

**The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Dracaena Avenue)  
(Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order 2019**

THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Section 1 (and Part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November 2020 and may be cited as 'The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Dracaena Avenue) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) Order 2019'.

2. The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010 shall have effect as though:
