CAERPHILLY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2019

Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act as amended by the Parking Act 1989, the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1 GENERAL

- 1. This order shall come into operation on 8th day of April 2019 and may be cited as the Caerphilly County Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019.
- 2. In this Order:-
 - 'The 2013 Regulations' means Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (General Provisions) Wales Regulations 2013;
 - 'Authorised officer' means an officer of the council so authorised by the Head of Infrastructure;
 - 'Bus' has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;
 - 'Charge Certificate' means the statement that the penalty charge has been increased by 50 per cent in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Penalty Charge Notices, Enforcement and Adjudication) Wales Regulations 2008 ("the 2008 Regulations") or by any other enactment;
 - 'Civil Enforcement Officer' means person authorised by the Council to supervise and enforce the provisions of this Order;
 - 'The Council' shall mean the Caerphilly County Borough Council and shall include its employees, agents and partners;
 - 'Country Parks Permit' means any ticket issued by The Council to a specific vehicle to be valid for a period of one year or six months from the date of issue in the car parks specified as Country Parks Car Parks in Schedule 1 of this Order;
 - 'Disabled Persons Badge' means a badge of a description prescribed by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000 or as amended;
 - 'Disabled Persons Vehicle' means a vehicle being used for the carriage of a holder of a Disabled Persons Badge where the Disabled Persons Badge is clearly displayed within the vehicle;
 - 'Driver' means the person who is responsible for the control of a vehicle at the time when a breach of any of the Articles occurs;
 - 'Owner' in relation to a vehicle which is required to be licensed under the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 means the person in whose name the vehicle was registered under that Act on the date on which the vehicle was left in contravention of this Order;
 - 'Parking' means any vehicle which is stationary in a Parking Place for any period of time. 'Park' and 'parked' shall have the same meaning;
 - 'Parking Bay' means any area of a Parking Place which is provided for the parking of a vehicle as indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;
 - 'Parking Place' means those areas of land identified on the plan attached to this order as car park;

'Passenger Vehicle' means a motor vehicle constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted not to carry more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer;

'Penalty Charge' means a penalty charge relating to a parking contravention in pursuant to the 2004 Act:

'Penalty Charge Notice' or 'PCN' means a Penalty Charge notice issued or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer posted by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to the 2004 Act and in accordance with the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Guidelines on levels of charges) (Wales) Order 2013;

'Scale of Charges' means the scale of charges set out in Schedule 1 of this Order

'Season Ticket' shall include any ticket issued by The Council covering a period of one year from the date of issue or quarterly covering a period of 3 months from the date of issue;

'The Regulations' means the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

'Weekly ticket' means any ticket covering a period of 7 consecutive days from the date of issue

PART II USE OF LAND AND PARKING PLACE

- 3. (1) Each area of land identified as pay and display parking in the plans attached to this order may be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order as a Parking Place for such classes of vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in Schedule 1 and in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.
 - (2) Where in the plan a Parking Place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the Driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to remain in that Parking Place unless it is of the class and in the position so specified.
 - (3) Where within a Parking Place there are markings indicating Parking Bays the Driver of a vehicle using the Parking Place shall not permit the vehicle to be parked otherwise than wholly within a Parking Bay.
 - (4) Where, within a Parking Place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a Parking Bay is: -
 - (a) Available only for a Disabled Person's Vehicle,
 - (b) Available only for a motor cycle or a Bus or
 - (c) A reserved bay and not available for use by members of the general public,

the Driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to remain in that Parking Bay unless it is the specified type of vehicle or as the case may be a vehicle authorised by The Council to Park in a reserved bay.

- (5) The conditions for use of all Parking Places shall apply to each and every Parking Place for all periods of every day inclusive of bank holidays irrespective of whether there is a charge in force at any time for parking in the Parking Place.
- 4. (1) The Driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall on parking the vehicle in the Parking Place pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the Scale of Charges. No charge shall be payable if the vehicle displays a valid weekly ticket, season ticket or Country Parks Permit issued in respect of that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph (3) of this Article or, if that vehicle is parked in a Parking Place during those times when no charge is payable as provided in Schedule 1.

