### THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF CALDERDALE (CAR PARKS) CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2019

A statutory instrument to make provision for the Council's off-street car parking facilities throughout the Borough, to include Brighouse, Elland, Halifax, Hebden Bridge, Sowerby Bridge and Todmorden.

The Borough Council of Calderdale in exercise of powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

#### **OPERATION**

#### **Article**

#### 1. Commencement and citation

This Order shall come into operation on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and may be cited as The Borough Council of Calderdale (Car Parks) Consolidation Order 2019.

#### 2. Revocations

The orders listed in Schedule 2 are hereby revoked.

#### 3. Interpretation

- (1) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.
- (2) Where a provision of this Order is in conflict with a provision contained in a previous order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- (3) Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation is referred to such reference shall include an amendment to or replacement thereof.
- (4) Where a statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation is referred to and a definition follows it in brackets, the reference in the statute, statutory instrument, specification or regulation shall prevail.
- (5) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, regulation or other requirement imposed by law.
- (6) References to articles or to parts unless otherwise stated mean articles or parts of this Order respectively.

#### 4. Definitions

In this Order, the following terms have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"actively charging" means electric charge is being transferred from the charging equipment at the <u>electric vehicle charging bay</u> to the motor or battery of the <u>electric vehicle</u> or <u>hybrid vehicle</u> and the motor or battery is not yet fully charged;

#### "active payment session" in respect of: =

(a) an <u>electric vehicle</u> or <u>hybrid vehicle</u> waiting in an <u>electric vehicle</u> charging bay:-

means a charging session that has started and is continuing to count and allocate time or expense to the user at the <u>electric vehicle charging</u> bay provided the <u>electric vehicle</u> or <u>hybrid vehicle</u> is:

- (i) connected to the charging equipment provided at that <u>electric</u> <u>vehicle charging bay;</u>
- (ii) <u>actively charging</u> its motor or battery for propulsion; and
- (iii) complying with the terms of use of the electric vehicle charging equipment specified on <u>signage</u> in or next to the <u>electric vehicle</u> <u>charging bay</u>.
- (b) a <u>vehicle</u> paying for the use of a <u>pay and display parking place</u> by an <u>approved app</u>:-

means a parking session that has started and is continuing to count and allocate time or expense on an <u>approved app</u> to the account of a pre-registered user for the purpose of paying for the use of a <u>pay and display parking place</u> provided:

- (i) the user has received and can evidence <u>written confirmation</u> that an <u>active payment session</u> has started and is covering the period the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting;
- (ii) the correct <u>vehicle registration number</u> for the <u>vehicle</u> waiting is registered with the <u>authorised supplier</u> in relation to the <u>active payment session</u>; and
- (iii) a valid credit or debit card is registered with the <u>authorised</u> supplier and there are sufficient funds available via the method of payment selected to pay for the <u>maximum stay period</u> for that pay and display parking place.

- "approved app" means a computer programme or software application designed to run on a mobile device such as a smart phone, tablet or watch that has been approved by the <a href="Council">Council</a> for the purpose of monitoring parking activity and accepting payment for the use of <a href="parking place">parking place</a>s;
- "authorised officer" means an individual duly authorised by the Council in writing to exercise any power in this Order;
- "authorised payment method" means payment via an <u>authorised supplier</u> or at the <u>pay and display machine</u> relating to the <u>parking place</u> in which the <u>vehicle</u> is left by either:
  - (a) the insertion of a coin(s) or bank note(s) of the denomination indicated on the pay and display machine; or
  - (b) a valid credit or debit card; or
  - (c) pre-paid parking card; or
  - (d) payment by electronic device;
- "authorised supplier" means a provider of an <u>approved app</u> for the purpose of facilitating a cashless transaction to include payment for the use of <u>parking places</u>;
- "charging hours" means the days and hours specified in Column 5 of <u>Schedule 1</u> and excludes bank holidays, except in relation to those <u>parking places</u> where specific provision is made for bank holidays in Column 5 of <u>Schedule 1</u>;
- "Council" means the Borough Council of Calderdale and includes any contractors or authorised agents appointed by or acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of any function under the provisions of this Order;
- "disabled person" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
- "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
- "disabled person's parking bay" means those <u>parking bays</u> which are indicated by <u>signage</u> placed in or next to the <u>parking place</u> for the use of <u>vehicles</u> displaying a <u>disabled person's badge</u>;
- "display" and "displayed" in relation to a <u>disabled person's badge</u>, <u>permit</u> or <u>pay</u>

