ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

CHESHIRE EAST BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIOUS ROADS) (CONSOLIDATION) Order 2022 (Amendment No.18) Order 2024

The Cheshire East Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2,4, 32, 35, 38, 45, 46, 51, 53, 61, 122 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- This order shall come into operation on 29th July 2024 and may be cited as CHESHIRE EAST BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIOUS ROADS) (CONSOLIDATION) Order 2022 (Amendment No.18) Order 2024
- 2. This order amends the CHESHIRE EAST BOROUGH COUNCIL (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING, STOPPING AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (VARIOUS ROADS) (CONSOLIDATION) Order 2022 ("the Order") by replacing map tiles in the Order: AG139 Rev 0 with AG139 Rev 1, BE152 Rev 0 with BE152 Rev 1, CP123 Rev 0 with CP123 Rev 1, CR121 Rev 0 with CR121 Rev 1, CS121 Rev 0 with CS121 Rev 1, as set out in the Schedule to this order.
- 3. Article 15 of the Order shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following clause:
 - "15) Nothing in Articles 8, 9 and 10 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any official Vehicle to Wait, used by a funeral director and if it cannot safely and conveniently do so elsewhere, at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths or sides of road for so long as may be necessary in connection with any funeral.
- 4. Article 59 of the Order shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following clause:
 - "59) Visitors Permits shall be issued in the form of scratch cards or Virtual Permits"
- 5. Insert after the definition of "Carriageway" in Article 2 of the Order:
 - "Cashless Payment System" means the system used to facilitate, monitor, and record the payment of Parking Charges using mobile telephone communication, software application or an online transaction with an authorised service provider, in accordance with instructions given on signs or by any other manner, as authorised by the Council, at Parking Places where the Cashless Payment System is in operation.
- 6. Insert after the definition of "Owner" in Article 2 of the Order:

- "Parking Charge" means a charge, as shown in a Map Tile, to be paid for a vehicle left in a Parking Place
- 7. Insert after Article 76 of the Order:
 - "76A) Save as provided in Article 94 the Driver of any vehicle using any Parking Place subject to a Parking Charge during the Permitted Hours and Days shall pay the Parking Charge shown on the relevant Map Tile and in accordance with instructions given on signs or by any other manner at the Parking Place."
 - "76B) Parking Charges shall be payable by a Cashless Payment System in accordance with instructions on signs or by any other manner at the Parking Place."
 - "76C) If at any time a Vehicle is left in a Parking Place which is subject to a Parking Charge and for which a Parking Charge has not been paid in accordance with the instructions at the Parking Place the Parking Charge shall be deemed to have not been paid."
- 8. In Schedule 3 of the Order after Zone W insert a further row as follows:

9. In Schedule 4 of the Order the following row will be removed from the table:

10. The restriction imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
