The County of Cornwall (Newquay and St Columb) (A3059 & B3276) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Experimental) Order 2022

THE CORNWALL COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of November 2022 for a period not exceeding eighteen months and may be cited as "The County of Cornwall (Newquay and St Columb) (A3059 & B3276) (Restrictions on Waiting) (Experimental) Order 2022".
- 2. Any reference to enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated or re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 3. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -
 - "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme, or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - ii. "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;
 - iii. "loading" and "unloading" means the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of road, to the extent that such goods or merchandise cannot, by reason of size, weight or value, reasonably be conveyed otherwise than by vehicle;
- 4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 5. Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) a vehicle, if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office, to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 65 (1) of the Postal Services Act 2011;
 - (c) a vehicle being used for the purposes of loading or unloading;

- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, cable or apparatus for the provision of gas, water, electricity or telecommunications;
- (e) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (f) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes to wait as long as is reasonably necessary;
- (g) a vehicle to stop if required by law;
- (h) a vehicle to stop in order to avoid an accident;
- (i) a vehicle to stop if it is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside the driver's control; or
- (j) a vehicle which is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on any of the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule to this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
- 6. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any Order previously made or having effect as if it were previously made under the Act of 1984 and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on vehicles or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition then that provision of this Order shall prevail.
- 7. Except where provided by Article 6, the prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise.
- 8. The Head of Highways and Infrastructure at Cornwall Council, or a person authorised by them, may modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it, if it appears to them essential:
 - i. in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic;
 - ii. in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities; or
 - iii. for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs.
