THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 (and Part IV of Schedule 9) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1 **Commencement, Citation and Revocation**

- This Order shall come into operation on the 29th day of January 2010 and may be cited as 1.1 "The County of Cornwall (Helston) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010"
- 1.2 The Traffic Regulation Orders specified in Article 9 to this Order are hereby revoked and their provisions are consolidated into this Order.

- apply to any taxi while waiting at a duly authorised taxi rank.

Nothing in Article 3.1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road) provided that such period lies within the period during which the exemption as to loading and unloading specified in paragraph (c) of Article 4 of this Order applies.

Nothing in Article 3.2 of this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge or to an invalid carriage.

Disabled Person's Parking Place

5.1 The area of highway specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this

Order, as a parking place on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area of highway in the said schedule.

No vehicle shall be left at any Disabled Person's Parking Place during the permitted hours unless it displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Persons Badge or is an invalid carriage.

Police Parking Places

The area of highway specified in the Seventh Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area of highway in the said schedule.

No person shall leave any vehicle at any time in a Police Parking Place during the Permitted Hours unless that vehicle is an operational Police vehicle or a vehicle authorised by the police authority to be used by civilian operators operating under the instructions of a chief officer of police.

Street Parking Place

The area of highway specified in the Eighth Schedule to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area of highway in the said schedule.

8.1	Nothing in Articles 5, 6 and 7 shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the streets, by Order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking place.
8.2	The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place in a position other than that specified in relation to that parking place in the Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Schedule to this Order.
8.3	Every vehicle left in a parking place shall stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.
8.4	The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place in a position other than that specified in Article 8.3 to this Order;
8.5	The driver of a vehicle shall not use the parking place -
8.5.1	so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the

when for preventing obstruction of the streets the Council by Order made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, has closed the parking place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place;

The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the parking place.

No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his or her skill or services: provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle if the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

No person shall use any part of the parking place or any vehicle left in the parking place -

- (a) for sleeping or camping purposes;
- (b) for cooking purposes; or
- (c) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.

Where any vehicle is standing in the parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 8.4 of this Order a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position shall comply with that provision.

Where a police constable in uniform is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 8.4, 8.5, 8.6, 8.7, 8.8 and 8.9 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in the parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall make such arrangements as may be necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
