The Central Bedfordshire Council (the "Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 19th day of December 2019 and may be cited as "Central Bedfordshire Council (Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008) (Variation No.1) Order 2020"
- 2. As from the date upon which this Order comes into operation, the provisions of the "Bedfordshire County Council (District of Mid Bedfordshire) (Civil Enforcement Area and Special Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008" shall be varied as follows:-

To add No Waiting at any time on the following lengths of road in (Lower Stondon):-

- (i) Station Road, north side, continuing from existing double yellow lines from a point approximately 2 metres south-west of a point in line with the boundary of number 199 and 201 Station Road extending in a south-westerly direction for approximately 33 metres.
- (ii) Station Road, south side, continuing from existing double yellow lines from a point approximately 2 metres south-west of a point in line with the boundary of number 199 and 201 Station Road extending in a south-westerly direction for approximately 4 metres.
- (iii) Station Road, south side, from a point approximately 1 metre south-west of a point in line with the boundary of number 197 and 197a Station Road extending in a south-westerly direction for approximately 16 metres.
