

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL  
(CANTERBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND  
STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 3a) ORDER 2015**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3a) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 7<sup>th</sup> April 2015.

B - Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though:

**In the Articles to the Order:**

*The following to be added to the Articles in Part F -*

SAVE as provided in Part G of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds five tonnes to wait between the hours of 7pm to midnight and midnight to 7am, in any of the parking places specified in the Table to Article \*\*\*\*

## **ROPER ROAD**

*The following to be added to Part A of the Seventh Schedule in place of the existing entry –*

- ROPER ROAD
- (1) On the south-eastern side between points the following distances north-east of the junction with St Dunstan's Street
    - (i) 14 metres and 27 metres
    - (ii) 58 metres and 73 metres;
    - (iii) 79 metres and 101 metres;
    - (iv) 127 metres and 142 metres;
    - (v) 152 metres and 172 metres;
    - (vi) 182 metres and 187 metres;
    - (vii) 196 metres and 241 metres.
