

NOTICE OF VARIATION OF OFF STREET PARKING CHARGES

THE CHORLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES, CHORLEY) (CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT ORDER 2008) (Notice of Variation No. 3 2017)

NOTICE is hereby given that Chorley Borough Council (“the Council”) will on 1st May 2017 under Sections 35(1) and 35(3) and 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and Regulation 25 of the Local Authorities’ Traffic Regulation Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and of all other enabling powers revise the charges for Off-Street Parking Places.

1. This Order shall come into force from 1st May 2017. The Council will post notices at each Parking Place set out in the Schedules below stating the revised car parking charges after the date that the notice of making is first advertised in accordance with Regulation 17 of and Schedule 1 to the Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 and may be cited as the “Chorley Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places, Chorley) (Consolidation and Amendment Order 2008) (Variation No.3 2017).”
2. In this Order the term ‘the Consolidation Order’ means The Chorley Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places, Chorley) (Consolidation And Amendment Order 2008) save as expressly varied as aforesaid shall continue in full force and effect.
3. In this Order the term ‘Variation Order No. 1’ means The Chorley Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places, Chorley) (Variation) Order 2012 save as expressly varied as aforesaid shall continue in full force and effect.
4. In this Order the term ‘Variation Order No. 2’ means The Chorley Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places, Chorley) (Variation No.2) Order 2016 save as expressly varied as aforesaid shall continue in full force and effect.
5. When this Order comes into force pursuant to paragraph 1 above:
 - (a) Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Consolidation Order and schedules 1, 2 and 3 of the Variation Order No.1 be replaced with the Schedules to this Order.
 - (b) The Consolidation Order is varied by inclusion of the following definition under Part I, clause 2(1):-

“approved method of payment” means payment made by telephone or by other electronic system (including via the internet) by credit or debit card or other means of secure authorised payment through a scheme organised through the Council;
 - (c) The Consolidation Order is varied by the amendment to Part II, clause 4 to the following:-

‘The driver of a vehicle using a parking place at any time during which a parking charge is payable shall upon leaving the vehicle in the parking place pay the charge specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 as appropriate by the insertion in a parking ticket meter relating to that parking place of a coin or coins together making up the amount of the charge so as to purchase a parking ticket or by any other approved method of payment’.
 - (d) The Consolidation Order is varied by the inclusion of clause 10(6), Part II below:

'If at the time when a vehicle is left during the permitted hours in a pay and display parking place and payment has been made by another approved method of payment which resulted in no parking ticket being issued by a parking ticket meter, that vehicle shall be exempt from the requirement to display a parking ticket'.

SCHEDULE ONE – VARIATION OF FLAT IRON CAR PARK

Flat Iron: short stay incremental pricing from 1 hour up to a maximum 2 hours.

Free parking after 1pm Saturday and free parking to continue all day Sunday and Bank Holidays. Customers taking advantage of the free parking may only park for a maximum of 2 hours and must display a time of arrival ticket.

SCHEDULE TWO – VARIATION OF SHORT STAY CAR PARKS

Short Stay: free for up to 1 hour or a charge for up to 3 hours maximum stay.

Free parking after 5pm Monday – Friday, after 1pm on Saturdays and all day Sunday and Bank Holidays.

Car Parks include: Fleet Street, Portland Street, St Mary's and West Street.

SCHEDULE THREE – VARIATION OF LONG STAY CAR PARKS

Long Stay: free for up to 3 hours or a charge for up to 4 hours or all day (8am - 5pm).

Free parking after 5pm Monday – Friday, after 1pm on Saturdays and all day Sunday and Bank Holidays.

Car Parks include: Water Street, Queens Road, Farrington Street, Friday Street, Fleet Street and George Street

Please note the following:-

- (a) Consecutive ticketing will be prohibited
- (b) Tickets are not transferable from car park to car park or vehicle to vehicle
- (c) The Maximum Stay at each car park is set out in the Schedules above
- (d) No return to the same car park within 2 hours

For customers who are taking advantage of the free parking:

- (a) A 'time of arrival' ticket must be obtained where required
- (b) The 'time of arrival' ticket must be displayed where required
- (c) Free parking periods cannot be used to extend stays. If customers wish to park for a duration which exceeds the free period of parking they must purchase a Parking Ticket.
