article is a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order, and any reference in this Order to "the Schedule" is a reference to the Schedule to this Order.
- b) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them and the singular shall include the plural and vice-versa;

"Charging Hours"	the hours specified in Column 5 of the Schedule;
"Maximum Period"	the period specified in Column 6 of the Schedule;
"Market Parking Permit"	a currently valid Market Parking Permit issued by Burnley Borough Council under the provisions of Article 7;
"Market Parking Permit Holder"	the person to whom a Market Parking Permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 7;
"Contract Parking Pass"	a currently valid Contract Parking Pass issued by the Council under the provisions of Articles 5 and 6 upon payment of the Tariff;
"Contract Parking Pass Holder"	the person to whom a Contract Parking Pass has been issued under the provisions of Articles 5 and 6;
"Towneley Annual Parking Permit"	a currently valid Towneley Annual Parking Permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 6 upon payment of the Tariff;
"Towneley Annual Parking Permit Holder"	the person to whom a Towneley Annual Parking Permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 6;
"Wedding Day Permit"	a currently valid Wedding Day Permit issued by the Council to wedding guests at Towneley Hall
"Wedding Day	the person to whom a Wedding Day Permit has

Permit Holder" been issued "Bowling Club a currently valid Bowling Club Annual Permit Annual Permit" issued by the Council for Bowls Season Ticket Holders "Bowling Club the person to whom a Bowling Club Annual Permit **Annual Permit** has been issued Holder" "Bowling Club a currently valid Bowling Club Visitors Annual Visitors Annual Permit issued by the Council for visiting bowls Permit" teams "Bowling Club the person to whom a Bowling Club Visitors Annual Visitors Annual Permit has been issued Permit Holder" "Golf Club Annual a currently valid Golf Club Annual Permit issued by Permit" the Council for Golf Season Ticket Holders "Golf Club Annual the person to whom a Golf Club Annual Permit has Permit Holder" been issued "Driver" in relation to a Vehicle entering, leaving or waiting in a Parking Place, means the person who was driving the Vehicle at the time it was left in the Parking Place;

"Owner" in relation to a Vehicle means the person in whose name the Vehicle was at that time registered under

the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"Civil Enforcement

Officer"

a person duly authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any Parking Place under Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as 'the 2004 Act');

"Parking Bay"

any area of a Parking Place which has been provided for the leaving of a Vehicle and marked out as an area within the boundaries of which a Vehicle should be parked;

"Designated Parking Area" a parking area containing unmarked parking bays

"Parking Place"

any area of land or premises specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule which has been provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act for use as a Parking Place;

"Vehicle"

a Vehicle of the class or classes described in Column 3 of the Schedule;

"Parking Meter"

an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, Local Government and the Regions for the purpose of this Order being apparatus designed to indicate the time by a clock and to issue tickets indicating the payment of a charge its date and the latest time until which it allows a Vehicle to park in the Parking Place and the provisions of Section 47(5) of the 1984 Act shall apply in respect of such apparatus;

"Parking Ticket"

A currently valid ticket purchased from a Parking Meter or where the context so requires, a Contract Parking Pass, Towneley Annual Parking Permit, Wedding Day Permit, Bowling Club Annual Permit, Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit or Golf Club Annual Permit;

"Tariff"

the appropriate charge shown in the Scale of Charges listed in Column 7 of the Schedule;

"Disabled Persons' Badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Disabled Persons' Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 2000;

"Relevant Position"

- in connection with the display upon a Vehicle of a Parking Ticket, Contract Parking Pass, Towneley Annual Parking Permit, Wedding Day Permit, Bowling Club Annual Permit, Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit, Golf Club Annual Permit or Timeclock:
 - a) If the vehicle is fitted with a front windscreen the aforesaid ticket, pass or permit shall be exhibited with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of the vehicle and immediately behind the windscreen either attached to it or upon the dashboard or fascia so that the same, in its entirety, is readable from the outside of the Vehicle;
 - b) In the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen or dashboard or fascia the aforesaid ticket, pass or permit shall be

exhibited in a conspicuous position on the Vehicle and readable in its entirety;

2) in connection with the display upon the vehicle of a Disabled Persons' Badge, the position defined in Section 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) (Regulations) 2000;

"Timeclock"

A device indicating the time the driver left the Vehicle in the Parking Place

"Penalty Charge

Notice"

has the same meaning as in The Civil
Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England)

General Regulations 2007

"Horse Trailer"

a non-HGV horse box or a horse box towed by a vehicle

"Coach"

has the same meaning as for 'Public Service Vehicle' as defined in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981

"Motorcycle"

has the same meaning as in Section 136(4) of the 1984 Act

"Passenger"

a person, other than the Driver, who is conveyed to and from the Parking Place in a Vehicle

"Operational"

In relation to the Schedule to this Order means that the job role requires frequent use of a car.

"Non-Operational"

In relation to the Schedule to this Order means that the job role does not require frequent use of a

Use of Parking Place

- a) The Parking Places specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule may only be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a Parking Place for Vehicles, in such positions, on such days and during such hours, and on payment of such charges as are specified in relation to that Parking Place in the Schedule.
- b) Where, in the Schedule, the Parking Place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that Parking Place;
 - i) unless it is of the specified class; and
 - ii) in a position other than wholly within a Parking Bay or, in relation to the Parking Places specified in Column 1 of the Schedule as 'Barwise, Todmorden Road', '9-Hole Golf, Towneley', 'Pavilion, Towneley', 'Woodgrove, Towneley' and the upper area of 'Riverside, Towneley' wholly in a Designated Parking Area
- c) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay on the Parking Place specified in Column 1 of the Schedule as Finsley Gate No. 1, Finsley Gate No. 3, Finsley Gate No.4, Bank Parade, Abbey, Royle Road or Caldervale Road other than a Vehicle in which is displayed a valid Contract Parking Pass issued in respect of the same Parking Place PROVIDED ALWAYS that the said Parking Place shall be indicated to be a Contract Parking Pass only Parking Place by a sign to that effect which should be erected in a prominent position at the entrance thereof.

- d) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay on the Parking Place specified in Column 1 of the Schedule as Victoria (Town Hall) between Monday and Friday inclusive other than a Vehicle, in which is displayed a valid Contract Parking Pass issued in respect of the same Parking Place <u>PROVIDED ALWAYS</u> that the said Parking Place shall be indicated to be a Contract Parking Pass only Parking Place by a sign to that effect which should be erected in a prominent position at the entrance thereof.
- e) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay, or series of Parking Bays, marked "Reserved" other than a Vehicle in which is displayed a valid Contract Parking Pass, Towneley Annual Parking Permit, Wedding Day Permit, Bowling Club Annual Permit, Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit, Golf Club Annual Permit issued in respect of that Parking Place.
- f) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay, or series of Parking Bays, marked by a sign corresponding to that numbered 661A in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 other than a Disabled Persons' Vehicle displaying a current Disabled Persons' Badge issued in respect of the Driver of, or a Passenger in the said Vehicle and in which said Vehicle is displayed a Timeclock indicating the time of arrival in the Parking Bay.
- g) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay marked as being a Parking Bay for coaches or horse trailers only on the Parking Place specified in Column 1 of the Schedule as the Riverside, Towneley Car Park other than a Coach or Horse Trailer.
- h) No Vehicle shall be left in a Parking Bay marked by a sign corresponding to that numbered 801 and 804.4 in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and marked 'SOLO MOTORCYCLES ONLY' other than a Motorcycle

- i) The period for which a Vehicle may be left in a Parking Place shall not exceed thirteen consecutive hours in any one period of twenty-four hours and the Driver of the Vehicle shall not leave it in any Parking Place for any longer period.
- j) The period for which a Vehicle may be left in a Parking Place specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule as Towneley Hall; Riverside, Towneley; Barwise, Todmorden Road; Causeway End (18-Hole Golf, Towneley); 9-Hole Golf, Towneley and Pavilion, Towneley shall not exceed fourteen consecutive hours in any one period of twenty-four hours and the Driver of the Vehicle shall not leave it in any Parking Place for any longer period.
- k) The period for which a Vehicle may be left in a Parking Place specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule as Abbey shall not exceed thirteen consecutive hours in any one period of twenty-four hours in the hatched area shown on the Plan attached to this Order or one hour (no return within one hour) on the cross-hatched area shown on the Plan attached to this Order and the Driver of the Vehicle shall not leave it in any Parking Place for any longer period.

Charging at Parking Places

Pay and Display Only Parking Places

- 4.
- a) This Article applies to the Parking Places specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule as Cow Lane No.1, Cow Lane No.2, Parker Lane, Sutcliffe Street, Standish Street, Grimshaw Street, Elizabeth Street, Thomas Street, Orchard Bridge, Pioneer No.1 and Victoria (Saturdays only).
- b) The Driver of a Vehicle left in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours shall pay the relevant Tariff.

