

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL  
(WHITSTABLE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND  
STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 3a) ORDER 2015**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Whitstable) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3a) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> April 2015.

B - Kent County Council (Whitstable) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though:

**In the Articles to the Order:**

*The following to be added to Article 10 in place of the existing table –*

*The following Article to be added to the Order –*

Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle used by personnel in connection with the operations of the National Coastwatch Institution to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in an item in column 4 of the Table on the side of the road specified in that item in column 3 in the road named in the corresponding item in column 2.

**In the Schedules to the Order:**

**BELMONT ROAD**

*The following to be added to Part 2 of the Second Schedule in place of the existing entry -*

BELMONT ROAD      On the southern side from 56 metres east of the junction with the access road to Windsor House to the boundary of Nos. 33/35 Belmont Road

**BRIDGEFIELD ROAD**

*The following to be added to Part 5 of the Second Schedule –*

BRIDGEFIELD ROAD

On the south-western side from 14 metres south-east of the junction with St Swithin's Road to 10 metres north-west of the junction with Kemp Road

## **CROMWELL ROAD**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry –*

- CROMWELL ROAD (2) On the south western, western and north western sides:
- (a) from the junction with Harbour Street to 10 metres south east of the junction with Westgate Terrace
  - (b) from a point 3 metres south east of a point in line with the common boundary of 186 and 188 Cromwell Road to a point 6 metres south east of a point in line with the north western flank wall of 197 Cromwell Road.
  - (c) from a point 14 metres north east of the junction with Regent Street to the junction with Oxford Street

*The following to be added to Part 2 of the Second Schedule in place of the existing entry –*

- CROMWELL ROAD
- (2) On the south western, western and north western sides
- (a) from a point 10 metres south east of the junction with Westgate Terrace to a point 3 metres south east of a point in line with the common boundary of 186 and 188 Cromwell Road;
  - (b) from a point 6 metres south east of a point in line with the north western flank wall of 197 Cromwell Road to a point 14 metres north east of the junction with Regent Street

## **DANIELS COURT**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule –*

- DANIELS COURT On the southern side from Island Wall to the southern flank wall of 6 Daniels Court

## **LONG REACH CLOSE**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry –*

- LONG REACH CLOSE
- (1) On the northern side
- (a) from the junction with Borstal Hill to a point 6 metres west of the western boundary of 6 Long Reach Close

(b) from the boundary of Nos 10 & 12 for 35 metres in a westerly direction

(2) On the southern side (a) from the junction with Borstal Hill to a point in line with the eastern boundary of 1 Long Reach Close

(b) between 32 metres west and 10 metres east of Old Farm Close

### **VICTORIA MEWS**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule –*

VICTORIA MEWS On both sides for the entire length of all parts of Victoria Mews

### **WESTGATE TERRACE**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry -*

WESTGATE TERRACE

(2) On the southern side

(a) for 9 metres from the junction with Cromwell Road

(b) between points 10 metres west and 10 metres east of the junction with Reservoir Road

(c) for 10 metres either side of the junction with Westmeads Road

### **WESTMEADS ROAD**

*The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry -*

WESTMEADS ROAD On both sides

(a) for 10 metres from the junction with Westgate Terrace

(b) between points 10 metres north and 10 metres south of the junction with Diamond Road

(c) between points 10 metres north and 10 metres south of the junction with Wheatley Road

(d) from the junction with Railway Avenue for a distance of 14 metres in a northerly direction.
