

**CONWY COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING  
PLACES ORDER 1997**

The Conwy County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of July, One thousand nine hundred ninety seven and may be cited as "The Conwy County Borough Council (Off-street Parking Places) Order 1997".
2. Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
3. In this Order:-

"driver" means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"owner" means the person by whom the vehicle is kept and used;

"Disabled badge" means a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 as amended by the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 and 1992 or a badge having effect under those Regulations as if it were a disabled person's; and for the purpose of this definition a badge shall be in the relevant position if:

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen, and
- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

"parking place" means any area of land specified in column 1 of schedule 2 provided by the Council under Section 32(1) of the Act of 1984 for use as a parking place; and

"parking bay" means any area of a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place;

"charging hours" means any period specified in column 5 of Schedule 2 in respect of which a charge is specified in column 6;

"cars and light vans" means Motor Car as defined in Section 136(2)(a), motor cycle as defined in Section 135(4) and invalid carriage as defined in Section 136(5) of the Act and motor vehicles not exceeding 30 cwt unladen weight constructed or adapted solely for the purpose of carrying goods.

"buses and coaches" means Passenger Carrying Vehicles as defined in Section 117(1) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981.

"vehicle" includes cars and light vans, buses and coaches and any boat, trailer, caravan or mobile shop.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of parliament and as if for the purposes of Section 21 of that Act this Order were an Act of Parliament.

5. **Use of land and Parking Place:-**

- (i) The area of land specified in column 1 of schedule 2 may be used SUBJECT TO the following provisions of this Order as a parking place for such classes of vehicle in such positions on such days as are specified in relation to that area in the Schedule.
- (ii) Where in schedule 2 a parking bay is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is of the class and in the position specified.
- (iii) Where within a parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for disabled person's vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle.
- (iv) In so far as a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours the driver thereof shall pay such charge or charges as are specified in column 6 of schedule 2.
- (v) Any ticket issued on payment of the charge referred to in Column 6 of schedule 2 shall be displayed in a conspicuous position in the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and a vehicle shall not be left in a parking place if it displays an expired ticket.

- (vi) the driver of any vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting as specified in column 7 of schedule 2 in relation to that parking place.
- (vii) any ticket issued on payment of the appropriate charge will be valid only for the vehicle in respect of which it was purchased.

**6. Amount of initial charge at Parking Places:-**

- (i) The charge shall be payable by the insertion of appropriate coinage, tokens or cards into the apparatus or device provided for the purpose in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Act of 1984 and the provisions of 47(5) shall apply in respect of such apparatus.
- (ii) If no such apparatus is provided in any parking places specified in schedule 2 or such apparatus is defective the appropriate charge shall be payable to a Parking Attendant.
- (iii) The owner of a vehicle resident within Conwy County Borough may on application to the Council purchase a season ticket in respect of that vehicle for a charge ascertained by reference to the charges specified in schedule 1 and that season ticket shall be valid in such parking places and for such periods as are specified thereon during the period for which it was issued.

**7. Amount of excess charge at Parking Places:-**

- (i) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours
  - (a) with no valid parking ticket conspicuously displayed thereon as provided for by Article 5(v), or
  - (b) for longer than any parking period for which payment was made in accordance with Article 5(iv), or
  - (c) parked with additional payment made to extend the stay beyond the expiry time initially purchased.
  - (d) for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting referred to in Article 5(vi).
  - (e) other than wholly within a parking bay.
  - (f) without displaying a valid Vehicle Excise Licence.
  - (g) without displaying a correctly set Disc Clock with the Season Ticket.
  - (h) Underpayment of charge for the class of vehicle.
  - (j) parking a vehicle prohibited from parking in that parking

place or parking bay.

(k) parking for a period in excess of that which the Season Ticket is valid.

(l) displaying a parking ticket previously displayed and/or used on another vehicle.

then the initial charge where appropriate together with an additional amount of **TWENTY POUNDS (£20)** for the first 14 days and **FIFTY POUNDS (£50)** thereafter (which additional amount is hereinafter referred as the "excess charge") shall be payable.

(ii) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which an excess charge has been incurred it shall be the duty of a Parking Attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Notice which shall include the following particulars:-

(a) the registration mark of the vehicle or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;

(b) the Excise Licence serial number;

(c) the time at which he or she first observed that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge had expired;

(d) a statement that the excess charge stipulated is required to be paid;

(e) the manner in which and the time within which the excess charge should be paid; and

(f) a statement that it is an offence under Section 35(4) of the Act of 1984 for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail to pay the excess charge.

(iii) The excess charge shall be paid to Conwy County Borough Council either by cheque, Banker's Draft, money order or postal order which shall be delivered or sent by post to reach the Director of Finance's Department at Bodlondeb, Conwy LL32 8DU not later than 14 days following the day on which the excess charge was incurred or in cash at any of the Council's cash receiving offices.

**8. Period for which vehicle may be left after excess charge incurred:-**

(i) The period for which a vehicle may be left in a parking place

during the charging hours after the excess charge has been incurred shall not exceed 7 days.

- (ii) If a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours for more than 7 days after which the excess charge has been incurred it shall be the duty of a parking attendant to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position a Notice which shall include the following particulars:-
  - (a) the registration mark of the vehicle or where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
  - (b) the time at which he or she first observed that the initial period for which payment was made by the initial charge had expired;
  - (c) a statement that it is an offence under Section 35(4) of the Act of 1984 for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to leave the vehicle therein for longer than 7 days after the excess charge has been incurred.

**9. Restriction on removal of Notices.**

When a Notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver or a person authorised by the driver in that behalf shall remove the Notice from the vehicle.

**10. Other Provisions.**

The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicle Excise and Regulation Act 1994 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1972.

- 11. When a vehicle has left a parking places after waiting therein for the maximum period the driver thereof shall not within 1 hour after its leaving permit it to wait again in that parking place.

- 12. The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in a parking bay and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or about to depart from the parking bay.

- 13. No person shall in a parking place use any threatening abusive or insulting language gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the

peace is likely to be occasioned.

14. (i) No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services nor erect or cause to permit to be erected any tent booth stand building or other structure without the written consent of the County Borough Council.
- (ii) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place:-
  - (a) for sleeping or camping or cooking; or
  - (b) for the purposes of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.
15. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle or is about to depart from the parking place.
16. (i) If a vehicle is left in a parking bay other than in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that it is in accordance with the said provisions.
- (ii) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from the parking place or arrange such removal.
- (iii) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police in uniform or a traffic warden may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking bay or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.
- (iv) Any person altering or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph (i) of this Article or removing or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraph (ii) or (iii) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such a manner as he or she may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed.
- (v) Any person removing or arranging for the removal of a vehicle by virtue of paragraphs (ii) or (iii) of this Article shall make arrangements as he or she considers reasonably necessary for the safety of the vehicle in the place to which it is removed.

17. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of:-

- (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place; or
- (ii) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place;

no person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:-

- (a) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
- (b) in a direction other than so specified.

18. No person shall knowingly exhibit on any vehicle any parking ticket which has been altered, defaced, mutilated or added to or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible.

19. No person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.

20. A vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge and being driven or carrying as a passenger a registered disabled person shall be exempt from any limitation of time specified in column 7 and from any payments specified in column 6 of schedule 2.

21. (i) Nothing in Article 5(i) of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council to close the parking place or any part thereof.

(ii) Without prejudice to the provisions of Article 21(i) the Council shall be entitled to suspend any or all of the provisions of this Order on such occasions and for such periods as they shall think fit.

22. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parking places referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-

- (i) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said parking places.
- (ii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or in land



adjacent to the said parking place, of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supplying of gas, water, or electricity, or of any Telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984.

- (iii) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in the service of a public utility in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
  - (iv) The vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police, ambulance or rescue/breakdown purposes.
  - (v) The vehicle to be used for building, industrial or demolition operations with the written permission of the Council..
23. Failure to perform observe or comply with the above provisions constitute a breach of the provisions of the Act of 1984 before referred to and shall render the person deemed to be in breach or contravention therefore subject to the imposition of a fine or penalty in accordance with the provisions in that regard therein contained or otherwise required.
24. The Aberconwy Borough Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1993 and The Borough of Colwyn (Off Street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1994 are hereby revoked.
25. The property known as Hodeson, 7 Rosehill Street, Conwy is hereby granted a permanent right of vehicular access to the rear of the premises through Vicarage Gardens car park, such access to be marked out accordingly.