- c) The Tariff for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours shall be that specified in Column 7 of the Schedule.
- d) The Parking Ticket issued on payment of the Tariff referred to in subparagraph c) shall be exhibited on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place so that the Tariff paid and the date and time that the Tariff was paid shown on the front of the Parking Ticket are clearly visible.
- e) The Tariff referred to in subparagraph c) of this Article shall be paid on the leaving of the said Vehicle in a Parking Place by the insertion in a Parking Meter of a coin or coins of appropriate value as per the Tariff.
- f) A Vehicle shall not be left in a Parking Place after the expiry of the period of validity of a Parking Ticket exhibited thereon.
- g) Nothing in this Article shall apply to Vehicles of the Emergency Services while in use for such purposes

Contract only Parking Places

- a) This Article applies to the Parking Places specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule as Abbey, Victoria (Monday to Friday only), Finsley Gate No.1, Finsley Gate No.3, Finsley Gate No.4, Bank Parade, Caledonia Mill, Royle Road and Caldervale Road.
- b) Subject to availability, the Owner of a Vehicle may, on application to the Council, purchase a Contract Parking Pass in respect of that Vehicle on payment of the Tariff and that Contract Parking Pass shall be valid in such Parking Places and for such days of the week as are specified thereon during the period for which it was issued.

- c) The Tariff for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours shall be that specified in Column 7 of the Schedule.
- d) The Contract Parking Pass issued on payment of the Tariff referred to in subparagraph c) shall be exhibited on the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- e) A Vehicle shall not be left in a Parking Place after the expiry of the period of validity of a Contract Parking Pass exhibited thereon
- f) Nothing in this Article shall apply to Vehicles of the Emergency Services while in use for such purposes

Part Contract, Part Pay & Display Parking Places

- a) Subparagraphs a) to e) of this Article apply to the Parking Places specified by name in Column 1 of the Schedule as Centenary Way, Finsley Gate No.2, King Street, Pioneer No.2 and William Thompson.
- b) Article 4 subparagraphs b) to g) of this Order shall apply to the Parking Places specified in subparagraph a) to this Article as they apply to the Parking Places in Article 4 subparagraph a).
- c) Subject to availability, the Owner of a Vehicle may, on application to the Council, purchase a Contract Parking Pass in respect of that Vehicle on payment of the Tariff and that Contract Parking Pass shall be valid in such Parking Places and for such days of the week as are specified thereon during the period for which it was issued.
- d) The Tariff for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place during the Charging Hours shall be that specified in Column 7 of the Schedule.

- e) The Driver of a Vehicle left in any of the Parking Places referred to in subparagraph a) of this Article shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Contract Parking Pass Holder and the said Pass is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- f) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as

 Towneley Hall in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be
 exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where
 he/she is a valid Towneley Annual Parking Permit Holder, Wedding
 Day Permit Holder or Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit Holder for
 that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is
 displayed in the Vehicle In the Relevant Position for the entire period
 that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- g) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as Riverside, Towneley in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Towneley Annual Parking Permit Holder or Bowling Club Annual Permit Holder for that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- h) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as Barwise, Todmorden Road in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Towneley Annual Parking Permit Holder or Bowling Club Annual Permit Holder for that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle In the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place

- i) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as Causeway End (18-Hole Golf, Towneley) in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Golf Club Annual Permit holder for that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place
- j) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as Causeway End (18-Hole Golf, Towneley) in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a customer of the Golf Shop and is parked in a Parking Bay marked for golf shop customers for a time not exceeding 20 minutes.
- k) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as 9-Hole Golf, Towneley in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Golf Club Annual Permit Holder for that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- I) The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as Woodgrove, Towneley in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall be exempt from obtaining a Parking Ticket from the Parking Meter where he/she is a valid Towneley Annual Permit Holder for that Parking Place in respect of that Vehicle and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.
- m) A Vehicle shall not be left in any of the Parking Places referred to in subparagraphs a), f), g), h) i) k) or l) after the expiry of the period of validity of a Parking Ticket, Contract Parking Pass, Towneley Annual

Parking Permit, Wedding Day Permit, Bowling Club Annual Permit, Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit, Golf Club Annual Permit exhibited thereon.

n) Nothing in this Article shall apply to Vehicles of the Emergency Services while in use for such purposes.

Market Service Area

7. The Driver of a Vehicle left in the Parking Place referred to as the Markets Service Area in Column 1 of the Schedule of this Order shall not leave the Vehicle in the said Parking Place unless express permission is given from Burnley Borough Council by way of the issue of a Market Parking Permit and the said Permit is displayed in the Vehicle in the Relevant Position for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place.

The Driver of the Vehicle shall be exempt from obtaining a Market Parking Permit where he/she is delivering stock to the Market or Charter Walk shops, in which case the Driver shall leave the Vehicle in the said parking Place for a period not exceeding twenty minutes.

General Management of the Parking Places

- 8.
- a) A Vehicle remaining in a Parking Place shall be at the Owner's or Driver's risk and the Council shall not be liable for loss or damage to the Vehicle or its contents howsoever such loss or damage may arise other than loss or damage occasioned by the act, default, omission or neglect of the Council or its servant or agents.
- b) In a Parking Place the Driver of a Vehicle shall comply with any instructions which may be given by a Civil Enforcement Officer or which may be contained on any Parking Ticket which the Driver may obtain in accordance with the provisions of this Order and in particular

he/she shall remove the Vehicle from the Parking Place on being asked to do so.

