GORCHYMYN BWRDEISTREF SIROL CONWY (CEI CONWY)
(GWAHARDD A CHYFYNGU AR AROS) 2007

Yn unol â'i bwerau dan Adrannau 1 a 2 a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 Deddf Rheoli Trafnidiaeth Ffyrrd 1984 (y cyfeirir ati o hyn ymlaen fel "Deddf 1984"), a'r holl bwerau galluogol eraill, ac ar ôl ymgynghori â Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu, yn unol â Rhan III Atodlen 9 Deddf 1984, y mae Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (y cyfeirir ato o hyn ymlaen fel "y Cyngor") drwy hyn yn gwneud y Gorchymyn canlynol:-

1. Bydd y Gorchymyn hwn yn dod i rym ar y ~~23~~⁶⁰ Orffennaf Dwy fil a saith, a gellir ei ddyfynnu fel "Gorchymyn Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (Cei Conwy) (Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros) 2007."
2. (1) Yn y Gorchymyn hwn:-

mae "safle tacsis awdurdodedig" yn golygu unrhyw ddarn o ffordd gerbydau sydd wedi ei gynnwys oddi mewn neu ei ddynodi gan farc ffordd sy'n cydymffurfio â diagram 1028.2 yn Atodlen 6 Rheoliadau a Chyfarwyddiadau Cyffredinol Trafnidiaeth Ffyrrd 2002;

mae "lle parcio awdurdodedig" yn golygu unrhyw le parcio ar ffordd, sydd wedi ei awdurdodi neu wedi ei ddynodi gan Orchymyn sydd wedi ei wneud dan Ddeddf 1984, neu sydd mewn grym fel pe bai wedi cael ei wneud dan y Ddeddf honno;

mae "arhosfan bysiau" yn golygu unrhyw ddarn o ffordd gerbydau (unrhyw ddarn o ffordd sydd wedi ei nodi mewn unrhyw Erthygl neu Atodlen ar gyfer aros gan fysiau) sydd wedi ei gynnwys oddi mewn neu ei ddynodi gan farc ffordd sy'n cydymffurfio naill ai â diagramau 1025.1, 1025.3 neu 1025.4 Atodlen 6 Rheoliadau Arwyddion Trafnidiaeth a Chyfarwyddiadau Cyffredinol 2002;

mae gan "cerbyd hacni" yr un ystyr ag sydd gan "hackney carriage" yn Adran 38(1) Deddf Cerbydau (Tollau) 1971;

mae gan "bathodyn person gydag anabledd" yr un ystyr ag sydd gan "disabled person's badge" yn Rheoliadau Pobl Gydag Anabledd (Bathodynnau ar gyfer Cerbydau Modur) (Cymru) 2000;

mae gan "disg parcio" yr un ystyr ag sydd gan "parking disc" yn Rheoliad Rhif 8 Rheoliadau Gorchymynion Trafnidiaeth Awdurdodau Lleol (Eithriadau ar gyfer Pobl Gydag Anabledd) (Cymru) 2000;

(2) I bwrvpas y Gorchymyn hwn, ystyri'r bod cerbyd yn arddangos

bathodyn unigolyn gydag anabledd yn y lle perthnasol:

