### The County of Cornwall (Padstow) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2009

THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 (and Part IV of Schedule 9) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

#### 1 Commencement, Citation and Revocation

- 1.1 This Order shall come into operation on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 2009 and may be cited as "The County of Cornwall (Padstow) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2009"
- 1.2 The Traffic Regulation Orders specified in Article 8 to this Order are hereby revoked and their provisions are consolidated in this Order.

#### 2 <u>Interpretations</u>

2.1		In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-
	2.1.1	"badges regulations" means the Disabled Persons (badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
	2.1.2	"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
	2.1.3	"disabled person's parking place" means any area of highway described in the Eighth and Ninth Schedules to this Order which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 as appropriate with respect to Article 5 to this Order;
	2.1.4	"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the circumstances prescribed in Regulations 13, 14,15 or 16 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

- 2.1.5 "Driver" in relation to a vehicle left at or waiting in a Parking Place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left at or is waiting at the Parking Place;
- 2.1.6 "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;
- 2.1.7 "invalid carriage" means a vehicle, whether mechanically propelled or not, constructed or adapted for use for the carriage for one person, being a person suffering from some physical defect or disability;

2.1.8	"Loading" and "Unloading" means the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road, to the extent that such goods or merchandise cannot, by reason of size, weight or value, reasonably be conveyed otherwise than by vehicle;		
2.1.9	"Loading Bay" means any area of highway described in the Sixth and Seventh Schedules to this Order which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;		
2.1.10	"parking bay" means a space in the parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;		
2.1.11	"parking place" means any area of highway which is authorised to be used as a parking place under the provisions of this Order;		
2.1.12	"relevant position" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;		
2.1.13	"taxi" and "taxi rank" have the same meanings respectively as in Regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;		
2.1.14	any reference to a length or lengths of road is a reference to a length or lengths of road in Padstow.		
2.2	any reference to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated or re-enacted by, or as having effect by virtue of, any subsequent enactment;		
2.3	The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.		
PART I – RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING AND LOADING			
3	Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading of Vehicles in		

3	Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading of Vehicles in certain roads other than parking places.
3.1	Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait -
3.1.1	at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
3.1.2	between 1 <sup>st</sup> day of march and 31 <sup>st</sup> day of October (both dates inclusive) in the lengths of road specified in the Third Schedule to this Order
3.1.3	between 9am and 6pm 1 <sup>st</sup> day of march and 31 <sup>st</sup> day of October (both dates inclusive) in the lengths of road specified in the Fourth

#### Schedule to this Order

3.2

Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait-

3.2.1

in the length of road specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order -

- (i) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
- (ii) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle in that length of road.

#### **Exemptions from Waiting Restrictions - General**

Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall -

render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable

- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) a vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125 (1) of the Postal Services Act 2000;
- (c) goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle, provided that, except as specified in paragraph (b) above, no vehicle shall so wait at an time in the lengths of road specified in the First Schedule of this Order
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the provision of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications:
- (e) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or
- (f) the vehicle to take in fuel, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road;

apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

apply to any vehicle when the person in control of the vehicle -

(i) is required by law to stop;

- (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or
- (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his or her control.
- apply to any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral; or
- 4.6 apply to any taxi while waiting at a duly authorised taxi rank.
  - Nothing in Article 3.1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road) provided that such period lies within the period during which the exemption as to loading and unloading specified in paragraph (c) of Article 4 of this Order applies.

4.8 Nothing in Article 3.2 of this Order shall apply to any disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge or to an invalid carriage.

#### 5 **Disabled Person's Parking Place**

5.1 The area of highway specified in the Eighth and Ninth Schedules to this Order is authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area of highway in the said schedules.

No vehicle shall be left at any Disabled Person's Parking Place during the permitted hours unless it displays in the relevant position a valid Disabled Persons Badge or is an invalid carriage.

#### Loading Bays

The areas of highway specified in the Sixth and Seventh Schedules to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as Loading Bays for the leaving of (i) such classes of vehicle, in such positions, and for such maximum period, as are specified in Article 7.2 of this Order, and (ii) on such days and during such hours as is specified in the Schedules to this Order.

No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a parking place specified in the Schedule :-

6.2.1 unless it is for the time being engaged in the loading or unloading of goods or merchandise;
6.2.2 unless it is wholly within the limits of the parking place and parallel to the side of the road nearest to the vehicle;
6.2.3 for longer than is necessary to enable goods or merchandise to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle

#### PART IV - RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF PARKING PLACES

7.1	Nothing in Articles 5 and 6 shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the streets, by Order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking place.				
7.2	The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place in a position other than that specified in relation to that parking place in the Sixth, Seventh, Eighth and Ninth Schedules to this Order.				
7.3	Every vehicle left in a parking place shall stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.				
7.4	The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking place in a position other than that specified in Article 7.3 to this Order;				
7.5	The driver of a vehicle shall not use the parking place -				
7.5.1	so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance; or				
7.5.2	when for preventing obstruction of the streets the Council by Order made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, has closed the parking place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place;				
7.6	The driver of a motor vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle or to depart from the parking place.				
7.7	No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the				

No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in the parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his or her skill or services: provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle if the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected.

Where any vehicle is standing in the parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 7.4 of this Order a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position shall comply with that provision.

7.9

Where a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7 and 7.8 of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in the parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall make such arrangements as may be necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
