ELLESMERE PORT & NESTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION AND CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) ORDER 2008

Ellesmere Port & Neston Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Cheshire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consulting with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

PART I GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

 This Order shall come into operation on 8 January 2009 and may be citied as the Ellesmere Port & Neston Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2008 and shall revoke all previous orders.

<u>Interpretation</u>

2. In this Order:

"Charging Days" means those days other than Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Years Day, Good Friday, Easter Sunday and all other Bank Holidays designated as public holidays which are as specified at each parking place respectively;

"Charging Hours" means the period as specified at each parking place on all charging days;

"Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise the Parking Places in accordance with Section 76 of the

2004 Act and enforce the restrictions imposed by this Order. For the time being and as appropriate, the term Civil Enforcement Officer also means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council as a Parking Attendant under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"Disabled Persons' Badge" means a badge issued by any Local Authority for use in a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) Regulations 2000 and Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a Disabled Person's Badge;

"Expiry Time" is the time indicated on the Pay and Display Ticket and is the time by which the Vehicle must leave the Parking Place;

"Loading/Unloading" refers to when a vehicle is parked wholly in a parking place or bay marked for that purpose on site, for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place or bay and the vehicle does not park for more than thirty minutes or such longer period as a duly authorised officer of the Council may authorise;

"Motor Cycle" refers to a solo motorcycle only and excludes any motor cycle which has a side-car or trailer, or which has more than two wheels;

"Owner" in relation to a Vehicle means the person who is recorded as the registered keeper by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency on the date on which the Vehicle was left in the parking place in question;

"Parking Bay" means an area of a parking place, which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle of a class specified and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place or signed or otherwise indicated by signs in the parking place;

"Parking Charge" means the cost of purchasing a pay and display ticket at the respective parking places as set out in the Schedule to this Order;

"Parking Permit" means a season ticket, contract permit, business permit, staff permit, visitor permit or resident's permit of a type and design issued by the Council;

"Parking Place" means an area of land provided by the Council pursuant to Section 32(1) of the 1984 Act for the purpose of leaving of Vehicles and not closed (in part or in whole) by a notice erected thereon by authority of the Council;

"Pay and Display Ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine located in the parking place in which the vehicle has been left or issued by a person nominated by the Council on payment of the appropriate charge and valid for a parking period as advertised at that parking place;

"Penalty Charge" means a charge imposed by legislation in respect of parking contraventions that are subject to civil enforcement;

"Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice issued by or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Regulation 8 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;

" Permit holder " means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order;

"Permit Parking Bay" means a parking bay allocated to a Permit holder in accordance with and subject to any provisions imposed by the Council contained in a separate contract made between the Permit Holder and the Council.

"Relevant Position" means

(a) in respect of a Vehicle displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge:

- (i) in the case of a Vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 (the front of the badge), is legible from outside the Vehicle; or
- (ii) in the case of a Vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the Vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the Vehicle;
- (b) in respect of a Vehicle displaying a Pay and Display ticket or Parking Permit:
 - (i) the ticket or permit is exhibited on the inside surface of the windscreen or in a clearly visible position so that it is facing forwards and can be easily seen and read from the front or side of the Vehicle: or
 - (ii) in the case of a Vehicle that is not fitted with a transparent windscreen, the ticket or permit is exhibited on the front of the Vehicle facing forwards and clearly visible;
- (c) in respect of a Vehicle displaying a Hackney Carriage Plate
 - (i) the plate must be affixed to the Vehicle in accordance with the instructions given within the licence as issued by the Council

"Ticket Machine" means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the appropriate Minister for the purpose of the 1984 Act, being apparatus designed to issue parking tickets which indicate the payment of a charge, and date and, time of such payment, or the time at which the Vehicle must leave the Parking Place;

"Trailer" has the same meaning as in Section 185 (1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

"Vehicle" means any motor car, motor cycle or other mechanically propelled automobile.

