

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

Cheshire East Borough Council (Various Traffic Movements) (Various Roads)
(Consolidation) Order 2022

Made: 30th June 22

Coming into operation: 8th July 2022

The Cheshire East Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of powers conferred by Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 19, 65(1) and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The 1984 Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of The 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of The 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as "Cheshire East Borough Council (Various Traffic Movements)(Various Roads) (Consolidation) Order 2022" ('this Order') and shall come into operation for all purposes on the 8th July, 2022.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "The 2016 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);
 - "The 1984 Act" means Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended;
 - "The 2004 Act" means the Traffic Management Act 2004;
 - "The 2022 Regulations" means The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices, Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022;
 - "Bus" "Bus Lane", "Carriageway", "Contraflow", "Cycle Lane", "Goods Vehicle", "Local Bus", "Local Service", "Maximum Gross Weight", "Pedal Cycle", "Traffic Lane" and "With Flow Lane" all have the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of The 2016 Regulations;
 - "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person appointed in accordance with the provisions of section 76 of The 2004 Act to enforce the prohibitions, restrictions and regulations imposed by this Order;
 - "Disabled Person" and "Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000;
 - "Disabled Person's Vehicle" means a Vehicle lawfully displaying in the Relevant Position a Disabled Person's Badge in accordance with The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - "Driver" means the person engaged in the driving a Vehicle at the time of contravention of the Order;
 - "Goods" means Goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and "Delivering" and "Collecting" in relation to any Goods or postal packets includes checking the Goods or postal packets for the purpose of their delivery or collection;
 - "Map Schedule" means the Map Schedule being a collection of Map Tiles listed in Schedule 2, which depicts the traffic movement prohibitions and restrictions designated by this Order, and in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend, identifies the type of each particular

prohibition and restriction and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the Map Schedule and where a traffic movement prohibition or restriction is depicted on the Map Schedule, that prohibition or restriction will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data;

“Map Schedule Legend” means the Map Schedule Legend to this Order which, when used in conjunction with a Map Tile as listed in Schedule 2, identifies the specific type of traffic movement prohibition or restriction designated by this Order and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions;

“Map Tile” means an individual Map Tile with a specific reference, being part of the Map Schedule as listed in Schedule 2;

“Map Tile Label”, where shown on a Map Tile forming part of the Map Schedule in relation to a traffic movement prohibition or restriction, means a label which indicates the type of prohibition or restriction and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions;

“Motorcycle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of The 1984 Act;

“Motor Vehicle” has the same meaning as that in Section 136 of The 1984 Act;

“Non-Vehicular” in the context of this Order means horse or pedestrian traffic;

“One-Way Street” means a highway in which Vehicles are prohibited at all times from proceeding in any other than one direction unless specific classes of Vehicle are permitted to proceed in a Contraflow direction or lane;

“Owner” in relation to a Vehicle includes any person who, by virtue of The 2022 Regulations, falls to be treated as the Owner of the Vehicle;

“Passenger Vehicle/s” means a Motor Vehicle (other than a Motorcycle or Invalid Carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than twelve passengers (exclusive of the Driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

“Prescribed Hours” means the periods specified in the Map Tile Label and/or the Map Schedule Legend indicating the hours of operation of a prescribed route on a street or streets identified as such in the Map Schedule to this Order;

“Relevant Position” means:

- a) a Disabled Person’s Badge has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles)(England) Regulations 2000; and
- b) a disabled person's Parking Disc, has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2020.

“Restricted Street” means any of the sides or lengths of roads as specified in the Map Schedule where access or movement is controlled by a restriction, prohibition or prescribed route specified in this Order;

"Taxi" means a hackney carriage as defined under section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 which is –

- a) Licensed by the Council; and
- b) Attended by the Driver and available for hire.

"Traffic Sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, Section 64 of The 1984 Act;

"Universal Postal Service" "Universal Service Provider", "Provision of a Universal Postal Service" and "Postal Packet" shall bear the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

"Vehicle" includes any part of a Vehicle including any Motor Vehicle, Motorcycle or other mechanically propelled automobile or a Pedal Cycle;

"Weight" in relation to a Vehicle means the gross Weight of that Vehicle together with its load (if any).