- c) Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
 - a. indicating the entrance to or exit from the Parking Place, or
 - b. indicating that a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

no person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any Vehicle:

- a) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated, or
- b) in a direction other than that specified, as the case may be.
- The Owner or Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit it to remain in a
 Parking Place for longer than the Maximum Period specified in Column
 6 of the Schedule.
- 10. The Driver of a Vehicle which is using a Parking Place shall stop the engine of the Vehicle as soon as it has taken up its position in a Parking Bay in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- 11. Whilst a Vehicle is in a Parking Place no person shall use it in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or hiring of his skills or services unless such selling of articles or selling or hiring of skills and services has been authorised by the Council's Markets Services and the Council's Streetscene Unit.

- 12. No person shall use a Parking Place in connection with the sale of any Vehicle remaining therein nor for the dismantling of a Vehicle nor for the purpose of effecting repairs to a Vehicle other than such repairs as may be necessary to enable the Vehicle to leave the Parking Place.
- 13. The Driver of a Vehicle shall not permit that Vehicle either to enter or wait in the Parking Place unless the Vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971, and unless there is, in relation to the use of the Vehicle by the Driver, such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- 14. The Driver of a Vehicle using the Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument, except in an emergency or when about to change the position of the Vehicle in or to depart from the Parking Place.
- 15. No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any Vehicle in the Parking Place for any purpose, other than the purpose of leaving that Vehicle in the Parking Place, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.
- 16. No person shall, in the Parking Place, wantonly shout or otherwise make any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or occupiers of premises in the neighbourhood.
- 17. No person shall, in the Parking Place, use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
- 18. In the Parking Place, no person shall:

- a. erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand,
 building or other structure without the consent of the Council's
 Markets Services and the Council's Streetscene Unit; or
- b. light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.
- 19. No person shall, in the Parking Place, either encourage other persons to, or themselves take part in, any recreational activity without the written consent of the Council.

Removal of Vehicle from Parking Place

- a. If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in a position other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 3, a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the Vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions.
- b. If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the Vehicle from that Parking Place or arrange for such removal.
- c. For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised on behalf of the Council in that behalf or a Police Constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a Vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a Vehicle from the Parking Place.
- d. Any person altering, or causing the alteration of the position of a Vehicle by virtue of subparagraph a) of this Article, or removing or causing the removal of a Vehicle, by virtue of subparagraphs
 b) or c) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the Vehicle

or in such other manner as he may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the Vehicle to be altered or the Vehicle to be removed.

- e. Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a Vehicle by virtue of subparagraphs b) and c) of this Article shall make such arrangements as he/she considers necessary for the safety of the Vehicle in the place to which it is removed.
- f. When a Vehicle has been removed or its position altered, by virtue of any provision of this Article the Council may recover the expenses reasonably incurred in doing so from the Owner of the Vehicle.

Contravention of this Order

21. If a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention, of or non-compliance with, any Article in this Order, Part 6 of the 2004 Act shall apply.

Presumptions in Legal Proceedings

- a. Payment of the relevant Tariff for a Vehicle left in a Parking Place in accordance with Articles 4, 5 or 6 of this Order shall be indicated either:
 - i. by the display of a Parking Ticket in the Relevant Position (for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place) indicating that the Tariff has been paid in respect of the period for which it was paid, the date of the payment of the Tariff and the time until which permission to leave the Vehicle in the Parking Place has been given as a result of the payment of the Tariff; or

ii. by the display in the Relevant Position (for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place) of a valid Contract Parking Pass, Market Parking Permit, Towneley Annual Parking Permit, Wedding Day Permit, Bowling Club Annual Permit, Bowling Club Visitors Annual Permit, Golf Club Annual Permit in respect of that Parking Place.

Exemption for Disabled Persons Vehicles

23. A Vehicle which displays, in the Relevant Position, for the entire period that the Vehicle remains in the Parking Place, a valid Disabled Persons' Badge and Timeclock issued in respect of the Driver of, or Passenger in the said Vehicle, and parks the said Vehicle in any Parking Bay in any Parking Place shall be exempt from any payment specified in Article 4 or 6 of this Order PROVIDED that the Vehicle remains within the Parking Place for a period not exceeding three hours.

Interference with a Parking Meter

24. No person shall interfere with a Parking Meter or operate or attempt to operate it by the insertion of objects other than current coins of the appropriate denomination.

Revocation

- 25. Nothing in this Order shall affect the following Orders, which are hereby revoked, in their relation to contraventions thereunder before the commencement of this Order:
 - a) The Borough of Burnley (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2010"
 - b) "The Borough of Burnley (Thomas Street) (Off Street Parking Places)
 Order 2011"

- c) "The Borough of Burnley (Woodgrove Car Park, Towneley) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012"
- d) The Borough of Burnley (Markets Service Area) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2012"


