

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CAMERON ROAD AND TURNERS WALK, CHESHAM)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING)
(EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER, 2006

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9, 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers and having regard to Section 122 of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. (1) In this Order

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act;

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142 of Act;

"parking disc" has the meaning given by Regulation 8(5) of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000)

"Undertaker" has the same meaning as in Section 48 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying –

(a) a disabled person's badge issued on or after 1 April 2000 in a relevant position if –

(i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or

(ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia is

exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle,
so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the
vehicle;

- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position if –
- (i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or
 - (ii) where a vehicle does not have a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle,
- so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

2. Save as provided in Articles 4 and 5 hereof no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 4 and 5 hereof, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 5.30pm on any day other than a Saturday and Sunday in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 hereof shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

- (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of an Undertaker or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (e) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
5. (1) Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 hereof shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road.
6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
7. Pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Act it is hereby declared that the Council's Head of Legal and Democratic Services may if it appears to her essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs and after carrying out the consultations required by the said statutory provisions modify or suspend this Order or any provision hereof.

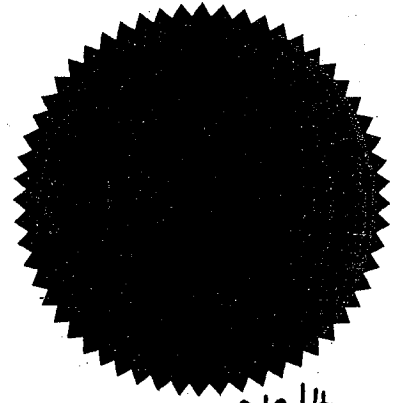

3. Save as provided in Article 4 and 5 hereof, no person shall, except upon the
direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a parking attendant,
cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 5.30pm on any day
other than a Saturday and Sunday in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2
to this Order.

4. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 hereof shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any
vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be
necessary to enable:-

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any
other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

8. For the purpose of Section 9(3) of the Act it is hereby declared that this Order shall continue in force for a period of 18 months from the date on which it comes into operation as mentioned in Article 10 hereinafter contained.

9. During the subsistence of this order "The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chiltern District) (Consolidation Order) 2005" is amended to the extent and in the manner specified in Schedule 3.

10. This Order may be cited as "The Buckinghamshire County Council (Cameron Road and Turners Walk, Chesham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Experimental) Order, 2006" and shall come into operation on 22nd December 2006.
