THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, WHITEHAVEN) (CONSOLIDATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2009) VARIATION (NO. 4) (PART FOOTPATH NO. 431043, SALTOM PIT) ORDER 2013

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and (3), 32, 35, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53, 63A and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 19 August 2013 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Whitehaven) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2009) Variation (No.4) (Part Footpath No. 431043, Saltom Pit) Order 2013
- 2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2009 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Whitehaven) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2009.
- 3. The 2009 Order shall have effect as though: -
 - (a) The following was added to the Arrangement of Articles: -

Part IXA – Prohibition of Pedestrians

Articles 42A – 42B General

(b) The following was added as Part IXA: -

PART IXA

PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS

- 42A. No person shall proceed along that section of Footpath No. 431043, Saltom Pit, in the Parish of Whitehaven, from a point at grid reference 296553/517431 (marked Point A on the attached plan), extending in a north-westerly direction to a point at grid reference 296509/517501 (marked Point B on the attached plan), then extending further in a north-westerly direction to a point at grid reference 296486/517572 (marked Point C on the attached plan), before continuing in a southerly then south-westerly direction to terminate at a point at grid reference 296387/517348 (marked Point D on the attached plan plan).
- 42B. The Council is satisfied that for preventing the likelihood of danger arising to persons or other traffic using Footpath No. 431043 it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the Act should not apply in relation to the restriction specified in Article 42A above.
