# The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011

The Canterbury City Council (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') in exercise of powers contained in Sections 32 and 35 of and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers in that behalf and with the consent of the Kent County Council given under Section 39(3) of the Act of 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:
  - 1.01 'Access Card' means a pre-paid card for access to Residents' car parks at Black Griffin Lane, St Peter's Grove, Southern Way and Tower Way, Canterbury subject to payment of a £30 refundable deposit;
  - 1.02 'Administration Fee' means a fee of £10 (inclusive of VAT) charged for the transfer, loss, destruction and replacement of any Parking Permit or pre-paid card and any refund transaction associated with any permit;
  - 1.03 'Appropriate Manner' in relation to the display of prepaid tickets and permits means in such a position:
    - (a) inside the vehicle and in such a manner that date and time symbols or permit details thereon are clearly visible from the front or near side of the vehicle:
    - (b) attached to a trailer around a beam as close to the towing hitch as possible;
  - 1.04 'Blue Badge' shall mean a badge issued under the provisions for parking concessions for disabled and blind people as provided by the Department of Transport;
  - 1.05 'Boat Trailer' means a trailer as defined in the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986, which has been constructed or adapted solely for the purposes of carrying a boat or personal water craft;
  - 1.06 'Business Users Parking Bay' means a bay marked with white lines onto the surface of a parking place and marked with appropriate signage which is reserved for the use of holders of Business Users' reserved space parking permits only;
  - 1.07 'Canterbury Business Users Permit' means a permit available to people who work within the Canterbury City Centre zone and who can prove that they regularly need to use their vehicle during the working day for the purposes of their work or the business of their employer to park in any Canterbury pay and display car parks except North Lane, Pound Lane, Queningate and Watling Street car parks at a fee of £605 inclusive of VAT, improper use of which will render the permit void;
  - 1.08 'Canterbury Business Users Reserved Space Permit' means a permit available to people who work within the Canterbury City Centre zone and who can prove that they regularly need to use their vehicle during the working day for the purposes of their work or the business of their employer, to park their vehicle in Hawk's Lane and St John's Lane car parks and also in the bays

marked for that purpose in Pound Lane, Rosemary Lane and St Radigund's car parks at a fee of £766 inclusive of VAT; improper use of which will render the permit void;

- 1.09 'Car' means the same as motor car;
- 1.10 'Canterbury pre-purchased hotel and guest house visitor parking permit' means a concessionary permit for use in Castle Row, Holman's Meadow, Longport, Millers Field, North Lane, Pound Lane, Queningate, St Radigund's and Station Road West car parks to provide parking from 6pm until 10am the following morning subject to a minimum purchase of ten permits at a cost of £1.50 per permit or a 24 hour parking permit for the same car parks at a cost of £5 per permit subject to a minimum purchase of 10 permits and a 10% discount for purchases of 50 or more £5 permits, (both permits inclusive of VAT) available only to hoteliers and guest house owners within the City Centre of Canterbury as approved by the Head of Planning and Regeneration; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.11 'Caravan' means a trailer constructed to include living accommodation and equipment;
- 1.12 'Castle Street car park business users permit' means a permit available to people who work within the Canterbury City Centre zone and who can prove they regularly need to use their vehicle during the working day for the purposes of their work or the business of their employer, to park their vehicle in bays marked for that purpose in Castle Street car park between 7am and 11pm on any day at a fee of £715 inclusive of VAT; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.13 'Castle Street car park residents' permit' means a non transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability, proof of residency, a copy of a valid driving licence; a vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle and if the vehicle is not owned by the applicant, the written consent of the owners, for residents who live in the vicinity of the Castle Street car park for the parking of a motor car in that car park at any time, at a fee of £526 inclusive of VAT; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.14 'Central or Central Premium car parks' means a car park as described in the Second Schedule to this Order, where the maximum period for which parking can be purchased does not normally exceed 12 hours (or any other period determined) and that an intervening period of one hour must elapse between parking events;
- 1.15 'Coach' means a passenger carrying vehicle, exceeding 5.5m in length and capable of carrying more than 16 passengers;
- 1.16 'Commercial Vehicle' m eans any mechanically propelled vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of goods;
- 1.17 'Current' in relation to a vehicle licence means valid on the relevant date;
- 1.18 'Disabled parking bay' means a bay within a parking place identified by surface markings and or other signage, for the parking at any time of vehicles displaying valid disabled persons badges only for a maximum period of three hours; free of charge other than in Pay on Foot car parks and multistorey car parks identified in clause 1.53; after which payment must be made

in accordance with charges applicable in that parking place. Payment will not be required in the Orange Street car park, Canterbury and during the day on Mondays to Saturdays in the Chapel Street car park, Herne Bay;

