

**THE CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(KEEP CLEAR ZONES, CHESTER AREA)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2011**

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, and 4 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order "Keep Clear Zone" means a length of road which is identified by the road marking to diagram 1027.1 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 and specified on the plans attached to this Order as 'No Stopping'.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer or a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to stop in any keep clear zone during the restricted hours and days as specified on the plans attached to this Order.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid waiver certificate issued by the Council to wait in any keep clear zone in accordance with the terms and conditions of the waiver certificate.
4. The Cheshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Chester Area) (Consolidation) Order 2008 ("the 2008 Order") is hereby varied by the revocation of the restrictions from the lengths of roads within the 2008 Order where new restrictions are hereby introduced as shown on the plans attached to this Order.
5. Subject to Article 4 the restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any Regulations or Orders made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by any other enactment.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 9th day of February 2011 and may be cited as "The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Keep Clear Zones, Chester Area) (Prohibition of Stopping) Order 2011."