PART II DESIGNATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

Designation

3. Each area of land or building specified in the Schedules below may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a place to leave Vehicles of such classes, in such positions, on such days, during such hours, for such period and on payment of such charges as are advertised at each parking place.

Class and position of Vehicle

- 4. Where by notice at a parking place, a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or vehicles to be left in a specified location, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in that parking place or in any parking bay within the parking place (i) unless it is of the specified class; (ii) that is parked beyond the parking bay markings; (iii) in a position other than that specified or (iv) there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- 5. When a vehicle is accompanied by a trailer, the trailer must be parked in a parking bay and a charge must be paid for the trailer equivalent to the charge payable in respect of the vehicle. Both tickets must be displayed in the vehicle bearing the registration mark of such trailer.

Disabled Person's Parking Bays

6. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking bay marked for disabled persons unless the vehicle displays a valid Disabled Person's Badge in the relevant position and immediately before or immediately after the act of parking the vehicle has been or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the Disabled Person's Badge has been issued.

Taxi bays

7. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in an area marked as a parking bay for use by taxis unless the vehicle displays in the relevant position a valid Hackney Carriage plate issued by the Council

Loading and unloading bays

8. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in any area marked as a parking bay for the purpose of loading or unloading unless the vehicle is being used for the purpose of loading or unloading.

Motor Cycle parking bays

 No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in a parking bay marked for motor cycles unless the vehicle is a motor cycle.

Driving within a Parking Place

- 10. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of (a) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place or (b) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit, so indicated or, (ii) in a direction other than so specified except in exceptional circumstances.
- 11. No person shall, except in exceptional circumstances with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of

leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purposes of departing from the parking place.

Maximum Period of Stay

12. Where by notice, a parking place is described as available on specified days, during specified hours or for a maximum period of stay, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in that parking place on any day, during such hours or for any period other or longer than those specified.

Period of no return

13. Where by notice, a parking place is described as having a period within which a vehicle may not return, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to park in that parking place on any day, during such period.

Power to close or suspend Parking Places

- 14. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council by notice, sign or barrier displayed in a parking place:
 - (i) from closing a parking place or any part thereof for any period; and/or
 - (ii) from setting aside a parking place or any part or parts thereof on all days or on certain days or during certain parts of days for use only by particular Vehicles or organisations.
 - 15. Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the preceding Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or that part thereof a notice or traffic sign indicating that the use of that parking place or that part thereof is suspended and that parking by vehicles is prohibited.
 - 16. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in a parking place or any part thereof during such periods that the use of that parking place or that part thereof is suspended or during such period as there is in or adjacent thereto a

notice or traffic sign placed by or on behalf of the Council in pursuance of Article 17 below.

Use of Parking Places

- 17. No person shall in a parking place without the express written permission of the Council, use a vehicle, in connection with the sale of any article, including the vehicle itself, to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skill or services in any other capacity.
- 18. No person shall use any part of the parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place (a) for sleeping or camping or cooking (b) for the purpose of servicing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place (c) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the consent of the Council or (d) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire.
- 19. All vehicles shall be driven in a reasonable manner with due care and consideration for other users of the parking places.

Parked with engine running

20. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in the parking space and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

Parked causing an obstruction

21. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not park the vehicle in such a manner or place where it causes an obstruction to any other users of the parking place.

Liability

22. The Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage to vehicles or other property left in any of the parking places to which this Order applies save for negligence of the Council.

PART III CHARGES FOR PARKING

Payment

23. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall upon leaving the vehicle in the parking place pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of current charges advertised at the parking place.

Pay and Display Parking Places

24. The driver of a vehicle using a parking bay within the parking place, shall upon parking the vehicle in a parking bay and prior to leaving the parking place, obtain a pay and display ticket at the level of charge and for the period required in accordance with the scale of charges as advertised at that parking place.

