

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND
STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2014**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on the 28th February 2014.

B - Kent County Council (Herne Bay) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though:

In the Articles to the Order:

The following to be added to the Table to Article 11 in place of the existing entry –

BREDLANDS LANE	STURRY	On the eastern side between points 28 metres and 72 metres north of the junction with Island Road
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In the Schedules to the Order:

Roads in the Parish of Barham

THE STREET

The following to be added to the First Schedule –

THE STREET from the junction with The Yard to the junction with the access track to Greengates

Roads in the Parish of Blean

CHESTNUT AVENUE

The following to be added to the First Schedule -

CHESTNUT AVENUE On the southern side for 10 metres from the junction with School Lane

SCHOOL LANE

The following to be added to the First Schedule -

SCHOOL LANE On the western side from the junction with Chestnut Avenue for 10 metres in a southerly direction

The following to be added to the Fourth Schedule in place of the existing entry -

FOURTH SCHEDULE

PART C

STREET OR LENGTH OF STREET WHERE PARKING IS RESTRICTED TO VEHICLES OF THE PERMITTED CLASS

Roads in the Parish of Littlebourne

HIGH STREET On the north-eastern side from a point 26 metres north west of the junction with Nargate Street to a point 3 metres north west of a point in line with the common boundary of 11 and 15 High Street.

Roads in the Parish of Sturry

HOMWOOD ROAD On the eastern side from a point in line with the south-eastern flank wall of 16 Homewood Road for a distance of 12 metres in a southerly direction.

The existing Part D to be removed from the Fourth Schedule.

Roads in the Parish of Westbere

PENNINGTON CLOSE

The following to be added to the First Schedule -

PENNINGTON CLOSE On the north-eastern side from the junction with Island Road to 2 metres north-east of a point in line with the south-western flank wall of 1 Pennington Close
