

CHELMSFORD CITY COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Chelmsford City Council in exercise of its powers under Section 32 & 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and part IV of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers and with the consent of Essex County Council given in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act has made the above Order.

Effect of the Order:

1. To revoke the interpretation for the meaning of the expression "Electric Vehicle Charging Bay" and replace with the following:

"Electric Vehicle Charging Bay" means a Parking Bay designated for the sole use by an Electric Vehicle for a continuous charging time as specified by the maximum charging time as shown on the Electric Vehicle Charging Bay signage. The Electric Vehicle Charging Bay signage will also indicate when there is a requirement to pay the daily car parking fee.

2. To insert the following clause 13(d) under the meaning of the expression "Exemption from Charge":

"No charge shall be payable the driver of a vehicle using Beaulieu Station Car Park A provided that vehicle is displaying a Disabled Person's Badge and a Disabled Person's Parking Disc in the relevant position."

- 3. To insert Beaulieu Station Car Park A (Pay and Display) into the list of Long Stay: Zone A car parks in Schedule 1 of the Order.
- 4. To insert the fees and charges for Beaulieu Station Car Park A into Schedule 2 of the Order with the following:

"Beaulieu Station Car Park A

Monday to Friday (from 5am)

Length of stay	Fee
Up to 1 hour	£3.50
Up to 2 hours	£4.50
Up to 3 hours	£5.50
Up to 5am	£11.50

Evenings (from 5pm)

Length of stay	New fee
Up to 5am	£2.50



Saturday and Sunday (from 5am)

Length of stay	New fee
Up to midnight	£5"

This Order will be incorporated into The Chelmsford City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2018.

Date of operation: This Order will come into operation on 11 August 2025.

Application to the High Court: Anyone who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or any instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from the making of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
