THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (TODMORDEN) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008 (VARIATION NO.2) ORDER 2010

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Section 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Variation Order to The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order 2008.

- This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No. 2) Order 2010 and will come into operation on 22 April 2010.
- The Borough Council of Calderdale (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order
 2008 shall be varied as follows:
 - i) the text in Article 74 of "the Order" will now read as follows
- 74 Nothing in Articles 6(a), 7a, 8a, 9a, 10a, 11a, 12a, 13a, 14a, 15(a), 16, 17(a), 21a and 25 to 46 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road during the days and times specified therein
 - (a) for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road or part of road on the same day)

- (b) in the length of road specified in Schedule 8 to this Order if the vehicle displays in the relevant position
- (i) in all cases a disabled person's badge
- (ii) in the case mentioned in (a) above a parking disc issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended), or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a Disabled Person's Badge and the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting began.
- Except as hereinbefore provided in this Variation Order the provisions and articles of "the Order" shall remain in force.
- 4. The provisions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
