


THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (LLANELLI)
(WAITING RESTRICTION AND STREET PARKING PLACES)
CONSOLIDATION (VARIATION NO. 7) ORDER 2006

THE CARMARTHENSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") as amended and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other powers then enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with the Road Traffic Act 1991, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The County of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli) (Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 ("the Consolidation Order") is hereby varied by the attachment thereto of the plan attached to this Order which has the effect of imposing on such part of the road identified and for the period identified in the plan attached to this Order for the prohibition of waiting at any time
2. The Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of December Two Thousand and Six and may be cited as The County of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli) (Waiting Restriction and Street Parking Places) Consolidation (Variation No. 7) Order 2006.

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNTY OF CARMARTHENSHIRE (LLANELLI) (WAITING RESTRICTION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) CONSOLIDATION (VARIATION NO. 7) ORDER 2006

NOTICE is hereby given that on the 4th day of December, 2006 the Carmarthenshire County Council made an Order under Section 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The effect of this Order will be to amend The County of Carmarthenshire (Llanelli) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2004 ("the Consolidation Order") (which provides for decriminalised enforcement of contraventions of waiting prohibitions and restrictions) by substituting the plan annexed thereto denoting Area CJ216 with the plan annexed to the Order. The consequence of the amendment will be to prohibit waiting at any time on the side of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice and will replace the existing prohibitions and restrictions (if any) that affect the parts of the road referred to above.

The provisions for the usual exemptions contained in the consolidation Order will apply in relation to the roads referred to above. These include the right for passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works, for the performance of statutory powers or duties, and to enable a vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated adjacent to such parts of the roads affected by the proposed restriction.

In addition, the Consolidated Order contains where applicable the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the Blue Badge Scheme.

The Order will come into operation on the 15th day of December, 2006 and a copy of the Order, together with the map indicating the road affected, may be inspected at the offices of the Carmarthenshire County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for his purpose.
