

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE**TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER****THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (HALIFAX CENTRAL AREA)
(CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2008**

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Section 1, 2, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1
GENERAL**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (HALIFAX CENTRAL AREA) (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2008 and shall come into operation on Monday 31st March 2008.

Interpretation

- 2.1
 - (a) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
 - (b) Where provision of this order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous Order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
 - (c) Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulations are referred to such reference shall include an amendment to or replacement thereof.
- 2.2 In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
 - "the Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended);
 - "carriageway" has the same meaning as in Section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980;
 - "the Council" means the Borough Council of Calderdale;
 - "restricted hours" means between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Saturday unless such day falls on a Bank Holiday;
 - "controlled parking zone" means the streets described in Schedules 3.01 and 4.09 to this Order and shown on Drawing No: 72/161/DfT/01;
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons' (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

“disabled person’s vehicle” means a vehicle displaying a disabled persons’ badge;

“driver” in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

“goods carrying vehicle” means a motor vehicle or trailer which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage or haulage of goods or burden and is not drawing a trailer;

“licensed taxi” has the meaning as in section 13 of the Transport Act 1985;

“loading or unloading” means the waiting of a vehicle for the commercial purpose of the delivery of goods to or the receipt of goods from adjacent premises, the volume, weight or bulk of the goods being such that it would not be reasonable to expect the goods to be otherwise delivered or received;

“motor car” and “motor vehicle” have the same meanings respectively as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

“motor cycle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms and has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

“owner” in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

“civil enforcement officer” means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place and to carry out such other functions as may be conferred by or under any enactment;

“parking bay” means a space in a parking place, which is provided for the leaving of the vehicle;

“parking charge” means the sum(s) payable for the purchase of a Parking Ticket as set out in Article 22 hereof;

“parking period” means the period beginning from the time the vehicle was first left in the parking place and ending on the expiration of the period of time for which payment was made at the time of first leaving the vehicle;

“parking place” means an area on a highway designed or authorised and described as a parking place by any of the various Articles or Schedules of this Order;

“parking ticket” means a ticket dispensed by a ticket parking meter or a ticket issued by a person authorised by the Council on the payment of the initial charge;

“passenger vehicle” means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than eight passengers, exclusive of the driver;

PCSO means a Police Community Support Officer authorised to carry out traffic duties;

“permit” means a permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 16 of this Order;

“prohibited area” means any area of a specified road, which is indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 974 or 975 in Schedule 5 to the 2002 Regulations;

“public service vehicle” means a motor vehicle (other than a tram car) which

- (a) being adapted to carry more than eight passengers, is being used for carrying passengers for hire or reward; or
- (b) being a vehicle not so adapted, is being used for carrying passengers for hire or reward at separate fares in the course of a business for carrying passengers, and for the purpose of this Order a public service vehicle shall be deemed to wait for more than two minutes in the same place if any part of the road is below any part of the vehicle or its load (if any) throughout the period exceeding two minutes whether or not the vehicle is moved during that period;

“relevant position” in relation to the display of a disabled person’s parking badge or disc has the same meaning as in Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

“relevant position” in relation to the display of a permit or parking ticket means in the case of a vehicle with a front windscreen the permit or parking ticket is exhibited thereon facing outwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen; or in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the permit or parking ticket is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the motor vehicle;

“the 2000 Regulations” means the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

“road” means any length of highway or of any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes;

“the 2002 Regulations” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“taxi rank” means an area of carriageway reserved for use by taxis waiting to pick up passengers

“telecommunications apparatus” or “apparatus” has the same meaning as defined in Section 405 of the Communications Act 2003;

“ticket machine” or “ticket parking meter” means any apparatus or device of a type or design approved in accordance with Section 35(3) or 46(2) of the Act of 1984 and installed to facilitate collection of the initial charge and dispense numbered

tickets as evidence of payment of the initial charge and situated adjacent to the parking place to which it relates;

“traffic sign” means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Act of 1984;

“trailer” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

“Universal Service Provider” has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000, as amended;

“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984.