  <u>and display ticket</u> means displayed in the <u>relevant position</u> for the duration that the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting;

- "driver" in relation to the <u>vehicle</u> left in a <u>parking place</u> means the person driving the <u>vehicle</u> at the time it was left in the <u>parking place</u>;
- "electric vehicle" means a <u>vehicle</u> in which the electrical motive power is derived from an electrical storage battery which is not connected to any source of power when the <u>vehicle</u> is in motion;
- "electric vehicle charging bay" means a marked out <u>parking bay</u> identified by <u>signage</u> authorising it to be used for the leaving of <u>electric vehicles</u> or <u>hybrid vehicles</u> in accordance with the provisions of this Order;
- "goods vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 138(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description and is not drawing a trailer);
- "hackney carriage" means a vehicle licensed under Section 37 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847;
- "hybrid vehicle" means a <u>vehicle</u> that has both an internal combustion engine and an electric motor powered by an electric storage battery that is recharged from an external source of electricity;
- "invalid carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a mechanically propelled vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person);
- "liveried vehicle" means a vehicle having a distinctive design and colour scheme used to distinguish a police, fire brigade, ambulance, statutory undertaker, Royal Mail or other <u>universal service provider</u>, a security company vehicle or a Council highway maintenance vehicle;
- "load" and "loading" includes 'unload' and 'unloading' and in this context means put something(s) in or take something(s) out of a vehicle;
- "loading bay" means a bay marked out for the loading and unloading of goods in accordance with the designation of signage in or next to the bay;
- "loading and unloading of goods" for the purpose of being permitted to <u>load</u> in a <u>loading bay</u> or load where otherwise it would not be permitted means the active loading or unloading of goods to or from a <u>vehicle</u>, the volume, weight or bulk of

- the goods being such that it would not be reasonable to expect the goods to be otherwise delivered or received and such loading or unloading is continuous;
- "maximum stay period" means the maximum period for which vehicles may wait or load as specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1;
- "motor car" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a mechanically propelled vehicle, not being a motor cycle or an invalid carriage, which is constructed itself to carry a load or passengers and of which the weight unladen—
  - (a) if it is constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects, is adapted to carry not more than 7 passengers exclusive of the driver, and is fitted with tyres of such type as may be specified in regulations made by the Secretary of State, does not exceed 3050 kilograms;
  - (b) if it is constructed or adapted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden of any description, does not exceed 3050 kilograms (or 3500 kilograms if the vehicle carries a container or containers for holding, for the purposes of its propulsion, any fuel which is wholly gaseous at 17.5 degrees Celsius under a pressure of 1.013 bar or plant and materials for producing such fuel); or
  - (c) in a case falling within neither of the foregoing paragraphs, does not exceed 2540 kilograms);
  - "motor cycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms);
  - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads);
  - "motor cycle parking bay" means a bay marked out for the parking of motor cycles as designated by signage in or next to the bay;
  - "no return period" means the period of time that a <u>vehicle</u> after waiting or <u>loading</u> in a <u>parking place</u> may not return to the same <u>parking place</u> within as specified in Column 6 of <u>Schedule 1</u>;
  - "operative hours" means the days and hours of operation of <u>parking places</u> as specified in Column 4 of <u>Schedule 1</u> of this Order;

- "parking bay" means a space within the <u>parking place</u> marked out to accommodate a single <u>vehicle;</u>
- "parking charge" means the sum(s) payable for the purchase of a <u>pay and display</u>

  <u>ticket</u> in accordance with the scale of charges specified in Column 7 of

  <u>Schedule 1</u>;
- "parking place" means the area within the car parks as shown edged red on the plans attached to this order and specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order provided by the Council in pursuance of Section 32(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as a parking place for vehicles of the prescribed classes;
- "pay and display machine" means an apparatus for issuing a <u>pay and display</u>

  <u>ticket</u> indicating the payment of a charge, the date on which the ticket is valid
  and the time by which the <u>vehicle</u> is required to leave the <u>pay and display</u>

