

The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) (Part 1) Order 2022

THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into force on the *9th* day of *March* 2023 and may be cited as "The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Amendment) (Part 1) Order 2022".
2. The County of Cornwall (Falmouth) (Various Streets) (On-Street Parking Places and Restrictions on Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 2010 shall have effect as though:
3. Article 3.1.11 was deleted.

In the Fourth Schedule relating to No waiting at any time:

In the paragraph relating to Castle Drive (spur from Falmouth Lodges to Cliff Road) the following was inserted.

Paragraph 2 relating to Cliff Road was deleted.

 - west side
 - from a point 18 metres north of its junction with Cliff Road to a point 10 metres south of its junction with Melvill Road