PART 2

GENERAL PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING

No Waiting and No Loading At Any Time (Schedule 3.01)

3. Save as provided in Article 5 to this Order no person shall:

(a) cause any vehicle to wait at any time; or

(b) load or unload any vehicle

on any length of road specified in Schedule 3.01.

No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading 10am – 4pm (Schedule 4.09)

4. (a) Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours midnight to 10am and 4pm to midnight in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.09 to this Order.

(b) Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or to load or unload between the hours 10am to 4pm in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.09 to this Order.

Exemptions from Waiting and Loading Restrictions

5. (1) Nothing in Article 3 to this Order shall apply

(a) to a public service vehicle waiting in a prohibited area;

(b) to a vehicle being a licensed taxi waiting in a taxi rank appointed by the Council;

- (2) Nothing in Article 4(a) of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in the length of road during the times specified therein for so long as may be necessary to deliver to or collect from or load or unload goods at any premises fronting onto said length of road provided that no vehicle so engaged shall wait for longer than 30 minutes outside the same premises without the permission of a civil enforcement officer in uniform and always provided that a police constable in uniform or a PCSO may at any time require the driver of a vehicle to move it if reasonable necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to any vehicle permitted to park in the parking places specified in
 - (a) Schedules 10.13, 10.14, 11.01, 12.01, 13.01; or
 - (b) Schedule 14.13 during the hours 6pm to 10am.
- (4) Nothing in Article 3(b) shall apply to the loading or unloading of a vehicle at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 14.02 or during the hours 10am to 6pm in the length of road specified in Schedule 14.13.
- (5) Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified therein for as long as it may be necessary
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle if it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so specified for the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning in or near the said length of road of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus or traffic sign;
 - (d) if a vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting as is necessary to prevent an accident;
 - (e) to open or close a gate or other barrier at the entrance to premises to which the vehicle is being driven or from which it has emerged if it is not reasonably practicable to cause the vehicle to wait elsewhere for the purpose;
 - (f) to enable the vehicle to be used in the length of road so specified for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (g) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle while the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal or delivery of furniture to or from any premises adjacent to the parking place provided that notice is given 24 hours in advance to the Council's Parking Services and their consent obtained;
 - (h) for a Security Company vehicle that is being used for the delivery and collection of money or securities to or from any bank or other adjacent premises;
 - (i) in respect of a vehicle which is in the service of a Universal Service Provider and which is waiting at the edge of a carriageway for as long as may be necessary for the purpose of collecting or delivering postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (j) in any other case, loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting and the vehicle does not wait for a period exceeding thirty minutes or for such other period as a civil enforcement officer in uniform may approve.
 - (k) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a civil enforcement officer in uniform.
- (6) The Council is satisfied that, for facilitating the passage of vehicular traffic on the specified roads, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the 1984 Act should not apply in relation to this part of the Order.

PART 3

PARKING PLACES

Contraventions

6. (1) Each of the lengths of road specified in Schedules 11.01, 12.01, 13.01, 14.02 and 14.13 to this Order are authorised for use as a parking place subject to the following provisions of this Order for the parking of vehicles of such classes and in such positions as are specified in said Schedules.
- (2) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place specified in Schedule 11.01 unless the vehicle displays a valid special permit in the relevant position and it is parked to comply with Article 14 of this Order.
- (3) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place specified in Schedule 12.01 unless a valid disabled person's badge is displayed in

the relevant position and it is parked to comply with the provisions of Article 14 of this Order.

