as described in the Order and which also empowers parking attendants to issue penalty

charge notices in respect of those offences) by the inclusion of the parking places

specified and described in Part 1 of the schedule to this Notice as additional parking

places in Schedule 2 of the said Order and further to include each of the said parking

places and the provisions of part II of the Schedule to this Notice as additions to that

part of Schedule 3 of the Order specifying the parking places in Carmarthen. The

consequence of the amendment will make these additional parking places subject to the

provisions of The County of Carmarthenshire (Off Street Parking Places) Consolidation

Order 2004 and will be subject to the charges specified in Part II of the schedule to this

notice.

The Order will come into operation on the 5th day of June, 2006 and a copy of the Order,

together with a map showing the parking places may be examined at the offices of the

Carmarthenshire County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen during normal office

hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision

contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on

the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not

been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the date on which

the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
