The County Borough of Conwy (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1997 (Amendment) (No.6) Order 2005

The Conwy County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following order:-

1. this order shall come into force on the 30th day of January, 2006 and may be cited as "The County Borough of Conwy (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1997 (Amendment) (No.6) order 2005".

2. In this order:-

"parking place " means the area of land specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this order provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the Act of 1984.

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place.

"Vehicle" means any motor car or light van, motorcycle, invalid carriage and includes any trailer, boat, caravan or mobile shop, bus or coach.

"operating hours" and "operating days" means the period specified in Column 3 of the said Schedule.

"permit" means a valid, location specific permit issued by the Council and incorporating the name of the parking place.

- 3. The County Borough of Conwy (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1997 is hereby amended to include the parking place specified in the Schedule to this order and the provisions and conditions therein shall apply.
- 4. The parking place specified in Column 1 of the Schedule may be used subject to the provisions hereto:-
 - (c) any vehicle left in the parking place on the days and during the hours specified in Column 3 of that Schedule shall display a valid location specific permit in a conspicuous position as described thereon.
 - (d) any vehicle left in the parking place on the days and during the hours so specified and not displaying a valid location specific permit is committing an offence under the provisions of the Act of 1984 and shall render the person deemed to be in breach or contravention therefore subject to the imposition of a fine or penalty in accordance with the provisions in that regard herein contained or otherwise required.
- 5. The penalty for failing to comply with the above provisions is <u>TWENTY POUNDS</u> (£20) if paid within the first 14 days and <u>FIFTY POUNDS</u> (£50) thereafter which additional charge (hereinafter referred to as the "excess charge") shall be payable.