- 1.19 'Disabled parking permit' means a permit issued by the Council in exceptional circumstances to those who live and/or work within the district and are either in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) (Mobility Component at the Higher Rate) or are over 65 without DLA but with a blue badge and attendance allowance exempting them from the three hour time restriction subject to an administration charge of £12.50 (inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void; applicants for these permits must attend in person when making their application and show a current valid Blue Badge;
- 1.20 'Disabled Person's Badge' has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 (as amended);
- 1.21 'Disabled Person's Vehicle' has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 (as amended);
- 1.22 'Driver' in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it entered the parking place;
- 1.23 'Entry Barrier System' means the equipment located at the entrance to car parks to control access by the issue of Parking tickets and reading of Parking Cards; or other card operated systems;
- 1.24 'Exit Barrier System' means the equipment located at the exit to car parks to control egress activated by Parking Cards or tickets only;
- 1.25 'Hackney Carriage' means any hackney carriage for the time being licensed by the Council;
- 1.26 'Heavy Motor Car' means any vehicle as defined in Section 136(3) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.27 'Herne Bay Business Users Permit' means a permit for parking in all town centre Pay and Display car parks in Herne Bay at a cost of £102 per annum (inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.28 'Herne Bay Market Traders Permit' means a permit for the parking of Market Traders' vehicles in William Street car park, Herne Bay at a cost of £32 per annum (inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.29 'Herne Bay pre-purchased hotel and guest house visitor parking permit' means a concessionary 24 hour permit for use in Beach Street and Market Street car parks at a cost of £1.50 (inclusive of VAT) per permit subject to a minimum purchase of 10 permits available only to hoteliers and guest house owners within Herne Bay as approved by the Head of Planning and Regeneraton; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.30 'Herne Bay Residents' Permit' means a non transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Herne Bay, belonging to the Council, at any time, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;

- 1.31 'Linear Tariff' means a system of parking payment with a set minimum and maximum payment allowing parking to be paid for by any payment of any amount between the minimum and maximum values;
- 1.32 'Lost pay on foot ticket charge' refers to tickets for parking in the Castle Street and Whitefriars car parks for which a charge of £20 (inclusive of VAT) for replacement will be made;
- 1.33 'Lost Park and Ride ticket' refers to a ticket for parking at any Park and Ride site for which a charge of £10 (inclusive of VAT) for replacement will be made:
- 1.34 'Marked Bay' means a bay marked on the surface of a parking place within which a vehicle may park;
- 1.35 'Market Traders' Permit' means a permit for the parking of Market Traders' vehicles in Longport car park, Canterbury on Wednesdays or Fridays only at a cost of £175 per annum; and on Wednesdays and Fridays at a cost of £350 per annum (both inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.36 'Member Parking Permit' means a permit issued to a Member of the City Council by the Head of Planning and Regeneration for use strictly in the performance of Council business; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.37 'Minibus' means a small passenger carrying motor vehicle not exceeding 5.5m in length capable of carrying more than eight but not more than 16 passengers whether or not the same is either a motor car or a heavy motor car as the case may be;
- 1.38 'Motor Car' means any motor car within the meaning of Section 136(2) of the Act of 1984 with the exception of a commercial vehicle;
- 1.39 'Motor Caravan' means a motor vehicle not exceeding 5.5m in length which provides fixed sleeping arrangements whether or not the same is either a motor car or a heavy motor car as the case may be;
- 1.40 'Motor Cycle' means any vehicle as defined in Section 136(4) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.41 'Motor Cycle Bay' means a parking bay marked out on the surface of the car park that is reserved for the parking of solo motorcycles only;
- 1.42 'Motor Vehicle' means any vehicle as defined in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.43 'Neptune car park parking card' means a prepaid decrementing card, available to commercial fishermen and other regular users for the parking of cars and trailers in the Neptune car park, Herne Bay, obtainable from the Council at a 50% discount rate on the standard fee for those car parks and at a 75% discount rate for existing users from the Herne Bay Angling Association (as at 8 February 2007).
- 1.44 'Outer car park' means a car park as described in the Second Schedule to this Order, the maximum period for which a vehicle may wait not to exceed 24 hours:

