The County of Cornwall (Camborne) (Camborne School) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order 2023

THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 32 and 35 of (and Part IV of Schedule 9 to) the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Order shall come into force on the 19th day of Oxober 2023 and may be cited as "The County of Cornwall (Camborne) (Camborne School) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order 2023".
- 2. The County of Cornwall (Camborne) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010 shall have effect as though:

In the First Schedule relating to No waiting at any time:

In paragraph 57 the following was inserted:

57. Rectory Road (U6036)

- (a) north-west side
- (iii) from its junction with Crane Road to a point 1 metre south-west of the north-eastern boundary of No 54
- (b) south-east side
- (iii) from its junction with Tregenna Lane to a point opposite a point 4 metres south-west of the north-eastern boundary of No 54

In paragraph 74 the following was inserted:

74. Tregenna Lane (U6036)

- (a) both sides
- (ii) from a point 4 metres north-west of the northwestern boundary of Crane Court to its junction with Rectory Road/Gwel Tregennow

The following new paragraphs were inserted:

Cranberry Road (U6036)

- (a) north-west side
- (i) from its junction with Crane Road to the southwestern boundary of No 2
- (ii) from a point 3 metres south-west of a point opposite the north-eastern boundary of No 9 to a point 4 metres south-east of the north-eastern gated access to Camborne Science and International Academy

- (iii) from the central gated access to Camborne Science and International Academy to a point opposite the south-western boundary of No 25
- (b) south-east side
- (i) from its junction with Crane Road to a point opposite a point 2 metres south-west of the south-western boundary of No 2
- (ii) from a point 2 metres south-west of the northeastern boundary of No 9 to the north-eastern boundary of No 11
- (iii) from a point 6 metres south-west of the northeastern boundary of No 23 to a point 6 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of No 25

Crane Road (U6036)

- (a) both sides
 from its junction with Rectory Road/Gwel
 Tregennow to a point 11 metres south of the
 northern boundary of No 54 Rectory Road
- (b) east side from a point 3 metres south of the northern boundary of No 8 to a point 7 metres south of the northern boundary of No 10
- (c) west side
- (i) from a point 5 metres south of its junction with Cranfield Road to a point 2 metres north of the northern boundary of No 3
- (ii) from a point 5 metres north of the southern boundary of No 11 to a point opposite a point 1 metre north of the southern boundary of No 14

Cranfield Road (U6036)

- (a) north-west side from its junction with Crane Road to a point 2 metres south-west of the north-eastern boundary of No 2
- (b) south-east side from its junction with Crane Road to a point 4 metres north-east of the south-western boundary of No 1

Gwel Tregennow (Unadopted)

both sides from its junction with Crane Road/Tregenna Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a southwesterly direction Morrab Road (U6036)

- (a) north-west side from a point 7 metres north-east of the southwestern boundary of No 10 to its junction with Crane Road
- (b) south-east side from a point 5 metres south-west of the northwestern boundary of No 15 to its junction with Crane Road

In the Twelfth Schedule relating to Disabled Parking Bay at any time:
