

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND
STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 3a) ORDER 2015**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 3a) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 7th April 2015.

B - Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though:

In the Schedules to the Order:

Roads in the Parish of Barham:

THE STREET

The following to be added to the First Schedule -

- THE STREET (1) On both sides from the junction with Valley Road to the boundary of Bridge Cottage and Clare Cottage, The Street
- (2) On the southern side from the junction with The Yard to the junction with the access track to Greengates

Roads in the Parish of Chartham

ASHFORD ROAD

The following to be added to the First Schedule –

- ASHFORD ROAD On the north-western side from 25 metres north-east of the boundary of KAP and Lipscombe Volvo for 82 metres in a north-easterly direction

STATION ROAD

The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry -

STATION ROAD

(1) On the eastern side from the junction with A28 Ashford Road to a point 9 metres south of a point in line with the main northern flank wall of The Glebe.

(2) On the western side

(a) from the junction with A28 Ashford Road to a point 32 metres south of the junction with The Green.

(b) from the junction with Church Lane for a distance of 120 metres in a south-westerly direction

(3) On both sides for the entire length of the western part of Station Road leading from the level crossing to the junction with Ashford Road

Roads in the Parish of Sturry

RISDON CLOSE

The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry –

RISDON CLOSE from 3 metres north-west of the common boundary of 7 and 8 Risdon Close to 3 metres south-west of the northern boundary of 9 Risdon Close