  <u>parking place</u>;
- "pay and display parking place" means the individual car parks listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 where there is also a parking charge listed in Column 7 of Schedule 1;

#### "pay and display ticket" means either:

- (i) a ticket issued by a pay and display machine; or
- (ii) a <u>virtual ticket</u>.
- "payment by electronic device" means use of an electronic transmission device to pay the <u>parking charge</u> through a pre-registered account accepted by the <u>Council</u> and containing the correct <u>vehicle registration number</u> of the <u>vehicle</u> used, valid credit or debit card details and such other information as the <u>Council</u> may from time to time require at the time of use of the <u>parking place</u>;
- "permit" means any valid permit issued by the <u>Council</u> under the provisions of this Order and includes a <u>virtual permit;</u>
- "permit holders parking place" means a <u>parking place</u> or a <u>parking bay</u> designated for the parking of <u>vehicles</u> displaying a valid <u>permit;</u>

#### "relevant position" in respect of: -

(a) a disabled person's badge and parking disc:-

has the same meaning as 'relevant position' defined in Regulation 4 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

#### (b) a permit:-

means displayed on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the <u>vehicle</u> or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle:

#### (c) a virtual permit:-

means visible to a civil enforcement officer checking the <u>vehicle</u> using hand-hand electronic equipment or equivalent means for the purpose of checking for a valid virtual permit;

#### (d) a pay and display ticket:-

means displayed on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the <u>vehicle</u> or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the ticket is clearly legible from outside the vehicle:

#### (e) a virtual ticket:-

means visible to a civil enforcement officer checking the <u>vehicle</u> using hand-hand electronic equipment or equivalent means for the purpose of checking for a valid virtual ticket;

- "restricted area" means an area physically signed, lined or otherwise demarcated through hatched markings to indicate that causing a <u>vehicle</u> to wait in that area is prohibited;
- "signage" means signs and/ or lines to describe, delineate or designate a restriction, provision or requirement;
- "specified class" in relation to a vehicle means a <u>vehicle</u> of a category or specification that is distinct in description, purpose, user, size, weight, height, length or emissions;

- "tariff card" means the insert or digital display showing the <u>parking charges</u> in or on the <u>pay and display machine</u>;
- "taxi" means a licensed taxi as in the meaning of Section 13 of the Transport Act 1985 or private hire vehicle within the meaning of Section 80 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;
- "taxi parking bay" means a bay marked out for the waiting or <u>loading</u> of <u>hackney</u> <u>carriages</u> or <u>taxi</u>s in accordance with the designation of <u>signage</u> in or next to the bay;
- "trailer" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- "universal service provider" has the meaning as that in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011;
- "vehicle" has the same meaning as "motor vehicle";
- "vehicle registration number" means the vehicle registration number as provided for in the vehicle's log book (V5C or V5CNI log book) and on the number plate(s) displayed the <u>vehicle</u> as prescribed by Part II of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 and regulations made thereunder;
- "virtual permit" means a <u>permit</u> issued electronically via the <u>Council</u> or an <u>authorised supplier</u> for the purpose of permitting a user to wait in a <u>parking</u> <u>place</u> in accordance with the terms and conditions for that virtual permit;
- "virtual ticket" means a ticket issued electronically via the <u>Council</u> or an <u>authorised</u> <u>supplier</u> for the purpose of paying the <u>parking charge</u>;
- "written confirmation" in relation to an <u>active payment session</u> means an email, text message or recorded communication through an <u>approved app</u> to relay confirmation;

#### **DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES**

#### 5. General designation of parking places

The car parks listed in <u>Schedule 1</u> are designated to be used as <u>parking places</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> subject to the provisions of this Order.

#### 6. Disabled person's parking bay

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>disabled person's parking</u> <u>bay</u> during the <u>operative hours</u>:

- (a) unless there is displayed on that <u>vehicle</u> in the <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>disabled person's badge</u>; and
- (b) provided that the <u>vehicle</u> immediately before or after the act of waiting has been or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or used for the carrying of the <u>disabled</u> <u>person(s)</u>.