- 1.45 'Owner' has the same meaning as in the Act of 1984;
- 1.46 'Park and Ride' means a service provided by the Council to park and obtain bus travel to the city centre;
- 1.47 'Park and Ride payment card' means a prepaid card for the parking of a motor vehicle at any Park and Ride car park belonging to the Council at a cost of £10 (inclusive of VAT) per card providing users with a 20% discount on charges;
- 1.48 'Parking Bay' means a bay marked with white lines on the surface of a parking place within which a vehicle may park;
- 1.49 'Pay and Display Payment Card' means a pre-paid card for the parking of a motor vehicle in any pay and display car park belonging to the Council: obtainable from the Council, at a cost of £10 (inclusive of VAT) per card, providing users with a 10% discount on parking charges at pay and display car parks;
- 1.50 'Parking Place' means any car park provided by the Council off a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place;
- 1.51 'Pay and Display' means a system of payment for parking of motor vehicles used at car parks where pre-paid tickets must be obtained and be displayed in the appropriate manner within the vehicle by adhering to the front windscreen or some other conspicuous place within or on the vehicle; such tickets to be non-transferrable to any other vehicle;
- 1.52 'Pay by phone' means a parking payment system enabling payment for parking in all pay and display car parks to be made by the use of a mobile phone through a system operated, administered and maintained by Cobalt Telephone Technologies Ltd (the Service Provider) and known as 'Ringo', for a trial period of 18 months;
  - Each participating car park will be assigned its own unique identifying number, the 'Location Identification Number'. Customers using this system are exempt from the requirement to display a pay and display ticket.
- 1.53 'Pay on Foot' means a system of payment for parking of motor vehicles used at car parks that are not pay and display car parks. The exemptions for Blue Badge users for payment of charges do not apply in Pay on Foot car parks, namely, any Park and Ride car park and the Castle Street and Whitefriars car parks;
- 1.54 'Pay Station' means the equipment installed at Park and Ride sites and Pay on Foot car parks to enable payment of the appropriate fee to be made. The Pay Station will read the ticket, indicate the amount to be paid and enable it to be used to exit the car park;
- 1.55 'Prepaid Ticket' means a ticket obtained from an automatic ticket issuing machine in pay and display car parks for collecting charges installed at any of the parking places referred to in the Second Schedule hereto. Any ticket valid for overnight parking in Canterbury car parks will be deemed to be valid until 10am the morning after the day of purchase;

- 1.56 'Private Light Goods Vehicle' means a motor vehicle as defined in Section 138(3) of the Act of 1984 as a goods vehicle but not exceeding 1.5 tonnes unladen weight or in the alternative as specified in Schedule 1 to this order in relation to certain car parks where different weight requirements apply;
- 1.57 'Proof of residency' means proof that a person is in permanent occupation or continual occupation for a considerable time in relation to a property, that property being the person's settled or usual abode;
- 1.58 'Public Service Vehicle' means a vehicle which is constructed or adapted to carry more than eight passengers;
- 1.59 'Registered Keeper' means the person in whose name the vehicle was registered under the Vehicle (Excise and Registration) Act 1994;
- 1.60 'Release fee' means a charge of £25 (inclusive of VAT) to release a vehicle from any car park out of hours when attended by the Parking Services standby service; the charge for the Castle Street car park to be £50 (inclusive of VAT);
- 1.61 "Relevant Date" means the date upon which any vehicle is or was parked in any parking place referred to in this Order or upon which any event occurs or occurred in breach of any of the provisions of this Order or to which this Order relates:
- 1.62 'Relevant Position' means:

#### In the case of a disabled person's badge -

The badge must be displayed on top of the dashboard or facia panel of a vehicle with the front of the badge (ie the side showing the wheelchair-user symbol) facing forward so that the relevant details are legible from outside of the vehicle. If the vehicle does not have a dashboard or facia panel you must exhibit the badge in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the relevant details are legible from outside the vehicle.