- (4) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place specified in Schedule 13.01 unless the vehicle is a solo motorcycle and it is parked to comply with Article 14 of this Order.
- (5) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place described in Schedule 14.02 unless it is engaged in loading or unloading goods, provided that no vehicle so engaged shall wait for longer than 30 minutes, and it is parked to comply with the provisions of Article 14 to this Order. No person shall cause that vehicle to wait again in that parking place until a period of 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting.
- (6) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place specified in Schedule 14.13
 - (a) during the hours 10.00 am to 6 pm unless it is engaged in loading or unloading goods, provided that no vehicle so engaged shall wait for longer than 30 minutes and it is parked to comply with the provisions of Article 14 to this Order. No person shall cause that vehicle to wait again in that parking place until a period of 1 hour has elapsed since the last period of waiting.
 - (b) during the hours 6pm to 10am unless it is parked to comply with the provisions of Article 14 to this Order.
- (7) The number and situation of parking bays in each parking place shall be determined by the Council and the limits of each parking place shall be indicated by the Council on the carriageway and by appropriate traffic signs in accordance with the 2002 Regulations.
- (8) Nothing in the preceding paragraphs of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council for preventing obstruction of the streets, by order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking place

Exemptions

- 7. (1) Notwithstanding Article 6 of this Order, any vehicle may wait in a parking place for so long as may be necessary if:-
 - (a) the vehicle is waiting to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;

- (c) the vehicle is a vehicle used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or a vehicle in the service of a local authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle is waiting to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of an obstruction to traffic;
 - (e) the vehicle is in the service of a Universal Service Provider and is waiting at the edge of the carriageway for as long as may be necessary for the purpose of collecting or delivering postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (f) it is a Security Company vehicle that is being used for the delivery and collection of money or securities to or from any bank or other adjacent premises;
 - (g) the vehicle is waiting to enable it to be used for the purpose of any building operation demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any mains pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 405 of the Communications Act 2003 or traffic sign;
 - (h) the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal or delivery of furniture to any premises situate in a parking place provided that notice is given 24 hours in advance to the Council's Parking Services and their consent obtained;
 - (i) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle at or from premises adjacent to the parking place and the vehicle does not wait for such purpose for more than 30 minutes or such other period as a civil enforcement officer in uniform may authorise provided always that a police constable in uniform or a PCSO may at any time require the driver of a vehicle to move it if it is reasonably necessary for the purpose of preventing obstruction.
- (2) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 25 of the Act of 1984.

Suspensions

8. (1) The Council's Parking Services may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever they considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) for the convenience of the occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from the premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals or on other special occasions;
 - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any road containing a parking place may be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (e) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 405 of the Communications Act 2003 or of any traffic sign or lighting column.
- (2) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article shall thereupon or as soon as reasonably practicable thereafter place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (3) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any parking place or part of a parking place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part of a parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (2) of this Article PROVIDED THAT nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 7(1)(c) or (d) of this Order to be left in the parking place or part of a parking place during any such period, or to any other vehicle so left if that vehicle was left with the permission (a) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this article (b) a civil enforcement officer in uniform.

Other Conditions

9. (1) A driver of a vehicle shall not use the parking place
- (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or the use of the road by other persons or
 - (b) so as to be a nuisance or

- (c) when for preventing an obstruction of the street the Council shall by order made on the occasion of any public procession rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or likely to be obstructed have closed that parking space and have exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place.
- 10. (a) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or about to depart from the parking place;
 - (b) Save as provided in sub-paragraph (i) and (ii) of this paragraph, no person shall use the vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near that road or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
 - (i) if the vehicle is of a type described in Article 6(1) and the goods are immediately delivered or taken into the premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is affected: or
 - (ii) the vehicle is one to which the provision of Article 7(1)(g) applies.
- 11. No person shall carry out upon any vehicle while it is in a parking place any work of construction, cleaning, maintenance or repair except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed from the parking place.
- 12. No person shall post, affix, place or otherwise leave in a parking place or on or to any vehicle using a parking place any leaflet, poster, or other similar material which advertises or publicises any goods, articles, services, or facilities provided or to be provided by that person or by anyone else.
- 13. A civil enforcement officer in uniform or a police constable in uniform may in any case of emergency move or cause to be moved any vehicle left in a parking place to any place he thinks fit.
- 14. Every vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order, except for the purposes specified in Article 7, shall so stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.

