

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND
STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 1a) ORDER 2012**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 1a) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on the 29th day of August 2012.

B - Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011 shall have effect as though:

In the Schedules to the Order

Roads in the Parish of Blean

TYLER HILL ROAD

The following to be added to the First Schedule -

TYLER HILL ROAD

On the northern side from the junction with the access road west of 7 Tyler Hill Road to 3 metres east of a point in line with the western flank wall of 7 Tyler Hill Road

The following to be added to the Table in Article 30 - Parking places for disabled persons' vehicles only -

TYLER HILL ROAD - BLEAN - north - From 3 metres east of a point in line with the western flank wall of 7 Tyler Hill Road for 5 metres in an easterly direction

Roads in the Parish of Sturry

MILL ROAD

The following to be added to the First Schedule in place of the existing entry -

MILL ROAD

(1) On both sides from the junction with Island Road to the level crossing

(2) On the eastern and south-eastern side from a point 34 metres north east of the junction with Fordwich Road to a point 1 metre south west of the north-eastern boundary of 32 Mill Road

(3) On the north-western side from the junction with High Street to a point in line with the western building line of 7 Mill Road

(4) On the southern side from a point in line with the common boundary of 10 and 12 Mill Road to a point in line with the common boundary of 14 and 16 Mill Road
