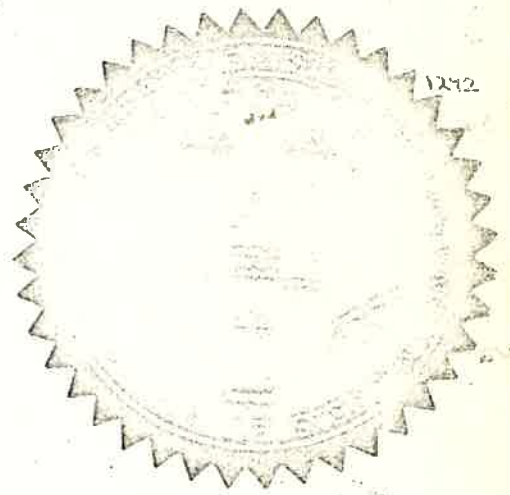
THE CITY OF CHESTER (WATERGATE STREET/NUNS ROAD)
(PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 1977

The Council of the City of Chester (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cheshire, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, (which said Act of 1967, as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, in accordance with Section 84(c)(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to make the right hand turn from New Crane Street into Nuns Road, Chester, between the hours of 4.30 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. (Mondays-Fridays)
2. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th day of ~~October~~ 1977, and may be cited as "The City of Chester (Watergate Street/Nuns Road) (Prohibition of Right Turn) Order 1977"
