

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, CITY OF CANTERBURY)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE)(AMENDMENT NO 2a)
ORDER 2012**

The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

A - This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Various Roads, City of Canterbury) (Prohibition of Stopping on Footway or Verge) (Amendment No 2a) Order 2012 and shall come into operation on the 29th day of August, 2012

B - Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Various Roads, City of Canterbury) (Prohibition of Stopping on Footway or Verge) Order 2010 shall have effect as though:
