

## THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (CHELMSFORD CITY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND STOPPING) AND (ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 30) ORDER 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Chelmsford City Council acting on behalf of the South Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an agreement dated 31 March 2011 (and subsequently varied by Deed of Variation on 15 June 2011 and 27 July 2012) has made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2 (1) to (3), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

## Effect of the Order:

All measurements are taken as accurately as possible and are taken from the extended kerb line unless stated otherwise.

1. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' on the following lengths of road in Church Road, Boreham in the City of Chelmsford:

Church Road,	Southeast side – from a point 15 metres northeast of the north-eastern end of the		
Boreham,	bridge over the River Chelmer south-westwards for 156 metres.		
Chelmsford	Northeast side - from a point 85 metres northwest of the northeast end of the

	Northeast & East sides - from a point 149 metres northwest of the northeast of the bridge over the River Chelmer north-westwards and northwards for		
	metres.		
	Northwest side – from a point 20 metres northeast of the north-eastern end of the		
	bridge over the River Chelmer south-westwards for 158 metres.		
	Southwest side - from a point 38 metres northeast of the northeast end of the		
	bridge over the River Chelmer north-westwards for 131 metres.		
	West side – from a point 180 metres northwest of the northeast end of the bridge		
	over the River Chelmer northwards for 120 metres.		

2. To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' on the following lengths of road in North Hill, Little Baddow, in the City of Chelmsford:

North Hill,	West & Northwest sides – from a point 100 metres south of the entrance to Paper	
Little Baddow,	Mill Lock Tea Rooms northwards and north-eastwards to the entrance of Rainbirds.	
Chelmsford	Northwest & Southwest sides – from a point 58 metres north-east of the entrance	
	to Rainbirds north-eastwards and north-westwards for 97 metres.	
	East & Southeast sides – from a point 100 metres south of the entrance to Paper	
	Mill Lock Tea Rooms northwards and north-eastwards for 148 metres.	
	Southeast side – from a point 204 metres northeast of the entrance to Paper Mill	
	Lock Tea Rooms north-westwards and north-eastwards for 135 metres.	
	Northeast side – from a point 379 metres northeast of the entrance to Paper Mill	
	Lock Tea Rooms north-westwards for 60 metres.	

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Chelmsford City Council) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by creating tile numbers TL760 085 Rev 0, TL760 087 Rev 0, TL775 087 Rev 0 and TL775 090 Rev 0.

This Order will come into effect on **20 December 2021** and will be incorporated into the relevant Schedules to the Essex County Council (Chelmsford City) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019.
