CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (CIVIC WAY, ELLESMERE PORT) (TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2020

The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1, 2, 4 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order will come into operation on the 14th day of August 2020 and may be cited as the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Civic Way, Ellesmere Port) (Traffic Management) Order 2020.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed on the Civic Way Service Road.
- 3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding on Civic Way to enter the private access road located 25 metres north-west of Marina Walk.
- 4. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed on the private access road located 25 metres north-west of Marina Walk on reaching the junction with Civic Way shall make a left turn.
- 5. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to proceed on the private access road located 40 metres north-west of Wellington Road on reaching the junction with Civic Way shall make a left turn.
- 6. The Borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (Ellesmere Port Town Centre Traffic Regulation) (One-Way Traffic and Restriction of Access) Order 1991 is hereby amended by: (i) by the deletion of Article 9 and (ii) in Schedule 1 to the Order by the deletion of items (e) referring to the length of Marina Drive between its junctions with Rivington Road and the Civic Way Service Road, and (f) referring to the Civic Way Service Road between its junctions with Marina Drive and Civic Way.
- 7. The prohibitions imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any regulations made, or having effect as if made, under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