- (2) For the purposes of this Order, a Vehicle and any trailer drawn thereby shall be deemed to be a single Vehicle.
- (3) In this Order, except where otherwise stated, any reference to a numbered Article or Schedule shall be construed as a reference to that article or schedule bearing that number in this Order and any reference to the Map Schedule is a reference to the Map Tiles and Map Schedule Legend incorporated into this Order as the Map Schedule.
- (4) Any reference in this Order to any Enactment shall be construed as a reference to that Enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent Enactment.
- (5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament and the Orders revoked by Schedule 1 were Acts of Parliament thereby repealed.
- (6) Unless the context otherwise requires words denoting the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and words denoting the persons shall include either gender, bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships
- (7) In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under The 1984 Act and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation and which imposes a traffic movement restriction or prohibition on any length of road specified in the Map Schedule to this Order, the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

Moving traffic prohibitions, restrictions and prescribed routes

- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order and:

Prohibition of turns or U-turns

Prohibition of turns or U-turns

- (1) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c) inclusive, no person shall cause a Vehicle to perform a turn into another road, or to undertake a U-turn on the same road, at any location where a prohibition of turning or U-turn is indicated by a Traffic Sign and is identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Compulsory route or turn

- (2) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c) inclusive, no person shall fail to cause a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with the indicated compulsory route/turn at any location where a compulsory route/turn is indicated by a Traffic Sign and is identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Prescribed direction - One Way

- (2) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c), and 4(i), or where specified Vehicles are permitted to travel in a Contraflow direction as specified in the Map Schedule or as indicated on that road by signing identifying classes of Vehicle(s) permitted to travel in a Contraflow direction, no person shall cause a Vehicle to proceed other than in the prescribed direction in any road or part of a road indicated as being one way at any location where one way is indicated by a Traffic Sign and is identified as such within the Map Schedule;

No entry

- (3) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c) inclusive, no person shall cause a Vehicle to proceed past a point in any road or part of a road indicated as being no entry to Motor Vehicles, or any Vehicle, at any location where no entry is indicated by a Traffic Sign and identified as such within the Map Schedule, except as provided in Article 4(i) at any location where an exception is provided for by means of Traffic Signing and as identified as such in the Map Schedule;

Prohibition of driving / Prohibition of Access

- (4) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(f), 4(k) to (m) and 4(o) to 4(q) inclusive, no person may use, or permit the use of, any Vehicle or Non-Vehicular traffic of a class or on any day or days or during any time period or periods, as specified in the Map Schedule, to proceed at any location in any road or footpath, or part of a road or footpath, indicated as being prohibited to such traffic by Traffic Signs and is identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Prohibition of overtaking

- (5) (a) except as provided by 4(a) or 4(b), no person may use, or permit the use of, any Vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other moving Vehicle on a length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, as specified in the Map Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of a Traffic Sign of the type described in item 5 (diagram 632 – no overtaking) of the sign table in Part 2 of Schedule 3 of The 2016 Regulations;
- (b) “other moving Vehicle” does not include, a Pedal Cycle, Motorcycle, or any other Vehicle not being a Motor Vehicle in accordance with section 140 of The 1984 Act;

Maximum width restriction

- (6) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c) inclusive, no person shall cause any Vehicle with an overall width of which together with the load (if any) carried thereon exceeds the stated width restriction to proceed in any of the roads or parts of roads indicated as being width restricted, at a maximum width less than the Vehicles overall width, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the width restriction and as identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Prohibited Access Maximum Environmental Weight restriction

- (7) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(e), 4(g) to 4(h), 4(j), 4(m) and 4(n), no person shall cause a Vehicle with a Maximum Gross Weight in excess of the stated maximum Weight restriction to proceed in any of the roads or parts of roads indicated as being Weight restricted, at a Maximum Gross Weight less than the Vehicles Weight, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the Weight restriction as identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Maximum Structural Weight restriction

- (8) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c), no person shall cause a Vehicle with a Maximum Gross Weight in excess of the stated maximum Weight restriction to proceed in any of the roads or parts of roads indicated as being Weight restricted, at a Maximum Gross Weight less than the Vehicles Weight, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the Weight restriction as identified as such within the Map Schedule, except as provided at any location where an exception is provided for by means of Traffic Signing and as identified as such in the Map Schedule;

Prescribed route

- (11) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(d), 4(f), 4(g), 4(h), 4(k), 4(m), 4(q), 4(r) and 4(s), no person shall cause a Vehicle or Non-Vehicular traffic of a class specified in the Map Schedule to enter any street during the Prescribed Hours identified within the Map Schedule as a prescribed route and that is signed as such in the vicinity of the entry as a prescribed route, except as provided at any location where an exception is provided for by means of Traffic Signing and as identified as such in the Map Schedule;

Maximum height restriction

- (12) except as provided in Article 4(a), 4(b), 4(c), 4(d), 4(e), 4(f), no person shall cause a Vehicle with a maximum height in excess of the stated height restriction to proceed in any of the roads or parts of roads indicated as being height restricted, at a maximum height less than the Vehicles height, by a traffic sign at the location of the height restriction and as identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Maximum length restriction

