- This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Sowerby Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No. 5) Order 2010 and will come into operation on 22 November 2010.
- The Borough Council of Calderdale (Sowerby Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall be varied as follows: -

The following Article is to be added to "the Order"

Additional Article

No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading Monday to Saturday 7.30am – 9.30am and 4pm – 6pm (Schedule 4.11)

- 15A (a) Save as provided in Articles 72, 73, and 74 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours midnight to 7.30am and 9.30am to 4pm and 6pm to midnight Monday to Saturday inclusive or on Sunday in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.11 to this Order.
- (b) Save as provided in Article 72 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer in uniform, cause or permit

any vehicle to wait or to load or unload between the hours 7.30am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6pm Monday to Saturday in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.11 to this Order.
