The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Variation Order to The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Hebden Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008.

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Hebden Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No. 4) Order 2008 and will come into effect on 4th May 2009

2. The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Hebden Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008. (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") shall be varied as follows: -
 - i) the Items in Table A to this Order are to be added to Schedule 4.04 of "the Order" and the effect of this will be to restrict waiting at any time and to restrict Loading between Monday to Friday 8.15-9.15am and 2.30-4pm on the streets listed in the said schedule

 - ii) the Items in Table B to this Order are to be added to Schedule 5.01 of "the Order" and the effect of this will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the streets listed in the said schedule

3. Except as hereinbefore provided in this Variation Order the provisions and articles of “the Order” shall remain in force.

4. The provisions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

1	Brier Hey Lane	the west side from the junction with school entrance road in a south - easterly direction for a distance of approximately 70 metres
2	Brier Hey Close	the north side from a point approximately 23 metres north-westerly of the projected common boundary line of No's 1 & 2, Brier Hey Close in a north-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 2.7 metres.
3	Brier Hey Lane	the west side from a point approximately 26 metres north-westerly of the projected common boundary line of No's 1 & 2, Brier Hey Close, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 124 metres.