PART 4

PARKING PERMITS

- 15. On receipt of an application duly made under the conditions of the Council's Parking Permit Scheme, the Council, upon being satisfied that the usual place of residence of the applicant is as specified in column 4 of Schedule 11.01, and the owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Column 3 of said Schedule, may, subject to provisos (i) and (ii) hereto, issue to the applicant one special permit for the leaving in the parking place of the vehicle to which such special permit relates

by consent of the owner, other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward, provided that:

- (i) subject to the provisions of Article 16 of this Order, the Council shall not issue a special permit to any person which would be valid for any period during which any other special permit issued to that person is or would be valid; and
- (ii) provided always that the issue of a special permit to any person shall not be construed as if any parking space in the parking place was reserved solely for the use of the permit holder.

16 (1) A permit holder may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender a permit to the Council on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article.

- (2) (i) The Council may, by notice in writing served on the permit holder by sending the same by recorded delivery service to the permit holder at the address shown by that person on the application for the permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode, withdraw a permit entirely at its own discretion and the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice;

- (ii) A permit shall cease to be valid on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article.

(3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this article are:-

- (a) the permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the permit was issued;
- (b) the withdrawal of such permit by the Council under the provisions of paragraph (a) of this Article;
- (c) the vehicle in respect of which such permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of the class specified in Column 3 of Schedule 11.01 to this Order.

17. (1) If a permit is mutilated or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the permit has become altered by fading or otherwise, the permit holder shall surrender it to the Council and the Council, upon receipt of the permit shall issue a duplicate permit so marked.

- (2) If a permit is lost or destroyed, the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate permit and the Council, upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction shall issue a duplicate permit so marked and upon such issue the permit which it duplicates shall become invalid.

- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate permit and an application therefore as if it were a permit, or as the case may be, an application therefore.
- 18. At all times during which a vehicle is left in a parking place there shall be displayed in the relevant position a valid permit issued in respect of that vehicle so that all the particulars on the face of the permit are readily visible from the front or near side of the vehicle.
 - 19. Where a permit has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 18 of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the permit from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

PART 5

PAY AND DISPLAY (Schedule 10.20 to 10.21)

Parking Places

- 20. (1) Each area of a highway described in Column 1 of Schedule 10.01 and 10.02 to this Order is hereby designated as a parking place.
- (2) Each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of Articles 20 to 30 of this Order, for the leaving of vehicles of the class specified in Column 3, during the hours indicated in Column 6 on days specified in Column 5 of Schedules 10.13 and 10.14
- (3) The period Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm is hereinafter called the “restricted period”.
- (4) The number of situation of parking bays in each parking place shall be determined by the Council and the limits of each parking place shall be indicated by the Council on the carriageway and by appropriate traffic signs in accordance with the 2002 Regulations.

Payment for Parking

- 21. (1) Subject to Articles 28 and 29 of this Order, no person may leave or cause any vehicle to be left in a parking place on any day, other than when such day falls on a Bank Holiday, during the restricted period except upon the payment of the sum of money for the period of parking that is required by the motorist and referred to in paragraph (4) of this Article.
- (2) The amount of parking time purchased and the payment required for that period described in paragraph (1) of this Article are hereinafter called respectively the “parking period” and the “parking charge”.
- (3) Subject to Articles 28 and 29 of this Order, the maximum length of time for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place during the restricted period on payment of the parking charge, shall be as indicated, in relation to that parking place, in Column 7 of Schedule 10.13 to 10.14 to this Order.

