**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES)
(TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
(AMENDMENT NO 2) ORDER 2011**

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the Order is to further amend the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) Order 2010 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in the rural parishes in the district of Canterbury.

810	Sturry Hill	New double yellow lines at the junction with Old School Close.
860	Howfield Lane	New double yellow lines at the junction with Bigbury Road
999R	Rentain Road	Extend disabled persons' parking bay outside 25 and 27 Rentain Road

The order was made on 31st May and comes into force on 1st July. Full details are contained in the Order which, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for making the order, the relevant maps and a copy of any orders amended by the order may be examined at the Canterbury City Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made make application to the High Court for this purpose.