#### 7. Electric vehicle charging bay

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait or <u>load</u> in an <u>electric vehicle</u> charging bay during the <u>operative hours</u> unless the <u>vehicle</u> is:

- (a) an <u>electric vehicle</u> or a <u>hybrid vehicle</u>;
- (b) connected to charging equipment provided at that <u>electric\_vehicle</u> charging bay;
- (c) actively charging its motor or battery for propulsion; and
- (d) complying with the terms of use of the electric vehicle charging equipment specified on <u>signage</u> in or next to the <u>electric vehicle</u> charging bay.

#### Taxi parking bays

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>taxi parking bay</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> unless that <u>vehicle</u> is a <u>taxi</u> and it complies with the designation of <u>vehicle</u> specified on <u>signage</u> in or next to the <u>taxi parking bay</u>.

#### 9. Motor cycle parking

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>motor cycle parking bay</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> unless that <u>vehicle</u> is a <u>motor cycle</u> and it complies with the designation of <u>vehicle</u> specified on <u>signage</u> in or next to the <u>motor cycle parking</u> bay.

#### 10. Bus and coach parking

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait during the <u>operative hours</u> in a parking bay designated for the waiting or <u>loading</u> of buses or coaches unless that <u>vehicle</u> is a bus or a coach and it complies with the designation of <u>vehicle</u> specified on the <u>signage</u> in or next to the parking bay.

#### 11. Loading bay

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>loading bay</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> unless that <u>vehicle</u> is being used in the <u>loading and unloading of goods</u> and it complies with the designation of <u>vehicle</u> specified on <u>signage</u> in or next to the <u>loading bay</u>.

#### 12. Permit holders' parking place

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>permit holders parking place</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> unless there is clearly displayed on that <u>vehicle</u> in the <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>permit</u> effective for that particular <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking</u> bay.

#### 13. Specified class of vehicle

Where a <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u> is described as being designated for <u>vehicles</u> of a <u>specified class</u> a <u>driver</u> shall not permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait or <u>load</u> in that <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> unless the <u>vehicle</u> is of the <u>specified</u> class.

#### MAXIMUM STAY AND NO RETURN PERIOD

#### 14. Maximum stay period

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait or <u>load</u> in any <u>parking place</u> for longer than the maximum stay period specified for that parking place.

#### 15. No return period

No person shall cause or permit a <u>vehicle</u> after leaving a <u>parking place</u> to wait or <u>load</u> again in the same <u>parking place</u> during the <u>operative hours</u> until the <u>no return</u> period has elapsed.

#### PAY AND DISPLAY SPECIFIC PROVISIONS

#### 16. When a parking charge is payable

- (1) Without prejudice to the above provisions where a charge is listed in Column 7 of <u>Schedule 1</u> in relation to a <u>parking place</u> all <u>vehicles</u> present in that <u>parking place</u> during the <u>charging hours</u> will be subject to payment of that parking charge.
- (2) A parking charge is not payable if:
  - (a) a vehicle is an invalid carriage;
  - (b) a <u>vehicle</u> displays in the <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>disabled person's</u> badge;
  - (c) a <u>vehicle</u> is a <u>motor cycle</u>;
  - (d) a <u>vehicle</u> is a <u>liveried vehicle</u> whilst it is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties and the <u>liveried vehicle</u> cannot conveniently wait elsewhere;
  - (e) there is in place for the duration a <u>vehicle</u> is waiting, an <u>active</u> <u>payment session</u>; or
  - (f) a <u>vehicle</u> is displaying in the <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>permit</u> effective for that <u>parking place</u>.

#### 17. Payment of the parking charge

When a <u>parking charge</u> is payable the person in charge of a <u>vehicle</u> shall ensure that upon arrival at a <u>pay and display parking place</u> the <u>parking charge</u> is paid by the purchasing of a <u>pay and display ticket</u>.

#### 18. Method of payment of the parking charge

The <u>parking charge</u> shall be paid by an <u>authorised payment method</u> or as prescribed on the <u>tariff card</u> displayed on the relevant <u>pay and display machine</u>.