#### In the case of any other badge as follows -

- i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
- ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle;

In all cases the details on the front of the badge must be clearly visible for inspection;

- 1.63 'Resident' means a person whose main or principle residence is located within the Canterbury district;
- 1.64 'Residents' car park' means a car park available only for the use of holders of residents' parking permits for the identified car park;
- 1.65 'Resident's Off Peak Permit' means a permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability, proof of residency, a copy of a valid driving licence; a

vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle and if the vehicle is not owned by the applicant, the written consent of the owners, for residents who live in the vicinity of the car park for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Canterbury, belonging to the Council, except for Watling Street, Castle Street, Whitefriars, Kingsmead Leisure Centre and the Park and Ride car parks between the hours of 5pm on one day and 9am on the next and all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;

- 1.66 'Residents' Off-Street Permit' means a non transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability, proof of residency, a copy of a valid driving licence; a vehicle registration document or insurance certificate for the vehicle and if the vehicle is not owned by the applicant, the written consent of the owners, for residents who live in the vicinity of the car park for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Canterbury, belonging to the Council, except for Watling Street, Castle Street, Whitefriars, Kingsmead Leisure Centre and the Park and Ride car parks, at any time, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void: where a property address has off-street parking provision, a residents' off-street permit may not always be issued to an applicant from that address;
- 1.67 'Residents' Parking Permit' means a non transferable permit for a specified vehicle for use in a specified car park for residents who live in the vicinity of a specified car park and have no off-street parking provision associated with their property, for the parking of a motor car in residents' car parking spaces, belonging to the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void. The number of permits issued per household will be entirely at the Council's discretion;
- 1.68 'School Lane, Herne Residents' Permit' means a non transferable permit for a specified vehicle for use in a School Lane car park for residents who live in the vicinity of that car park and have no off-street parking provision associated with their property. Improper use will render the permit void. The number of permits issued per household will be entirely at the Council's discretion:
- 1.69 'Solo Motor Cycle' means a motor bicycle without a sidecar or trailer;
- 1.70 'Staff Parking Permit' means a permit issued to a member of staff of the City Council, Active Life or an East Kent Shared Service; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.71 'Station Road West car park rail user permit' means a permit available from the City Council, subject to availability, for rail season ticket holders to park their vehicle on Mondays to Fridays in Station Road West car park at a fee of £80 per month inclusive of VAT, improper use of which will render the permit void:
- 1.72 'Temporary Car Parking Permit' means a permit issued by the Head of Planning and Regeneration for parking requirements of guests or visitors to the City Council or to those given special authorisation by it; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.73 'Trailer' means a trailer as defined in Section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;
- 1.74 'Valid Pay and Display ticket' means a ticket issued from an automatic ticket issuing machine within a Pay and Display car park, that shows the time the

ticket was purchased, expiry date and time, registration index number of the vehicle, the fee paid and the machine number, such tickets to be non-transferrable:

- 1.75 'Whitstable Business Users Permit' means a permit for parking in public car parks in Whitstable, with the exception of Whitstable Harbour and Whitstable Leisure Centre car parks, at a cost of £102 per annum (inclusive of VAT); improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.76 'Whitstable Harbour Business Permit' means a permit for the parking of motor vehicles in specified parking bays within the harbour, issued subject to the approval of the Harbour Master and at a cost of £70 per permit (inclusive of VAT) or such other amount as may, from time to time, be approved; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.77 'Whitstable Market Traders Permit' means a permit for the parking of Market Traders' vehicles in Gorrell Tank car park, Whitstable at a cost of £32 per annum (inclusive of VAT): improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.78 'Whitstable pre-purchased hotel and guest house visitor parking permit' means a concessionary 24 hour permit for use in Gorrell Tank, Keam's Yard, Middle Wall and Victoria Street car parks at a cost of £1.50 (inclusive of VAT) per permit subject to a minimum purchase of 10 permits available only to hoteliers and guest house owners within Whitstable as approved by the Head of Planning and Regeneration; improper use of which will render the permit void:
- 1.79 'Whitstable Residents' Off Street Parking Permit' means a non-transferable permit for a specified vehicle, provided subject to availability and proof of residency, for residents who live in the vicinity for the parking of a motor car in all public car parks in Whitstable belonging to the Council, with the exception of Whitstable Harbour and Whitstable Leisure Centre car parks, at any time, obtainable from the Council; improper use of which will render the permit void;
- 1.80 'Windsor House Residents' Permit' means a non-transferable permit available to residents of Windsor House for the parking of a motor car in Windsor House Residents' car park.
- 1.81 'Windsor House Residents' Visitor Permit' means a permit made available to residents for the use of their visitors when parking in Windsor House Residents car park.
- 1.82 'Worshippers' Permit' means a permit for a specified vehicle available to residents of Canterbury district, to Quakers resident in Swale district, and to the Anglican Catholic Church members resident in the Ashford district to park without charge when attending, on a regular basis, a service of worship on any day, the permit providing parking at the nearest available car park and obtainable from the Council with an administrative charge of £30 (inclusive of VAT) per new permit issued being applied.
- Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place or any part thereof when such parking place or part thereof is required for any purpose of the Council or for any purpose authorised by the Council.
- 3. Each of the places specified in column 1 of the First Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such vehicles or classes of vehicles in such positions and on such days and