- (4) (a) The parking charge for a vehicle left in a parking place during the restricted period shall be the amount in relation to that parking place, and be dependant upon the parking period required by the motorist, provided that it is compliant with that specified in Column 8 of Schedule 10.13 to 10.14 to this Order.
 - (b) The parking charge for a vehicle left in a parking place or parking bay or parking during the restricted period shall be as appropriate for the period required at that parking place or parking bay provided that the parking period(s) purchased shall not exceed the maximum period of waiting specified for that parking place or parking bay.
- 22. (1) The parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking place by the insertion in the parking meter relating to the parking place or parking bay in which the vehicle is left, of a coin, or coins of the denomination indicated on the parking meter or pre-paid parking card. The Parking meter will dispense a ticket that must be displayed in accordance with the provisions of this order.
- (2) No person shall display on a vehicle left in a parking place during the restricted period, any ticket issued by a ticket parking meter relating to that parking place other than the ticket issued by such ticket parking meter upon payment of the parking charge in respect of that vehicle until the expiration of the parking period.
- (3) No person with intent to deceive, shall use or lend to, or allow to be used by any other person, any ticket issued by a ticket parking meter to them following their payment of the initial charge in respect of the vehicle.
- (4) Save as provided in paragraph (2) of Article 28 of this Order no vehicle which has been taken away from a parking bay in a parking place after the parking charge has been incurred shall, until the expiration of period of prohibited return indicated in Column 7 of Schedule 10.20 to 10.21, again be left in that parking place during the restricted period.

Parking Meter tickets

- 23. (1) There shall be a parking meter installed on or in the vicinity of each parking place.
- (2) The parking charge for the parking period for a vehicle left in a parking place at which a parking meter with clock is installed shall be indicated by the issue of a numbered ticket showing the date and time at which the parking period was purchased, the time it expires and details of the parking charge made and showing such details shall be conclusive evidence of those facts for the purpose of this Order.
- (3) Upon payment of the parking charge for a vehicle left in a parking place at which a parking meter with a clock is installed, the driver thereof shall

exhibit on the vehicle, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article, a ticket issued by the parking meter relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article.

- (4) The ticket referred to in paragraph (3) of this Article shall be displayed in the “relevant position” on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left in the parking place during the restricted hours.
- (5) Where a ticket has been exhibited on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.
- (6) If at any time while a vehicle is left in a parking place during the restricted period no ticket is exhibited on that vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article, it shall be assumed unless the contrary is proved that the payment has not been duly paid.

Manner of Standing in Parking Places

- 24 Every vehicle left in a parking place during the restricted period shall, except as specified in Article 28(1), so stand so that every part of the vehicle is wholly within the limits of the parking bay.

Removal of Vehicles from Parking Places

- 25. A civil enforcement officer in uniform or a police constable in uniform may in case of emergency move or cause to be moved vehicles left in a parking place to any place he thinks fit.

Power to Suspend Use of Parking Places

- 26. (1) The Council’s Parking Services may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-
 - (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration or maintenance in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 405 of the Communications Act 2003;

- (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
 - (d) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
 - (e) On any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed.
- (2) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs (1) of this Article shall thereupon:-
 - (a) place or cause to be placed over the parking meter relating to the parking place or parking bay hoods or other covers indicating that the use of the parking place or parking bay is suspended and that waiting by vehicles is prohibited; and
 - (b) place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of that parking place which is not a parking bay and use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (3) On any suspension of the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article, any person duly authorised by the Council may temporarily remove any parking meter relating to any parking place or parking bay, as the case may be, that part thereof and any post, bracket or other support on which that parking meter is fitted and shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or parking bay a traffic sign giving the indication referred to in paragraph (2) (b) of this Article.
- (4) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article if the use of a parking place is suspended or any part thereof during the restricted period for any purposes in paragraph (1) of this Article except in paragraph (1)(a) of this Article a charge of 24 times the hourly rate shall be payable for each parking bay suspended in respect of each day or part day thereof during which use of the parking place or part thereof is suspended.
- (5) No Person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be left in any parking place or part of a parking place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part of a parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (2) of the Article PROVIDED THAT nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 28(iii) and (iv) of this Order to be left in a parking place during any such period, or to any vehicle so left if that vehicle was left with the permission (a) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article or (b) a civil enforcement officer in uniform.

