The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of its powers under Section 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Variation Order to The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order 2008.

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (Variation No. 1) Order 2010 and will come into operation on 17 January 2011.
2. The Borough Council of Calderdale (Todmorden) (Consolidation) Order 2008 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") shall be varied as follows:-
 - i. The items in Table A to this Order are to be added to Schedule 5.01 of the Order and the effect of this will be no waiting at any time on the streets listed in the said schedule
 - ii. The items in Table B to this Order are to be added to Schedule 11.01 of the Order and the effect of this will be to introduce Resident Parking place all days all hours on the streets listed in the said schedule.

- iii. The Schedules listed in Table C to this Order are the Schedule of Revocations to the Order and are to be revoked to the extent laid down in Column 2.
3. Except as hereinbefore provided in this Variation Order the provisions and articles of "the Order" shall remain in force.
4. The provisions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.