Means of payment

25. The parking charges shall be payable in the manner and by the amount advertised at that parking place.

Display of ticket

26. The driver of a vehicle shall ensure that a valid pay and display ticket has been obtained to cover the entire period that the vehicle is parked in the parking bay, and display the pay and display ticket issued at that parking place in the relevant position on the Vehicle in respect of which it was issued.

27. In so far as a motor vehicle is left in a parking place specified in the Schedule where a free parking period is available the driver thereof shall obtain a parking ticket and the parking charge for the free period shall for the purposes of this Order be deemed to have been paid.

Validity of Pay and Display Tickets

- 28. A pay and display ticket is not transferable from one vehicle to another and on transfer the pay and display ticket ceases to be valid.
- 29.A Pay and Display Ticket is valid only in the Parking Place in which it was issued. This is defined by the reference code of the Ticket Machine located in that Parking Place printed on the Pay and Display Ticket.

Expiry of parking period

30. The expiry of the period for which the appropriate charge has been paid shall be indicated when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiry time shown on the pay and display ticket.

No Pay and Display Ticket displayed

- 31. If at any time a vehicle is left in a parking place and where no pay and display ticket is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position, it shall be deemed that the parking charge has not been paid.
- 32. If at the time when a vehicle is left during the charging hours in a parking place and on the nearest ticket machine in that parking place there is a notice placed by any person duly authorised by the Council, indicating that the ticket machine is out of order, then a pay and display ticket shall be obtained from another ticket machine within the same parking place (where provided).
- 33. Where no valid pay and display ticket can be obtained and displayed, vehicles may be left in a parking place for no longer than the maximum period of parking in that parking place as advertised at the parking place.

Parking Permits

- 34. Parking Permits are available from the Council at the appropriate fee for a vehicle of a specific class and for a specific permit parking bay subject to conditions determined by the Council.
- 35. The driver shall abide by the terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the parking permit.
- 36. A parking permit is only valid in the parking place in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the parking permit.
- 37.A parking permit remains the property of the Council and must be surrendered on request. In such instances where a refund fee is deemed appropriate by the Council, this will be provided in accordance with the Council's policies.

Display of Parking Permit

38. The driver of the vehicle shall display the parking permit in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is left in the parking place.

Replacement Parking Permits

39. Damaged or lost parking permits will be replaced on application to the Council and on payment of an administration fee. The damaged or lost parking permit will become immediately invalid.

Surrender of Parking Permit

40. The holder of an annual parking permit shall on surrendering the parking permit be entitled to a pro-rata refund based less an administration fee.

Restriction on removal

41. When a pay and display ticket or parking permit has been exhibited on a vehicle in the relevant position, no person shall remove the pay and display ticket or parking permit from the vehicle until the vehicle is removed from the parking place.

PART IV EXEMPTIONS FROM DAILY CHARGES

- 42. No daily charge shall be payable in respect of:
 - (i) Emergency Services vehicles while in use for such purposes,
 - (ii) Vehicles authorised by the Council for specified purposes,
 - (iii) Motorcycles when parked in areas marked as reserved for such vehicles,
 - (iv) Vehicles in use for works of building, demolition, repair or maintenance to car parks or buildings adjacent to the car parks,
 - (v) Motor vehicles displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position provide that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been used or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the disabled person's badge is issued.

Absence of Ticket Machine

43. If at the time when a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours there is no ticket machine at the parking place, or all the ticket machines at that parking place carry notices placed upon them by a person duly authorised by the Council indicating that they are out of order, the driver of that vehicle shall be exempt from purchasing a pay and display ticket.

Wilful damage of ticket machine

44. Any person who with intent to defraud interferes with the Ticket Machine or operates or attempts to operate it by the insertion of objects other than undamaged and unaltered coins of legal tender and of the appropriate

denomination, or other approved method of payment, shall be liable to prosecution.

PART V RELOCATION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES

Removal of vehicle

45.A person authorised by the Council may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved to any place he/she thinks fit, any vehicle left in a suspended parking place and the cost of movement or removal and safe keeping shall be the liability of the owner of the vehicle.