Restriction of Use of Parking Places

27. (1) A driver of a vehicle shall not use the parking place
- (a) so as to unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or the use of the road by other persons or
 - (b) so as to be a nuisance or
 - (c) when for preventing an obstruction of the street the Council shall by order made on the occasion of any public procession rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or likely to be obstructed have closed that parking space and have exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place.
- (2) (a) The driver of a vehicle using the parking space shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- (b) Save as provided in sub-paragraph (i) and (ii) of this paragraph, no person shall use the vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near that road or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skills or services.
- (i) if the vehicle is of a type described in Article 20(2) and the goods are immediately delivered or taken into the premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is affected: or
 - (ii) the vehicle is one to which the provision of Article 28(1)(vii).
- (3) No person shall carry out or permit the carrying out of any work of construction, cleaning, maintenance or repair except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved from the parking place.
- (4) No person shall post, affix, place or otherwise leave in a parking place or on or to any vehicle using a parking place any leaflet, poster, or other similar material which advertises or publicises any goods, articles, services, or facilities provided or to be provided by that person or by anyone else.
- (5) Every vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of the Order, except for the purposes specified in Article 28, shall so stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.

Use of Parking Places during the Restricted Period without Payment

28. (1) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order relating to vehicles which are left in a parking place in accordance with those provisions any other vehicle may wait during the restricted period:-
- (a) anywhere in a parking place if:
- (i) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (ii) the vehicle is waiting due to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (iii) the vehicle is used for fire brigade purposes, is an ambulance or is a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or is a vehicle in the service of a police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (iv) the vehicle is waiting for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (v) the vehicle, being a vehicle of universal service provider, to be used in the provision of a universal postal service.
 - (vi) the vehicle not being a passenger vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in paragraph (5) of Article 26;
 - (vii) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting and does not wait for more than 30 minutes or such other period as a parking attendant in uniform or a person identifiable as being responsible for Parking Services or duly authorised officer of the Council may authorise.
- (2) No charge specified in the foregoing provisions of Articles 20 to 27 of this Order shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Article.
- (3) Nothing in the provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any Regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 25 of the Act of 1984.

Exemptions from Charges

29. (1) If a vehicle is left in a parking place or bay during the restricted period on which there is on the parking meter relating to that place or bay or in or adjacent to that place or bay a notice placed by any person authorised by

the Council indicating that the meter is out of order, the vehicle will be exempt from the parking charge provided that -

- (a) after the meter is repaired the vehicle is removed within a period not being longer than the maximum parking period relating to the appropriate parking place, and that
 - (b) if the vehicle is not removed within that period the parking charge shall be treated as having been incurred and paid.
- (2) If a parking meter is out of order then a civil enforcement officer in uniform may instead of placing a notice in accordance with Article 29(1) place a notice nominating another parking meter or meters in the locality at which a parking ticket may be obtained for that parking place and the parking ticket(s) shall be valid for the purpose of Article 21, providing that:
- (a) the initial parking period purchased does not exceed the maximum parking period of the parking place; and
 - (b) the number of parking tickets initially purchased at the start of the initial parking period does not exceed that required to meet the maximum parking period of the parking place.
- (3) Any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge issued by a local authority or any vehicle which displays a valid permit, for that parking place, issued by the Council shall if left in a parking place or parking bay during the restricted period be exempt from the payment of any charge or compliance with any time limit or prohibited return period in relation to the leaving of any vehicle in that parking place or bay prescribed in the foregoing provisions of this Order.
- (4) A motorcycle left in a parking place or parking bay during the restricted period shall be exempt from the payment of any charge or compliance with any time limit or prohibited return period in relation to the leaving of any vehicle in that parking place or bay prescribed by the foregoing provisions of this Order.
- (5) A vehicle, which is left in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Article, shall stand in accordance with the provisions of Article 24 of this Order.

