CHYMYN BWRDEISTREF SIROL CONWY (MANNAU PARCIO I UNIGOLION
/DAG ANABLEDD) (RHIF 1) 2012 (RHAN 2)

Yn unol â'i bwerau dan Adrannau 1, 2 a 4 a Rhan IV Atodlen 9 Deddf Rheoli Trafnidiaeth Ffyrdd 1984 (y cyfeirir ati wedi hyn fel "Deddf 1984"), a'r holl bwerau galluogi eraill, ac ar ôl ymgynghori â Phrif Swyddog yr Heddlu yn unol â Rhan III Atodlen 9 Deddf 1984, mae Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (y cyfeirir ato wedi hyn fel "y Cyngor") drwy hyn, yn gwneud y Gorchymyn canlynol:-

1. Bydd y Gorchymyn hwn yn dod i rym ar **12 Awst** dwy fil a thair ar ddeg, a gellir cyfeirio ato fel "Gorchymyn Cyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Conwy (Mannau Parcio i Unigolion Gydag Anabledd) (Rhif 1) 2012 (Rhan 2)."

2. (1) Yn y Gorchymyn hwn:-

ystyr "man parcio wedi'i awdurdodi" yw unrhyw le parcio ar ffordd wedi'i hawdurdodi neu ei neilltuo drwy Orchymyn a wnaed, neu sydd â'r un effaith â phetai wedi ei wneud dan Ddeddf 1984;

yr un ystyr sydd i "bathodyn unigolyn gydag anabledd" ag yn Rheoliadau Unigolion Gydag Anabledd (Bathodynnau ar gyfer Cerbydau Modur) (Cymru) 2002;

yr un ystyr sydd i "disg parcio" ag yn Rheoliad 8 Rheoliadau Gorchmylion Trafnidiaeth Awdurdodau Lleol (Eithriadau ar gyfer Unigolion Gydag Anabledd) (Cymru) 2000;

(2) I bwrvpas y Gorchymyn hwn, ystyrir bod cerbyd yn arddangos bathodyn unigolyn gydag anabledd yn y lle perthnasol os:

- (a) yw'r bathodyn yn ddilys; a
- (b)
 - (i) bod y bathodyn yn cael ei arddangos ar forden flaen neu ddangosfwrdd y cerbyd, gan sicrhau y gellir gweld Rhan 1 y bathodyn o ymyl y ffordd, neu
 - (ii) os nad oes gan y cerbyd forden flaen neu ddangosfwrdd, bod y bathodyn yn cael ei arddangos ar ran amlwg o'r cerbyd, gan sicrhau y gellir gweld Rhan 1 y bathodyn o ymyl y ffordd.

(3) I bwrvpas y Gorchymyn hwn, ystyrir bod cerbyd yn arddangos disg parcio yn y lle perthnasol os:

- (a) Caiff y ddisg ei harddangos fel nad yw'n bosibl gweld yr ochr sy'n dangos y chwarter awr pan ddechreuodd y cyfnod aros, o ymyl y palmant.

(4) Ac eithrio lle nodir fel arall, mae unrhyw gyfeiriad yn y Gorchymyn hwn at Erthygl neu Atodlen wedi eu rhifo yn gyfeiriad at yr Erthygl neu Atodlen sydd â'r rhif hwnnw yn y Gorchymyn hwn.

3. Ac eithrio'r hyn a ddarperir yn Erthygl 4 y Gorchymyn hwn, ni chaiff unrhyw un, oni bai ei fod yn gweithredu dan gyfarwyddyd neu gyda chaniatâd cwnstabl heddlu neu Swyddog Gorfodaeth Sifil mewn iwniform, achosi na chaniatáu i unrhyw gerbyd aros ar

,yw adeg ar y darn ffordd a nodir yn Atodlen 1 y Gorchymyn hwn, oni bai bod y cerbyd arddangos bathodyn unigolyn gydag anabledd a thrwydded preswylydd.

4. Ac eithrio'r hyn a ddarperir yn Erthygl 3 y Gorchymyn hwn, ni chaiff unrhyw un, oni bai ei fod yn gweithredu dan gyfarwyddyd neu gyda chaniatâd cwnstabl heddlu neu Swyddog Gorfodaeth Sifil mewn iwniiform, achosi na chaniatâu unrhyw gerbyd aros ar y darn ffordd y cyfeirir atynt yma am gymaint o amser ag sydd ei angen i alluogi:

- (a) i'r cerbyd gael ei ddefnyddio, os na ellir ei ddefnyddio'n hwylus at ddibenion o'r fath ar unrhyw ffordd arall, i wneud y canlynol, sef:
- (i) gweithredoedd adeiladu, diwydiannol neu ddymchwel.
 - (ii) cael gwared ar unrhyw rwystr i drafnidiaeth.
 - (iii) cynnal, gwella neu ail adeiladu'r darnau ffordd y cyfeirir atynt.
 - (iv) gosod, adeiladu, addasu neu drwsio, unrhyw bibell garthffos neu brif biben neu offer ar gyfer darparu nwy, dŵr, trydan neu unrhyw offer telegyfathrebu, fel y caiff ei ddiffinio yn Neddf Telegyfathrebu 1984, ar dir neu dir sy'n gyfagos i'r darnau ffordd y cyfeirir atynt.
- (b) i'r cerbyd gael ei ddefnyddio, os na ellir ei ddefnyddio'n hwylus at ddibenion o'r fath ar unrhyw ffordd arall, at wasanaeth yr awdurdod lleol neu gwmni gwasanaeth cyhoeddus, yn unol â phwerau neu ddyletswyddau statudol.
- (c) cerbyd darparwyr gwasanaeth cyffredinol dan Adran 125 Deddf Gwasanaethau Post 2000.

5. Bydd y gwaharddiadau a'r cyfyngiadau sy'n cael eu gosod dan y Gorchymyn hwn yn ychwanegol at unrhyw gyfyngiad neu amod sy'n cael ei osod dan unrhyw reoliadau sydd wedi eu gwneud dan Ddeddf 1984, neu drwy neu dan unrhyw ddeddf arall, ac ni fydd yn eu dirymu.



**THE COUNTY BOROUGH OF CONWY (DISABLED PERSON'S
PARKING PLACES) (NO. 1) ORDER 2012 (PART 2)**

The Conwy County Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 12 August Two thousand and thirteen and may be cited as "The County Borough of Conwy (Disabled Person's Parking Places)(No.1) Order 2012 (Part 2)".

2. (1) In this Order:-

"authorised parking place" means any parking place on a road authorised or designated by an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

"parking disc" has the same meaning as in Regulation 8 of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Wales) Regulations 2000;

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position, if -

(a) the badge has not ceased to be in force; and

(b) (i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from the kerbside, or
(ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position of the vehicle, so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from the kerbside.

(3) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying a parking disc in the relevant position if:-

(a) the disc is exhibited the side showing the quarter hour during which the period of waiting began is legible from the kerbside.

(4) Except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order unless that vehicle is displaying a valid disabled person's badge and a residents permit.

Save as provided in Articles 3 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable or Civil Enforcement Officer in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations.
 - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic.
 - (iii) The maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths of road.
 - (iv) The laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of road, of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supplying of gas, water, or electricity, or of any Telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act, 1984.
- (b) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or a public utility company in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (c) The vehicle of a universal service provider under Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000

5. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