during such hours as are specified in relation to that parking place in the said Schedule.

- 4. Where, in the First Schedule to this Order, a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, or during a specified period (including any provisions specifying particular positions or periods for specified classes of vehicle) no vehicle shall be parked in that parking place otherwise than in strict accordance with such provisions.
- 5. No vehicle shall be left in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the First Schedule to this Order in relation to that parking place.
- No parking place or any part thereof shall be used when such parking place or part thereof has been closed by the Council in accordance with Article 2 hereof.
- No Hackney Carriage shall use a parking place unless approved by the Head of Planning and Regeneration.
- 8. No vehicle shall use a parking place unless there is, in relation to the use of that vehicle by any person who drives it within that parking place, such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988.
- 9. Where, in a parking place, signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:
  - (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
  - (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place;

no vehicle may be driven:

- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated; or
- (ii) in a direction other than that specified;

as the case may be.

- 10. No vehicle shall park on any yellow line within a car park nor cause any obstruction.
- 11. Except in accordance with any right of way which may exist or with the permission of the Council or of any person duly authorised by the Council:
  - no parking place may be used as a means of passage for proceeding from one road to another road;
  - (b) no vehicle may be driven in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place, changing its position in the parking place or departing from the parking place.
- The engine of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall be stopped as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and the engine shall not be started except when the position of the vehicle in the parking place is about to be changed or the vehicle is about to depart from the parking place.

- 13. No horn or other similar instrument may be sounded on a vehicle using a parking place except when the position of the vehicle in the parking place is about to be changed or the vehicle is about to depart from the parking place.
- 14. No vehicle shall be used while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any thing to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of the skill or services of any person PROVIDED ALWAYS that this Article shall not be deemed to prohibit the use of any vehicle in a parking place for or in connection with the sale of any thing or commodity in any case where the written consent of the Council has been obtained.
- 15. No vehicle shall be sold, offered or exhibited for sale whilst it is in a parking place.
- 16. No work of building, construction, cleaning, engineering, maintenance or repair of any nature shall be carried out in a parking place, except such as may be necessary to enable a vehicle to be moved from the parking place, nor shall any plant, equipment or materials be deposited in a parking place other than with the written consent of the Head of Planning and Regeneration and payment of the appropriate fee, £15 per parking space or part thereof for a single day; £75 for any period up to one week (both fees inclusive of VAT) or such fee as may be determined by the Head of Planning and Regeneration thereafter.
- 17. No vehicle left in a parking place may be used for sleeping, camping, eating or cooking purposes.
- 18. No trailer shall use a parking place, unless otherwise stated.
- 19. No minibus or motor caravan shall use a parking place unless otherwise stated.
- 20. Whenever a vehicle occupies any of the parking places mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, excluding any Pay on Foot or Park and Ride car parks, a prepaid ticket or a combination of prepaid tickets shall be purchased when the vehicle enters the said parking place in respect of the period (not being longer than the maximum period permitted in that parking place) during which the vehicle is intended to be parked in that parking place calculated in accordance with Column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto and such prepaid ticket or tickets shall be exhibited on the vehicle in the appropriate manner throughout the said period, unless a valid permit (as described in Article 1 of this Order) is on display so it can be clearly seen by a Civil Enforcement Officer, such tickets to be non-transferrable to any other vehicle, unless the trial 'Pay by Phone' system has been used.
- 21. Where the parking of a vehicle in any parking place is authorised by a prepaid ticket or tickets under the provisions of Article 20 hereof such vehicle shall not be left in the parking place for longer than the period permitted by the prepaid ticket or tickets, such tickets to be non-transferrable to any other vehicle.
- 22. (1) If there is a contravention of any of the provisions of Articles 3 to 21 inclusive to this Order then, and in any such case, a penalty charge (hereinafter referred to as 'the penalty charge') shall be payable to the Council under and subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, the amount of the Charge being any amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by Members of the Council.
  - (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge may have been incurred it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer/Supervisor employed by the Council, to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a notice which shall include the following particulars:

- (a) Vehicle registration number
- (b) Make of vehicle
- (c) Colour of vehicle
- (d) Detailed location of vehicle (for example meter bay number, residents' bay number, name of car park, or other description of parking place)
- (e) Contravention code and description of contravention
- (f) Time of issue
- (g) Date of the contravention and date of issue
- (h) Penalty Charge Notice number
- (i) Civil Enforcement Officer's number
- (i) Civil Enforcement Officer's signature

Provided that the requirements of this paragraph shall not apply to a breach of this Order if the vehicle is removed from the parking place before the notice can be completed or affixed to the vehicle and that such Penalty Charge Notice may be challenged by the recipient/registered keeper through an independent appeals tribunal managed by the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or its successor in title.

- (3) Subject to Paragraph (4) hereof the penalty charge shall be paid to the Council in cash or by credit card, cheque, banker's draft, money order or postal order in each case crossed and made payable to Canterbury City Council which shall be delivered or sent by post to the Director of Finance, Canterbury City Council, Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent CT1 1YW on or before the end of a period of 28 days from the day on which the penalty charge was incurred.
- (4) In the event of payment being received by the Director of Finance as aforesaid within 14 days of the day on which the penalty charge was incurred (provided that if the fourteenth day falls upon a day on which the department is closed the period within which payment of the penalty charge as provided herein shall be extended until 5pm on the next full day on which the said department is open whether or not this date is shown on the notice left on the vehicle indicating that a penalty charge is payable) the amount of the penalty charge shall be reduced to an amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by Members of the Council; the said payment shall be accepted in full settlement of the penalty charge payable under the terms hereof.
- (5) Payment of the penalty charge (whether or not the same is reduced under the provisions of Paragraph (4) hereof) will not exonerate any person from payment of any expenses recoverable in respect of the removal and disposal of the vehicle pursuant to the provisions of Articles 27, 28, 29 and 30 of this Order and any statutory provisions for the time being in force or from any claim to damages which the Council may have in respect of damage incurred in relation to the parking of the vehicle howsoever arising.
- (6) If the penalty charge is not paid after a minimum of 56 days and a Charge Certificate is issued, the penalty charge payable will be increased to an amount recommended by the Secretary of State for the time being and approved by Members of the Council.
- 23. Nothing in Articles 5 or 20 shall apply in respect of a disabled person's vehicle in pay and display car parks which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority if the vehicle is left for no longer than three hours without payment being made.

#### 24. Nothing in Article 20 shall apply in respect of:

- (a) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Resident's Off Peak Permit if the vehicle is parked between 5pm on one day and 9am on the following day or all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays in any of the parking places referred to in the Second Schedule hereto except for Watling Street, Castle Street, Whitefriars, Kingsmead Leisure Centre and Park and Ride car parks;
- (b) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Residents' Off Street Permit if the vehicle is parked in any of the parking places referred to in the Second Schedule hereto except for Watling Street, Castle Street, Whitefriars, Kingsmead Leisure Centre and Park and Ride car parks;
- (c) a public service vehicle which displays in the relevant position a permit issued in advance by the appropriate office of the Council if the said vehicle is parked in the St Radigund's car park;
- (d) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Residents' Parking Permit if the vehicle is parked at any time in the car park named on the Residents' Parking Permit in accordance with Article 1 of this Order in the Albin's, Whitstable; Bisson's, Whitstable; Black Griffin Lane, Canterbury; Essex Street, Whitstable; Fountain Street, Whitstable; New Street, Whitstable; Notley Street, Canterbury; Orange Street, Canterbury; Regent Street, Whitstable; Rye's, Whitstable; Salt Marsh Lane, Whitstable; St Peter's Grove, Canterbury; Southern Way, Canterbury; Sydenham Street, Whitstable; Tower Way, Canterbury and Windsor House, Whitstable car parks;
- a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Business Users Reserved Spaces or Business Users Permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order;
- (f) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Herne Bay or Whitstable Residents' off street parking permit if the vehicle is parked at any time in any public car park in Herne Bay or Whitstable, with the exception of the Whitstable Harbour and the Whitstable Leisure Centre car parks;
- (g) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current School Lane, Herne Residents Parking Permit if the vehicle is parked in the School Lane, Herne car park;
- (h) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Canterbury, Herne Bay or Whitstable Pre-Purchased Hotel and Guest House Visitors Parking permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order;
- a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Worshippers' car parking permit if the vehicle is parked at any time in the nominated car park;
- a market traders vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner either a current Canterbury, Herne Bay or Whitstable Market Traders permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order;