- (a) pan mae'r bathodyn yn ddilys; a
 - (b) (i) pan fo'r bathodyn yn cael ei arddangos ar forden flaen neu banel deialau y cerbyd, neu
 - (ii) pan fo'r bathodyn yn cael ei arddangos mewn lle amlwg ar flaen neu ar ochr fewnol y cerbyd (os nad oes gan y cerbyd forden flaen neu banel deialau), fel bod modd darllen blaen y bathodyn yn glir o'r tu allan i'r cerbyd.
 - (3) I bwrrpas y Gorchymyn hwn, ystyrir bod cerbyd yn arddangos disg parcio yn y lle perthnasol:
 - (a) pan fo'r disg yn cael ei arddangos ar forden flaen neu banel deialau y cerbyd, neu
 - (b) pan fo'r disg yn cael ei arddangos mewn man amlwg ar y cerbyd, os nad oes gan y cerbyd forden flaen neu banel deialau.
 - (4) Ac eithrio lle nodir fel arall, mae unrhyw gyfeiriad yn y Gorchymyn hwn at Erthygl neu Atodlen rifedig yn gyfeiriad at yr Erthygl neu Atodlen sydd â'r rhif hwnnw yn y Gorchymyn hwn.
3. Ac eithrio'r hyn sy'n cael ei ddarparu yn Erthygl 6 y Gorchymyn hwn, ni chaiff neb, oni bai ei fod yn gweithredu dan gyfarwyddyd neu gyda chaniatâd cwnstabl yr heddlu neu wasanaethydd parcio mewn lifrai, achosi na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd aros ar unrhyw adeg ar y darn[au] ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 1 y Gorchymyn hwn.
4. Ac eithrio'r hyn sy'n cael ei ddarparu yn Erthygl 6 y Gorchymyn hwn, ni chaiff unrhyw un, ac eithrio perchnogion cychod sy'n dal trwydded gan Awdurdod yr Harbwr, oni bai ei fod yn gweithredu dan gyfarwyddyd neu gyda chaniatâd cwnstabl yr heddlu neu wasanaethydd parcio mewn lifrai, achosi na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd aros ar y darn[au] ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 2.
- (a) am gyfnod hirach na 60 munud a heb ddychwelyd o fewn 120 munud; neu
 - (b) Os oes llaí na 120 munud ers i gyfnod aros diwethaf (os o gwbl) y cerbyd hwnnw fynd heibio.
5. Ac eithrio'r hyn sy'n cael ei ddarparu yn Erthygl 6 y Gorchymyn hwn, ni chaiff unrhyw un, ac eithrio unigolyn

sydd â bathodyn anabl a disg parcio, oni bai ei fod yn gweithredu dan gyfarwyddyd neu gyda chaniatâd cwnstabl yr heddlu neu wasanaethydd parcio mewn lifrai, achosi na chaniatâu i unrhyw gerbyd aros unrhyw bryd ar y darn[au] o ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 3:-

6. (1) Ni fydd dim yn Erthyglau 3, 4 a 5 o'r Gorchymyn hwn yn ei gwneud yn anghyfreithlon i achosi neu i ganiatâu i unrhyw gerbyd aros ar y darn[au] ffordd y mae'r Erthygl honno'n cyfeirio [ato/atynt], am gyhyd ag y bydd angen:
 - (a) Galluogi unigolyn i fynd i mewn i gerbyd neu ddod allan ohono.
 - (b) Galluogi i nwyddau gael eu llwytho ar y cerbyd neu gael eu dadlwytho oddi arno.
 - (c) Galluogi i'r cerbyd gael ei ddefnyddio (os nad oes modd ei ddefnyddio'n hwylus i bwrrpas o'r fath ar unrhyw ffordd arall) mewn cysylltiad ag unrhyw rai o'r gweithgareddau canlynol, sef:-
 - (i) Gweithrediadau adeiladu, dymchwel neu ddiwydiannol.
 - (ii) Symud unrhyw rwystr i draffig.
 - (iii) Cynnal, gwella neu alladeiladu'r darn[au] ffordd dan sylw.
 - (iv) Gosod, codi, newid neu atgyweirio ar y darn[au] ffordd dan sylw neu dir cyfagos, unrhyw bibell garthffos, neu unrhyw brif bibell neu gyfarpar cyflenwi nwy, dŵr neu drydan, neu unrhyw offer telathrebu fel y maent yn cael eu diffinio yn Neddf Telathrebu 1984.
 - (ch) Galluogi i'r cerbyd gael ei ddefnyddio (os nad oes modd ei ddefnyddio'n hwylus i bwrrpas o'r fath ar unrhyw ffordd arall) at wasanaeth awdurdod lleol neu gwmni gwasanaeth cyhoeddus, yn unol â phwerau neu ddyletswyddau statudol.
 - (d) Cerbyd darparwr gwasanaeth cyffredinol dan Adran 125 Deddf Gwasanaethau Post 2000
 - (dd) Galluogi i'r cerbyd aros ger neu'n agos at unrhyw adeilad sydd wedi ei leoli ar neu ger y darn[au] ffordd

dan sylw am gyhyd ag y bydd angen rhesymol i'r cerbyd hwnnw aros yno mewn cysylltiad ag unrhyw briodas neu angladd.

- (e) Galluogi i'r cerbyd gael ei ddefnyddio at ddibenion y frigâd dân, yr heddlu neu'r gwasanaeth ambiwlans.
- (2) Ni fydd unrhyw beth yn Erthygl 3 y Gorchymyn hwn yn ei gwneud yn anghyfreithlon i achosi neu i ganiatáu i unrhyw gerbyd unigolyn gydag anabledd sy'n arddangos, yn y lle perthnasol, fathodyn unigolyn gydag anabledd a disg parcio (ac mae'r gyrrwr/gyrwraig neu unigolyn arall sydd â gofal am y cerbyd, wedi nodi'r amser y dechreuodd y cyfnod aros) aros ar y darn[au] ffordd y cyfeirir atynt yn yr Erthyglau hynny am gyfnod o ddim mwy na 3 awr (ar yr amod nad oes cyfnod o lai nag 1 awr wedi mynd heibio ers diwedd unrhyw gyfnod blaenorol o aros gan yr un cerbyd ar yr un diwrnod).
7. Diddymir drwy hyn Orchymyn (Cydgrynhof) Gwahardd a Chyfyngu ar Aros a Mannau Parcio ar y Stryd 2006 i'r graddau y mae'n berthnasol i'r cyfyngiadau ar y darn[au] o ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 4 y Gorchymyn hwn yn unig, a bydd yn parhau'n gwbl weithredol.
8. I'r graddau y bo unrhyw un o ddarpariaethau'r Gorchymyn hwn yn croestynnu ag amod sydd wedi ei gynnwys mewn Gorchymyn sydd wedi ei wneud, neu sy'n cael effaith fel pe bai wedi ei wneud dan Ddeddf 1984 ac sy'n bodoli pan ddaw'r Gorchymyn hwn i rym, ac sy'n gosod cyfyngiad neu waharddiad ar gerbydau heblaw bysiau neu fysiau cyflym mewn arhosfan bysiau, neu'n eithrio cyfyngiad neu waharddiad o'r fath, darpariaeth y Gorchymyn hwnnw fydd drechaf.
9. Bydd y gwaharddiadau a'r cyfyngiadau sy'n cael eu gosod gan y Gorchymyn hwn yn ychwanegol at unrhyw gyfyngiad neu amod sy'n cael ei osod gan unrhyw reoliadau sydd wedi eu gwneud dan Ddeddf 1984, neu unrhyw ddeddf arall, ac ni fyddant yn tynnu oddi wrtho.



THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF CONWY (CONWY QUAY) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2007

The Conwy County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 23 day of July Two thousand and seven and may be cited as "The County Borough of Conwy (Conwy Quay) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2007".

2. (1) In this Order:-

"authorised cab rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.2 in Schedule 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"bus stop area" means any area of carriageway in any length of road specified in any Article or Schedule hereto intended for the waiting of buses which is comprised within or indicated by a road marking complying with either diagrams 1025.1, 1025.3, 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"hackney carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act, 1971;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

"parking disc" has the same meaning as in Regulation 8 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, if -

(a) the badge has not ceased to be in force; and

(b) (i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or

(ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle, so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle.

- (3) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a parking disc in the relevant position if:-
- the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle, or
 - where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia the disc is clearly exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle.
- (4) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person other than boat owners who hold a permit issued by the Harbour Authority, shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 -

- for a longer period than 60 minutes with no return within 120 minutes; or
- if a period of less than 120 minutes has elapsed since the termination of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle

5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person, other than a person holding a disabled persons badge and parking disc shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable or parking attendant in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 3 hereto.

6. (1) Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length(s) of road referred to therein for so long as may be

necessary to enable:-

- A person to board or alight from the vehicle.
- Goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
- The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - Building, industrial or demolition operations.
 - The removal of any obstruction to traffic.
 - The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length(s) of road.

- (iv) The laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or in land adjacent to the said length(s) of road, of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supplying of gas, water, or electricity, or of any Telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984.
- (d) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or a public utility company in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (e) The vehicle of a universal service provider under the Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000
- (f) The vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length(s) of road for so long as such waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral.
- (g) The vehicle to be used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.

(2) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began), to wait in the length(s) of road referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same day).

7. The (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and On-Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2006) is hereby revoked insofar only as it relates to the restrictions imposed on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 of this Order and shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

8. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a proviso which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail.

9. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