- (2) The charge referred to in Paragraph (1) of this Article 4 shall be payable by:
 - (a) the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the apparatus or device provided being an apparatus of device approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Act and known as 'Pay and Display machine' or
 - (b) Paying an Authorised Officer of The Council.
- (3) The Owner of a vehicle may on application to The Council purchase a Season Ticket in respect of that vehicle for a charge ascertained by reference to the said Scale of Charges and that Season Ticket shall be valid in the Parking Place as specified thereon during the period for which it is issued.
- (4) The Owner of a vehicle may on application to The Council purchase a Country Parks Permit in respect of that vehicle for a charge ascertained by reference to the said Scale of Charges and that Country Parks Permit shall be valid in all Parking Places listed as Country Parks Car Parks in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- (5) Any ticket issued upon the payment of the charge ascertained by reference to the said Scale of Charges or Season Ticket or Country Parks Permit issued in accordance with Paragraph (3) and (4) of this Article shall be placed in a conspicuous position visible through the windscreen of the vehicle in respect of which it was issued or purchased but in the case of motorcycles and motorcycle combinations only may be left in a designated receptacle where such receptacle is provided by The Council for such purpose.
- (6) A vehicle shall not remain in a Parking Place if it displays a ticket, Weekly Ticket, Season Ticket or Country Parks Permit which has expired.
- (7) No person shall transfer any ticket issued in accordance with the provisions in this Article from the vehicle in respect of which the ticket has been issued to any other vehicle.
- (8) Any ticket issued will only be valid for the Parking Place indicated thereon. Tickets, Weekly Tickets and Season Tickets are not transferable between Parking Places.
- 5. The Driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to remain in a Parking Place unless the vehicle is licensed in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of the Vehicles (Excise and Registration) Act 1994 and unless there is in force in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- J. The Driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the Parking Place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in, or depart from, the Parking Place.
- 7. (1) No person shall use any part of a Parking Place or any vehicle left in a Parking Place:-
 - (a) for sleeping, camping eating, cooking or drinking
 - (b) for the purpose of repairing, maintaining, servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the Parking Place
 - (c) for the playing of ball games or
 - (d) For skating, sliding or rolling on rollers, skateboards, wheels, mechanical contrivances or other equipment.
 - (2) No person shall remain in a Parking Place other than for the purpose of parking a vehicle, removing a vehicle or waiting with the vehicle for a reasonable time unless with the express permission of an Authorised Officer or a Police Constable or Police Community support Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform

- 8. (1) The driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument or cause to be made any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the Parking Place or occupiers of premises in the neighbourhood except when such a disturbance is reasonable.
 - (2) The Driver of a vehicle using a Parking Place shall not cause or permit any musical instrument, radio, disc player or cassette player or similar apparatus to be played whilst the vehicle is in the Parking Place.
 - (3) No person shall act in a noisy, disruptive or disorderly manner in a Parking Place and any person requested to do so by a Police Officer or Police Community Support Officer or a Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform shall leave the Parking Place forthwith.
- 9. (1) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised by The Council in that behalf or a Police Constable or Police Community Support Officer or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a Parking Place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a Parking Place.
 - (2) In exercising its powers in Article 9 (1) or Article 19 The Council may recover from the Driver of the vehicle any reasonable costs and expenses which are incurred by The Council or its authorised agents.
- 10. Where in a Parking Place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-
 - (1) indicating the entrance to or exit from a Parking Place
 - (2) indicating that a vehicle using a Parking Place shall proceed in a specified direction within the Parking Place

No person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:-

- (1) so that it enters the Parking Place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the Parking Place otherwise than by an exit so indicated,
- (2) in a direction other than so specified
- 11. (1) No person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by The Council on that behalf drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a Parking Place for any purpose other than for the purpose of Parking that vehicle in the Parking Place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the Parking Place.
 - (2) No person shall drive in a Parking Place in a reckless or dangerous manner.
- 12. In a Parking Place no person shall:-
 - (1) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of The Council,
 - (2) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire,
 - (3) use a vehicle while it is in a Parking Place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills and services without the written consent of The Council
 - (4) use any vehicle for the purpose of storing goods or materials with a view to selling or delivering such articles to persons in or near to the Parking Place,
 - (5) deposit or cause to be deposited any advertising handbills, leaflets or circulars on any vehicle in a Parking Place, and without prejudice to the generality of this Article a person shall be deemed to be causing an advertisement, handbill, leaflet or circular to be deposited if his goods, trade,

business or other concerns are being given publicity by the advertisement, handbill, leaflet or circular unless he can prove that it was deposited without his consent or

- (6) Use a vehicle as a dwelling or for any domestic or sanitary purpose.
- 13. No person shall use a Parking Place or any Parking Bay within a Parking Place when The Council has closed that Parking Bay or Parking Place except with the written consent of The Council.
- 14. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to be Parked in an area where 'No Parking' signs are erected or marked out on the ground in words or by yellow markings.
- 15. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to be Parked so unreasonably as to obstruct and/or as to prevent access to any other Parking Place, Parking Bay or any premises adjoining the Parking Place or so as to become a nuisance to any other user of the Parking Place.
- 16. (1) No person shall abandon a vehicle within a Parking Place.
 - (2) For the purposes of Paragraph (1) of this Article a person who leaves a vehicle within a Parking Place in such circumstances or for such a period that he may reasonably be assumed to have abandoned it shall be deemed to have abandoned it there unless a contrary intention is shown.
- 17. Where a Parking Place named in Schedule 1 is subject to a limited waiting restriction, no Driver shall permit their vehicle to remain in the Parking Place for longer than the maximum period identified in Schedule 1.
- 18. Where a Parking Place named in Schedule 1 has a restriction prohibiting a return to that Parking Place within a specified time period the Driver of a vehicle shall not permit their vehicle to return to that Parking Place within that time period.