- a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a Whitstable Harbour Business Permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order in the Whitstable Harbour car park;
- a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Castle Street car park business users or residents permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order;
- a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Station Road West car park rail user permit if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order;
- (n) a motor vehicle which displays in the appropriate manner a current Windsor House Residents permit or visitor voucher if the vehicle is parked in accordance with Article 1 of this Order.
- Nothing in Article 20 shall apply in respect of a motor cycle which is parked in a section of a parking place reserved for the parking of a motor cycle free of charge.
- 26. It is hereby directed under the provisions of paragraph (c) of Sub-section (3) of Section 35A of the Act of 1984 that the provisions of Sub-sections (4), (5) and (6) of Section 47 of the Act of 1984 shall apply to this Order save that references in the said Sub-section to "this section" shall be construed as references to Section 35A of the Act of 1984.
- When a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 14, 17, 18 or 19 of this Order a Police Constable or a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place.
- When a vehicle is left in a parking place contrary to the provisions of the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978 and subject to the appropriate notice being served, the said vehicle may be removed. Similarly, when a vehicle is left in a parking place contrary to the provisions of this Order and subject to the authorisation of the DVLA, the said vehicle may be removed.
- 29. Any person removing a vehicle by virtue of the last preceding Article of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it as aforesaid.
- When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 29 of this Order, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- Where, in this Order, the hours of operation and/or the maximum period for which a vehicle may wait are stated, no vehicle shall exceed the stated period unless with the written authority of the Head of Planning and Regeneration.
- 32. (a) Save as hereinafter provided, a Residents' Parking Permit shall not be assigned or transferred by an Owner to any other person but may be surrendered at any time to the Council when the Owner shall be entitled to receive the refund of a sum representing the full month's unexpired portion of the Residents' Parking Permit, subject to the amount refunded being a minimum of £20 (inclusive of VAT).

- (b) In the event of (i) any Owner wishing to transfer a Residents' Parking Permit from one motor car to another or (ii) any Owner seeking a replacement of a Residents' Parking Permit following its loss or destruction; then on application to the Council and upon payment of an Administration Fee such transfer or replacement will be effected with any Residents' Parking Permit previously issued to such Owner deemed to be surrendered and of no effect.
- (c) The Council shall be entitled to terminate all rights granted by the Residents' Parking Permit if at any time there is any contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order and in any such circumstances the Owner shall not be entitled to any refund whatsoever without prejudice to any other right of action the Council may have whether under this Order or otherwise.
- (d) Where the owner of a vehicle has been issued with a Residents' Parking Permit for a site with barrier controlled access arrangements, an access card to the barrier will be provided by the Council subject to the payment of a £30 deposit. The owner will be responsible for the safe keeping of the said access card, which, if lost or damaged, will render the owner liable for all costs of replacement. The deposit shall be refundable upon the safe return of the said access card.
- (e) Where a person has outstanding Penalty Charge Notices, no permit shall be issued until all debts have been discharged.
- 33. The registered keeper at the relevant date shall, pursuant to the provisions of Section 35A(3)(a) of the Act of 1984, be deemed to be responsible for any contravention of or non-compliance with this Order unless the registered keeper can prove in any proceedings:
  - (a) that the registered keeper was neither the owner nor the keeper of the vehicle on the relevant date; or
  - (b) that the vehicle was being used on that date without the consent of the registered keeper;

Provided that the Council shall be entitled to proceed against any other person whom the Council proves to be either the owner or the keeper or the driver of the vehicle at the relevant date instead of the registered keeper.

- 34. The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2010 is hereby revoked.
- 36. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 2011 and may be cited as the "Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2011".