Emergencies

46. A person authorised by the Council or a Police Constable in uniform may, using such measures as appropriate, move or cause to be moved in the case of an emergency to any place he/she thinks fit, any vehicle left in a parking place. Any person removing a vehicle from a parking place under the provisions of this Order shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary to provide for the safe keeping of the vehicle.

Disposal of Vehicles abandoned in Parking Places

47. The Council may sell or otherwise dispose of, in accordance with current legislation, a vehicle which has been, or could at any time be, removed from a parking place if the vehicle appears to have been abandoned.

PART VI CONTRAVENTION AND PENALTY CHARGE

Contravention

- 48. If a vehicle is left in a parking place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable subject to the provisions of Regulation 5 of the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 for each day of the said contravention or non-compliance. A Penalty Charge Notice showing the information required by the 2004 Act may then be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of the 2004 Act or any subsequent applicable legislation.
 - 49. In the case of a Vehicle in respect of which the Penalty Charge has been incurred, it shall be the duty of a Civil Enforcement Officer to (i) attach a Penalty Charge Notice to the vehicle in a conspicuous position, or (ii) give the Penalty Charge Notice to the person appearing to him/ her to be in charge of the vehicle, or (iii) post the Penalty Charge Notice to the Owner of the Vehicle.
 - 50. The Penalty Charge Notice shall include the following particulars; (a) the registration mark of the vehicle, or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade licence carried by the vehicle; (b) the nature of the contravention; (c) the date and time at which he first noticed that a contravention had occurred; (d) a statement that a penalty charge is required to be paid; and (e) the manner in which and the time within which the charge is to be paid.

Restriction on removal of notices

- 51.A notice fixed to a vehicle in accordance with Article 36 above shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of:
 - (i) the Owner, or person in charge of, the vehicle;

- (ii) the Council for the parking place in which the vehicle in question was found.
- 52. The Penalty Charge shall be paid in accordance with the instructions contained on the Penalty Charge Notice,
 - (a) by cheque, bankers' draft, money order or postal order delivered or sent by post to 'Ellesmere Port & Neston Borough Council' as indicated on the Penalty Charge Notice, or
 - (b) in cash, as indicated on the Penalty Charge Notice in person at any outlet which accepts such payments, or
 - (c) by credit card or debit card over the phone using the number specified on the Penalty Charge Notice, or
 - (d) via the website www.epnbc.gov.uk using the online payment service with the number specified on the Penalty Charge Notice

If the deadline for payment as described on the Penalty Charge Notice falls on a day when the Council Offices or the offices of the Agents acting on behalf of the Council are closed, the period within which payment of the Penalty Charge shall be paid is extended until 16.00 hours on the next full day when such Offices are open.

53. If the driver fails to pay the penalty charge by the end of the 28 day period, a notice may be served on the Owner; and if the charge is then not paid within a further 28 days it may be increased by 50% on the issue of a charge certificate in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 21 Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007. A continuing failure to pay the penalty charge may result in a judgement in the County Court against the Owner to enable the Council to recover the payment due.

The particulars given in the notice attached to a Vehicle in accordance with this Order shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such Penalty Charge.

PART VII OTHER PROVISIONS

Behaviour

- 54. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 55. No person shall, in a parking place, use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or behaviour with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
- 56. No person shall use any parking place in an improper and disorderly manner, particularly for the use of ball games or any other activity that is likely to cause annoyance and nuisance to other users of the parking place or residents of premises in the neighbourhood.

PART VIII

REVOCATIONS

Revocations

57. The following Orders made by Ellesmere Port & Neston Borough Council and all their Amendments and any other Orders and Regulations of whatever nature relating to Off-street Car Parking Places specified in Schedules 1 and 2 within the area of the Council made before the introduction of this Order are hereby revoked.



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
