THE COUNTY OF CORNWALL (TRURO) (VARIOUS STREETS) (LOADING AND POLICE BAYS) ORDER 2010

Cornwall Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32 and 35 of (and Part IV of Schedule 9 to) the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Order shall come into force on the **17th** day of **March 2011** and may be cited as "The County of Cornwall (Truro) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (Loading and Police Bays) Order 2010"
- 2. The County of Cornwall (Truro) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010 shall have effect as though:

In Article 2.1.5 the words "Sixteenth, Seventeenth and Eighteenth" were deleted and replaced with "Sixteenth and Seventeenth"

In Article 2.1.14 the word "Schedule" was deleted and replaced with the following "and Eighteenth Schedules"

In Article 5.1 the words "Sixteenth, Seventeenth and Eighteenth" were deleted and replaced with "Sixteenth and Seventeenth"

In Article 7 relating to Loading Bays the following was deleted and replaced with;

7 <u>Loading Bays</u>

7.1

The areas of highway specified in the Fifteenth and Eighteenth Schedules to this Order are authorised to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as Loading Bays for the leaving of

- (i) such classes of vehicle, in such positions, and for such maximum period, as are specified in Article 7.2 of this Order, and
- (ii) on such days and during such hours as specified in the Schedules to this Order.

In Paragraph 10 relating to Lemon Street in the First Schedule no loading at any time, Paragraphs (a) (ii) and (iii) were deleted and replaced with the following

Lemon Street (U6078)

- (ii) From a point 36 metres south-west of its junction with Boscawen Street for a distance of 19 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- (iii) From a point 66 metres south west of its junction with Boscawen Street to a point opposite its junction with Lemon Quay.

In Paragraph 98 (a) of the Fifth Schedule, No Waiting at any time, Paragraphs (iii) and (v) were deleted and replaced with the following

Lemon Street (iii) From a point 66 metres south west of its junction with (U6078) Boscawen Street to a point 166 metres north-east of its junction with Charles Street.

(v) From a point 36 metres south-west of its junction with

(v) From a point 36 metres south-west of its junction with Boscawen Street for a distance of 19 metres in a south-westerly direction.

In the Fifteenth Schedule - Loading Bay at any time the following was deleted:-

Paragraph 1 (i) and (ii) relating to Boscawen Street; Paragraph 2 relating to Calenick Street; Paragraph 3 relating to Duke Street; Paragraph 5 (i) and (ii) relating to High Cross; Paragraph 8 relating to Little Castle Street; Paragraph 9 relating to New Bridge Street; Paragraph 10 relating to Prince's Street; Paragraph 11 relating to Quay Street; Paragraph 12 relating to River Street and paragraph 13 relating to St.Mary's Street.

Paragraph 7 relating to Lemon Street was deleted and replaced with

Lemon Street (i) north-west side (U6078) from a point 20 metres south-west of its junction with Boscawen Street for a distance of 16 metres in a southwesterly direction.

(ii) From a point 55 metres south-west of its junction with Boscawen Street for a distance of 11 metres in a south-westerly direction.

In the Seventeenth Schedule – the title "Disabled Parking Bay 3 hours no return within 1 hour" is deleted and replaced with the following "Disabled Parking Bay 8am – 6pm 3 hours no return within 1 hour" and Paragraphs 1 and 3 relating to Boscawen Street and King Street were deleted and replaced with the following.

1. Boscawen Street north side

(U6078) from a point 3 metres west of its junction with Duke

Street for a distance of 35 metres in a westerly direction

3. King Street north-east side

(U6078) from a point 24 metres north-west of its junction with

Boscawen Street to a point 23 metres south-east of its

junction with High Cross

The following was inserted into the Seventeenth Schedule

4. High Cross south-west side

(U6078) from a point 50 metres south-east of its junction with

King Street to a point 40 metres north-west of its junction

with St Mary's Street.

The Eighteenth Schedule – Disabled Parking Bay 3 hours no return within 6 hours was deleted.

7.	Prince's Street (U6078)		south-west side from a point 12 metres north-west of its junction with Quay Street for a distance of 20 metres in a north- westerly direction
8.	Quay Street (U6078)		south-west side from a point 24 metres south-east of its junction with Green Street to a point 22 metres north-west of its junction with Morlaix Avenue
9.	River Street (U6078)		south-west side from a point 22 metres north-west of its junction with Victoria Square (north spur to River Street) for a distance of 40 metres in a north-westerly direction

10. St Mary's Street

south-west side (U6078) from its junction with High Cross for a distance of 11

metres in a south-easterly direction

In the Nineteenth Schedule - Police Vehicles Parking Place at any time, the following was added: -

from a point 38 metres west of its junction with Duke Street for (U6078)

a distance of 7 metres in a westerly direction.

King Street north-east side

(U6078) from a point 16 metres south east of its junction with High

Cross for a distance of 7 metres in a south easterly direction.
