

**THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (CASTLE POINT BOROUGH)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND
(ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA)
(AMENDMENT NO. 9) ORDER 2023**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 30 June 2022 has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

Effect of the Order: To introduce parking restrictions in Thundersley on the following lengths of roads in the Borough of Castle Point as specified. All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise:

1. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time':

Kingston Road, Thundersley	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with A13 Kiln Road northwards for 25 metres. Tile TQ795 877 Rev 0 to Rev 1
A13 Kiln Road, Thundersley	NORTH SIDE: From a point 10 metres west of its junction with Kingston Road eastwards to a point 23 metres east of its junction with Kingston Road. Tile TQ795 877 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Firfield Road, Daws Heath	EAST SIDE: From a point 10 metres north of its junction with Daws Heath Road northwards to a point in line with the boundary between property Nos. 11 & 15. Tile TQ800 887 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Common Lane, Thundersley	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Triton Way and Lewes Way eastwards for 12 metres and westwards for 12 metres. BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Cedar Park Close eastwards for 10 metres (on the bend). Tile TQ795 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1 & TQ790 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Triton Way, Thundersley	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Common Lane southwards for 12 metres. Tile TQ795 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Lewes Way, Thundersley	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Common Lane northwards for 12 metres. Tile TQ795 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Cedar Park Close, Thundersley	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Common Lane southwards for 10 metres (on the bend). Tile TQ790 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1
Runnymede Road, Canvey Island	BOTH SIDES: From a point 5 metres south of its junction with Long Road southwards for 7 metres. Tile TQ795 832 Rev 1 to Rev 2

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile numbers TQ790 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1, TQ795 832 Rev 1 to Rev 2, TQ795 877 Rev 0 to Rev 1, TQ795 890 Rev 0 to Rev 1 and TQ800 887 Rev 0 to Rev 1

Date of operation: This Order will come into operation on **21st June 2023**.

Application to the High Court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.

1. This Order shall come into operation for all purposes on the 21st day of June 2023 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Amendment No.9 Order 2023.
