

THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (CASTLE POINT BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 8) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an agreement dated 31 March 2011 (and subsequently varied by Deed of Variation on 15 June 2011 and 27 July 2012) has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order: To revoke and introduce various parking restrictions in Benfleet and Canvey Island on the following lengths of roads in the Borough of Castle Point as specified. All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise:

1. To revoke 'No Waiting 8am – 8pm'

Lionel Road, Canvey Island	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Convent Road eastwards for 10 metres TILE: TQ795 832 Rev 0 to Rev 1

2. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time'

Lionel Road, Canvey Island	Both sides: From a point 10 metres east of its junction with Convent Road, westwards to a point 10 metres west of its junction with Convent Road. TILE: TQ795 832 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Convent Road, Canvey Island	Both sides: From its junction with Lionel Road southwards for 10 metres. TILE: TQ795 832 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Dyke Crescent, Canvey Island	Northeast side: From a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with Haarlem Road south eastwards to a point 10 metres southeast of its junction with Haarlem Road. Northeast side: From a point 10 metres northwest of its junction with Limburg Road south eastwards to a point 5 metres southeast of its junction with Limburg Road. TILE: TQ775 837 Rev 0 to Rev 1

3. To revoke 'No Waiting Monday – Friday, 11am – 12pm' and introduce 'Permit Holders Only Monday – Friday 11am – 12pm Zone C'

Brook Road, Benfleet	Both sides: From a point 8m southwest of its junction with Fleet Road, south-westwards to a point 14 metres northeast of its junction with Hope Road. TILES: TQ770 862 Rev 0 to Rev 1, TQ770 865 Rev 0 to Rev 1, & TQ775 865 Rev 0 to Rev 1

4. To revoke 'No Loading at Any Time'

Grove Road, Benfleet	Both sides: From its junction with High Road north-eastwards for 60 metres. TILE: TQ775 867 Rev 0 to Rev 1

5. To amend: The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 Schedule 3 to include the following properties the residents of which are eligible to apply for a permit:

Brook Road	C	40 – 86 Evens, 35 - 69 odds

Date of operation: This Order will come into operation on **12th September 2022**

Application to the High Court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