PART III ENFORCEMENT

- 19. (1) If any vehicle is left in contravention of the provisions of this Order, a Penalty Charge shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed from its location
 - (2) Where in this Order reference is made to a Penalty Charge this shall mean an amount ascertained in accordance with the following:
 - a) If there is any contravention of any of the provisions of this Order in any such case a Penalty Charge at the level of Band 2 as set out in Regulation 1 of the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (Wales) Order 2013 shall be payable;
 - b) The Penalty Charge shall be paid in accordance with this Article not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the notice was served;
 - c) In event of payment being received in accordance with this Article not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the day on which the notice is served the amount of the charge shall be reduced by 50 per cent;
 - d) The Penalty Charge shall increase by 50 per cent on the issue of a Charge Certificate in accordance with Regulation 1 of the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (Wales) Order 2013 Regulations;
 - e) The Payment of the Penalty Charge (whether or not reduced under the provisions of Article 19(2)(c)) will not exonerate any person from payment of any expenses incurred and recoverable in respect of the removal and disposal of the vehicle and any statutory provisions for the time being in force or from any claim for damages which The Council may have in respect of damage incurred in relation to the Parking of the Vehicle howsoever arising;

- f) The current Penalty Charge rates shall be displayed on the Council's website.
- (3) In the case of the Vehicle in respect of which a Penalty Charge may have been incurred it shall be the duty of the Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Penalty Charge Notice which shall include the following particulars:
 - a. The date on which the Penalty Charge Notice is served;
 - b. The name of the enforcement authority;
 - c. The registration mark of the vehicle involved in the alleged contravention;
 - d. The date and time at which the alleged contravention occurred;
 - e. The grounds on which the Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform issuing the Penalty Charge Notice believes that a Penalty Charge is payable;
 - f. The amount of the Penalty Charge;
 - g. That the Penalty Charge must be paid before the end of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served:
 - h. That if the Penalty Charge is paid before the end of the 14 days beginning with the date on which the notice is served, the Penalty Charge will be reduced by the amount of any applicable discount;
 - i. The manner in which the Penalty Charge must be paid;
 - j. That if the Penalty Charge is not paid before the end of the period of 28 days referred to in subparagraph (g), a Notice to Owner may be served by the enforcement authority on the Owner of the vehicle;
 - k. That, if representations against the Penalty Charge are received at such address as may be specified for the purpose before a Notice to Owner is served:
 - i. those representations will be considered;
 - ii. But that, if a Notice to Owner is served notwithstanding those representations, representations against the Penalty Charge must be made in the form and manner and at the time specified in the Notice to Owner.
 - I. That a person on whom a Notice to Owner is served will be entitled to an adjudicator if those representations are rejected.
- (4) Where a Penalty Charge Notice is served by post it shall include the following particulars:
 - a. The date of the notice;
 - b. The matters specified in Article 19(3) b), c), d), f), i) and l);
 - c. The grounds on which the enforcement authority believes that a Penalty Charge is payable;
 - d. That the Penalty Charge must be paid not later than a specified date which must be the last day of the period of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the Penalty Charge Notice will be taken to have been served:
 - e. That if the Penalty Charge is paid before the end of the applicable period, the Penalty Charge will be reduced by the amount of any applicable discount;
 - f. That if after the date specified in accordance with subparagraph (d)


- i. No representations have been made in accordance with regulation 4 of the Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Representations and Appeals) Wales Regulations 2013; and
- ii. The Penalty Charge has not been paid; The enforcement authority may increase the Penalty Charge by the amount of any applicable surcharge and take steps to enforce payment of the charge as so increased; and
- g. That the Penalty Charge Notice is being served by post for whatever of the following reasons applies:
 - i. That the Penalty Charge Notice is being served by post on the basis of a record produced by an approved device;
 - ii. That it is being so served, because a Civil Enforcement Officer attempted to serve a Penalty Charge Notice by affixing to a vehicle or giving it to the person in charge of the vehicle but was prevented from doing so by some person; or
- h. That is being so served because a Civil Enforcement Officer had begun to prepare a Penalty Charge Notice in accordance with Regulation 5 of the 2008 Regulations, but the vehicle was driven away from the place in which it was stationary before the Civil Enforcement Officer had finished preparing the Penalty Charge Notice or had served it in accordance with the regulation 5 of the 2008 Regulations.
- (5) The Penalty Charge may be paid to the South Wales Parking Group (S.W.P.G) by cheque, online payment, money or postal order. Payment may also be made by debit or credit card via the telephone. All payment instructions can be found on the back of the Penalty Charge Notice.
- (6) When a Penalty Charge Notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the Driver or a person authorised by the Driver in that behalf shall remove the notice from that vehicle.

PART IV REVOCATIONS

21. This Order hereby revokes the Orders listed in Schedule 2
