Cornwall Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 (and Part IV of Schedule 9 to) the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

| 7.7 | | No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his or her skill or services: provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle if the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected. |
| 7.8 | 10. | Where any vehicle is standing in the parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 7.4 of this Order a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position shall comply with that provision. |
| 7.9 | | Where a police constable in uniform is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.8 and 7.9 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in the parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall make such arrangements as may be necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle. |