#### 19. Display of pay and display ticket

- (1) When a <u>parking charge</u> is payable the person in charge of the <u>vehicle</u> shall ensure that:
  - (a) a valid pay and display ticket is displayed in the relevant position; and
  - (b) the <u>pay and display ticket</u> is clearly displayed for the duration the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting in the <u>pay and display parking place</u> and whilst <u>charging hours</u> are in operation.
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>pay and display</u> <u>parking place</u> during the <u>charging hours</u> unless there is displayed in the

- <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>pay and display ticket</u> effective for that parking place and for the duration the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting in that <u>parking place</u>.
- (3) Where a free period of parking applies during the <u>charging hours</u>, a <u>pay and display ticket</u> must still be obtained and displayed in the <u>relevant position</u> for the <u>duration</u> the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting and whilst <u>charging hours</u> are in operation.
- (4) If at any time while a <u>vehicle</u> is waiting in a <u>pay and display parking place</u> and no <u>pay and display ticket</u> is clearly <u>displayed</u> in the <u>relevant position</u> it shall be iudged that the parking charge has not been paid.

#### 20. Expiry of paid for time

The expiry of the period for which the <u>parking charge</u> has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the hand-held device carried by the civil enforcement officer checking the <u>vehicle</u> is later than the time exhibited on the <u>pay and display</u> ticket displayed on the <u>vehicle</u> unless the hand-held device is found to be faulty.

#### 21. Staying beyond paid for time

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>pay and display parking</u> <u>place</u>:

- (a) beyond the time or expiry of the period for which the <u>parking charge</u> has been paid; or
- (b) for longer than the expiry time displayed on the pay and display ticket.

#### 22. Feeding the meter (pay and display machine)

The <u>maximum stay period</u> applicable to a <u>pay and display parking place</u> as shown in Column 6 of <u>Schedule 1</u> shall take precedence over the time shown on a <u>pay and display ticket</u> in determining whether or not a contravention has occurred.

#### 23. Validity of pay and display tickets

- (1) A <u>pay and display ticket</u> is not transferable from one <u>vehicle</u> to another or from one <u>pay and display parking place</u> to another.
- (2) A <u>pay and display ticket</u> is only valid until the expiry of the date and time for which the <u>parking charge</u> has been paid.
- (3) A <u>pay and display ticket</u> is only valid in the <u>pay and display parking place</u> in respect of which it was issued unless otherwise indicated on a sign in or adjacent to the <u>pay and display parking place</u>.

#### 24. Pay and display machine out of order

If at any time a <u>vehicle</u> is waiting during the <u>charging hours</u> in a <u>pay and display</u> <u>parking place</u> and the nearest <u>pay and display machine</u> is not working, then a <u>pay and display ticket</u> shall be obtained from another <u>pay and display machine</u> within the same parking place if available.

#### **PARKING PERMITS**

#### 25. Purchase of a parking permit

Any person may on application to the <u>Council</u> and at the <u>Council</u>'s discretion be provided with or purchase a <u>permit</u> for a sum to be determined for the period for which the <u>permit</u> is valid.

#### 26. Terms and conditions for parking permits

No person shall cause or permit a <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>parking place</u> displaying a <u>permit</u> contrary to the terms and conditions that apply to that <u>permit</u> at the time that the permit is displayed.

#### **CLOSURE OF CAR PARK & SUSPENSION OF PARKING BAYS**

#### 27. Provision to close a parking place or suspend the use of a parking bay

An <u>authorised officer</u> may close the use of a <u>parking place</u> to the public or suspend the use of a <u>parking bay</u> whenever they consider such closure or suspension reasonably necessary.

#### 28. Display of a closure or suspended bay sign

Where a <u>parking place</u> is closed or a <u>parking bay</u> is suspended, the <u>Council</u> shall display a sign in or near to that <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u> to convey that it is not available for public use.

#### 29. Contravention for parking in a closed car park or in a suspended bay

No person shall cause or permit a <u>vehicle</u> to wait or to <u>load</u> in a <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u> during such period as the <u>Council</u> has closed or suspended that <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u>.

#### 30. Permit for parking in a suspended bay

Nothing in the preceding article shall make it a contravention to cause or permit a <u>vehicle</u> to wait or to <u>load</u> in a <u>parking bay</u> which has been suspended, which displays in the <u>relevant position</u> a valid <u>permit</u> issued by the <u>Council</u> for use in that suspended

<u>parking bay</u> and the <u>vehicle</u> is waiting in accordance with the terms and conditions of the said <u>permit</u>.

#### 31. Authority to use a closed car park

Nothing in this Order shall make it a contravention to cause or permit a <u>vehicle</u> to wait or to <u>load</u> in a <u>parking place</u> that has been closed, provided that written authority from an <u>authorised officer</u> has been obtained in advance and any person relying on that authority abides by any terms set out by the <u>authorised officer</u>.

