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(WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (SOWERBY BRIDGE)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008 (VARIATION NO.5) ORDER 2010

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Section 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Variation Order to The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Sowerby Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008.

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Sowerby Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No. 5) Order 2010 and will come into operation on 22 November 2010.
2. The Borough Council of Calderdale (Sowerby Bridge) (Consolidation) Order 2008 shall be varied as follows: -

The following Article is to be added to "the Order"

Additional Article

No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading Monday to Saturday 7.30am – 9.30am and 4pm – 6pm (Schedule 4.11)

15A (a) Save as provided in Articles 72, 73, and 74 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours midnight to 7.30am and 9.30am to 4pm and 6pm to midnight Monday to Saturday inclusive or on Sunday in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.11 to this Order.

(b) Save as provided in Article 72 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer in uniform, cause or permit

any vehicle to wait or to load or unload between the hours 7.30am to 9.30am and 4pm to 6pm Monday to Saturday in the length of road specified in Schedule 4.11 to this Order.

Additional Schedules

- ii. The items in Table B to this Order are to be added to Schedule 5.01 of the Order and the effect of this will be no waiting at any time on the streets listed in the said schedule
- iii. The items in Table C to this Order are to be added to Schedule 8.03 of the Order and the effect of this will be limited waiting of two hours return prohibited within two hours Monday – Saturday 8am – 6pm on the streets listed in the said schedule
- iv. The items in Table D to this Order are to be added to Schedule 9.51 of the Order and the effect of this will be resident parking all days all hours or limited waiting

of two hours return prohibited within two hours Monday – Saturday 8am – 6pm
on the streets listed in the said schedule

- v. The items in Table E to this Order are to be added to Schedule 12.09 of the Order and the effect of this will be disabled parking of two hours returned prohibited within four hours on the streets listed in the said schedule
 - vi. The items in Table F of this Order are to be added to Schedule 16.12 of the Order and the effect of this will be a parking area reserved for buses and coaches on the streets listed in the said schedule
 - vii. The items in Table G to this Order are the Schedule of Revocations to the Order and are to be revoked to the extent laid down in Column 2.
3. Except as hereinbefore provided in this Variation Order the provisions and articles of “the Order” shall remain in force.
4. Changes to Articles of BCC (WAITING AND LOADING AND PARKING PLACES) (SOWERBY BRIDGE) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2008 (VARIATION NO. 3) ORDER 2010

Article 2 - Insert 15A (a) after 15(a)

5. The provisions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.