- (13) except as provided in Article 4(a) to 4(c) inclusive, no person shall cause any Vehicle with an overall length of which together with the load (if any) carried thereon exceeds the stated length restriction to proceed in any of the roads or parts of roads indicated as being length restricted, at a maximum length less than the Vehicles overall length, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the length restriction and as identified as such within the Map Schedule;

Movement prohibitions, restrictions and prescribed route exemptions

4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply:

- (a) to a marked Vehicle being used by the fire brigade, ambulance service or police in the course of their dealing with an emergency; or
- (b) to anything done:
 - (i) with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
 - (ii) to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) to enable an obstruction to traffic to be removed;
- (c) to any person who causes a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to sections 66 and 67 of The 1984 Act; or
- (d) in relation to any Vehicle when used in the service of a local authority, water undertaker, sewerage undertaker or Environmental Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or in the performance of such duties for that Vehicle to enter or proceed in a Restricted Street; or
- (e) in relation to any Vehicle being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation works or the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting in any Restricted Street for the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer thereunder or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, electricity or water or of any line of telecommunication apparatus (as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984) kept installed for the purpose of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position or the placing, maintenance or removal of any Traffic Sign thereon; or
- (f) to a marked Vehicle, whilst used by a Universal Service Provider in the course of the provision of a Universal Postal Service, to deliver and/or collect postal packets; or
- (g) to a Vehicle being used to gain access to any land or premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road to which there is not a satisfactory alternative means of vehicular access; or
- (h) to a Vehicle being used for the purpose of conveying persons, Goods or merchandise or effects to or from any land or premises situated on or accessible only from the road or adjacent to the road where the restriction applies to which there is no satisfactory alternative means of access; or
- (i) in relation to any Vehicle and/or Pedal Cycle authorised by a Traffic Sign and identified as such in the Map Schedule to enter a road or part of road identified as a no entry and travel in a direction other than the prescribed direction; or
- (j) for Vehicle being used to proceed to or from any premises which are situated on or adjacent to the said length of road and at which the Vehicle is to be, or has been garaged, serviced or repaired; or
- (k) to a Pedal Cycle or electrically assisted Pedal Cycle; or
- (l) if it is a Vehicle being used in the course of public cleansing or waste collection; or

- (m) if it is a Vehicle being used in connection with the removal of furniture and effects from one dwelling house, office or depository to another such dwelling house, office or depository as the case may be; or
- (n) is being used on the said length of road for or in connection with the conveyance of Goods for sale from that Vehicle; or
- (o) the delivery of essential fuel supplies to those premises in the said length of road which cannot be so serviced from the rear; or
- (p) the carrying out of any building operations to or demolition of premises to which rear access is unobtainable provided that notice is given twenty-four hours in advance to the Council; or
- (q) such other purposes as the Council shall allow.
- (r) to a Vehicle bearing a livery which is stopped at the edge of the carriageway for as long as may be necessary for the purposes of delivering or collecting cash to premises adjacent to the carriageway.
- (s)

Bus Lanes

5. Except as provided in Articles 6 and 7, no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle to enter or proceed within a Bus Lane in a length of road identified as a Bus Lane in the Map Schedule during the times specified and unless that Vehicle is proceeding in the direction specified and is of a type identified on a sign at the entrance to the Bus Lane and as specified in the Map Schedule for that Bus Lane.
6. The controls specified in Articles 5 do not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

Bus Lane Exemptions

7. Nothing in Article 5 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to enter or proceed within a Bus Lane in the length of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) a Vehicle to avoid an accident;
 - (b) a person to board or alight from the Vehicle;
 - (c) Goods to be loaded on to, or unloaded from, the Vehicle;
 - (d) a Vehicle to enter or exit land or any other highway adjacent to the Bus Lane;
 - (e) the Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition works;
 - (ii) the removal of an obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said road; or
 - (iv) the laying, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any line of telecommunication apparatus (as defined in the

Telecommunications Act 1984) kept installed for the purpose of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position;

- (f) the Vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in service of an undertaker, a local authority or the Environmental Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (g) the Vehicle is to be used for the fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (h) the Council to suspend the restrictions detailed in Article 5 with the use of variable message signs to comply with traffic overflow requirements as a result of a closure, works or an emergency on nearby roads.

Revocations

8. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Orders that brought into effect the prohibitions and restrictions on traffic movement and prescribed routes as specified in Schedule 1 that are re-enacted by this Order and any Orders amending those Orders are hereby revoked.