#### MANNER OF PARKING

#### 32. Parking within bay and not within a restricted area

- (1) No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>parking place</u> where <u>parking bay</u>s are provided unless every part of the <u>vehicle</u> is wholly within the limits of the <u>parking bay</u> and in the position required by the <u>signage</u> for that parking bay.
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait in a <u>restricted area</u> of a parking place.

#### PROHIBITED VEHICLES

#### 33. Prohibited vehicles

No person shall cause or permit any of the following to wait or to <u>load</u> in a <u>parking</u> place:

- (a) a vehicle with an unladen weight of over 3 tonnes; or
- (b) a trailer; or
- (c) a caravan; or
- (d) a <u>vehicle</u> that is not licensed or is without registration plates in accordance with the provisions of Part II of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 or regulations made thereunder; or
- (e) a <u>vehicle</u> for which there is no policy of insurance in place by the driver of the vehicle in accordance with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988; or
- (f) a <u>vehicle</u> that is not roadworthy or does not have a current MOT certificate if one is required by law; or
- (g) a <u>vehicle</u> that is not currently taxed vehicle excise duty or has no exemption in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS AND PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES**

#### 34. Terms & Conditions

- (1) Users of <u>parking places</u> must comply with the terms and conditions displayed in the <u>parking places</u> as amended by the <u>Council</u> from time to time.
- (2) Without prejudice to any other remedy in law, the <u>Council</u> shall not be liable for any loss or damage to any <u>vehicle</u> or to the fittings or contents of any <u>vehicle</u> using a <u>parking place</u>.

#### 35. Idling

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait or <u>load</u> in a <u>parking place</u> with the vehicle's engine running.

#### 36. Prohibition of trade

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to use a <u>parking place</u> in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of goods or services.

#### 37. Camping or overnight sleeping

No person shall use a <u>parking place</u> for the purpose of camping or overnight sleeping.

#### 38. Placing of objects/ depositing of material

No person shall place any object other than a <u>vehicle</u> or deposit any material in a <u>parking place</u> that restricts or prevents the use of a <u>parking place</u> or <u>parking bay</u> or otherwise causes a hazard or a nuisance.

#### 39. Lighting a fire

No person shall light a fire or cause any material to ignite in a <u>parking place</u> other than the proper ignition of a <u>vehicle</u> engine.

#### 40. Obstruction

No person shall cause or permit any <u>vehicle</u> to wait or <u>load</u> in a <u>parking place</u> in such a position as to obstruct or prevent any other <u>vehicle</u> from entering or departing from the <u>parking place</u>.

#### 41. Unacceptable behaviour

No person in a <u>parking place</u> shall exhibit anti-social, threatening, abusive, intimidating, discriminatory or violent behaviour or otherwise cause a danger or a nuisance to other persons or property.

#### **CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT**

#### 42. Contraventions

- (1) Where a contravention of this Order constitutes a parking contravention within the meaning of the Traffic Management Act 2004, the contravention shall be subject to the penalties and procedures provided for by the 2004 Act, including the imposition of a penalty charge in accordance with Schedule 7 of that Act and Regulation 4 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.
- (2) A contravention shall occur for each and every calendar day during which a <u>vehicle</u> is left in contravention of any prohibition or restriction imposed by this Order.

#### 43. Being asked to leave

Without prejudice to any prosecution or penalty charge, any person who carries out an activity prohibited by this Order may be asked to leave the <u>parking place</u> by a civil enforcement officer or an <u>authorised officer</u> without refund of any <u>parking charge</u> or the cost of a permit.

#### 44. Acting with the permission of an authorised officer

An <u>authorised officer</u> may in writing provide time-limited permission to any named person(s) or organisation to act contrary to any article in this Order as may be reasonable acting for and on behalf of the Council as a public body.

#### 45. Removal of a vehicle

Where the <u>Council</u> has reason to believe that a <u>vehicle</u> is waiting illegally, or is obstructively or dangerously parked, abandoned or broken down in a <u>parking place</u>, it may use its powers under Section 99 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or Section 3 of the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978 to move or remove the <u>vehicle</u> and utilise corresponding powers with regards disposal and recovery of its costs.