Installation of Parking Meters

30. The Council may -

- (a) provide parking meters or such other ticket machines or apparatus as may be required by this Order for the purposes of that parking place; and
- (b) carry out such other work as is authorised by this Order or is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

PART 6**PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

31. Save as provided in Article 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or PCSO cause or permit any public service vehicle other than one less than 8.5 metres in length to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Item 1 to this Order.
32. Save as provided in Articles 33 and 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Items 2 to 6 inclusive to this Order other than for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle at premises fronting onto the said lengths of road between the hours 4.00 pm to midnight and midnight to 9.30 am on Monday to Sunday inclusive.
33. Nothing in Articles 32 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Items 2 to 6 inclusive to this Order:
- (1) between the hours 4.00 pm to midnight and midnight to 9.30 am if the vehicle:-
 - (a) is being used for any building operation excavation or demolition at premises fronting onto or accessible only from the said lengths of road providing it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road;
 - (b) requires access to private off-street parking from the said lengths of road;
 - (c) the vehicle is in the service of a Universal Service Provider and requires access for the purpose of collecting or delivering postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000;
 - (2) requires egress between the hours of 9.30am to 10am from any premises situated on or adjacent to the specified lengths of road (where no suitable alternative means of egress is available) or any other premises accessible from and only from the said lengths of road provided that the vehicle has been engaged in the loading or unloading of goods in accordance with the provisions of Article 5(2) of this Order.
34. Save as provided in Articles 37 and 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Items 7 to 10 inclusive other than;
- (a) a public service vehicle;
 - (b) licensed taxi;
 - (c) pedal cycle; or

- (d) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle at premises fronting onto the said lengths of road.
35. Save as provided in Articles 37 and 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Item 11 to this Order other than;
- (a) licensed taxi;
 - (b) pedal cycle; or
 - (c) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle at premises fronting onto the said lengths of road.
36. Save as provided in Article 37 and 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Items 12 and 13 to this Order other than;
- (a) a public service vehicle;
 - (b) licensed taxi;
 - (c) pedal cycle; or
 - (d) for the purpose of loading or unloading the vehicle at premises fronting onto the said lengths of road.
37. Nothing in Articles 34, 35 and 36 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Items 7 to 13 to this Order if the vehicle:-
- (a) is being used for building operations excavation or demolition at premises fronting onto or accessible only from the said lengths of road providing it cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road;
 - (b) requires access to private off-street parking from the said lengths of road;
 - (c) is in the service of a Universal Service Provider and requires access for the purpose of collecting or delivering postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000.
38. Save as provided in Article 39 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle other than one with a maximum length of 6 metres to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule 50.05 Item 14 to this Order.
39. Nothing Articles 31, 32, 34, 35, 36 and 38 of this Order shall prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified if the vehicle:-

- (a) is being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade, local authority or water authority purposes when used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (b) is being used and cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road for the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so specified or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said length of road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Section 405 of the Communications Act 2003;
- (c) is a Security Company vehicle that is being used for the delivery and collection of money or securities to or from any bank or other adjacent premises.

PART 7

PRESCRIBED ROUTES

- 40. Save as provided in Article 41 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 50.07 to this Order to proceed at the junction specified in Column 2 in relation to that length of road other than in the direction specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule.
- 41. Nothing in Article 40 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road-cleansing vehicle when used for that purpose at any time in accordance with any contractual arrangements entered into by the Council for the purpose of cleansing of the streets.

PART 8

PROHIBITION OF TURNS

- 42. Save as provided in Article 43 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 50.08 to this Order to make a turn into the road specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 43. Nothing in Article 42 of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is a public service vehicle or licensed taxi, pedal cycle or vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

PART 9

ONE-WAY STREETS

- 44. Save as provided in Article 45 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or a PCSO cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 and 2 of Schedule 50.04 to

this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

45. Nothing in Article 44 of this Order shall apply to the driving of any mechanical road-cleansing vehicle when used for that purpose at any time in accordance with any contractual arrangements entered into by the Council for the purpose of cleansing of the streets.

PART 10

REVOCATIONS

46. The Orders specified in the Schedule of Revocations to this Order are hereby revoked in their entirety.

PART 11

GENERAL

47. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
48. For the avoidance of doubt any reference in this Order to a length of road shall be deemed to be a reference to more than one length of road where the context requires it.
49. Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Order shall restrict a police constable in uniform from performing his duties if an emergency situation arises.
50. This order shall come into operation on the 31st March 2008 and may be cited as "The Borough Council of Calderdale (Halifax Central Area) (Controlled Parking Zone) Consolidation Order 2008.
