

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, BARROW-IN-FURNESS)
(CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) VARIATION ORDER (NO.26) 2011

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53, 64 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 24 October 2011 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Barrow-in-Furness) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) Variation Order (No. 26) Order 2011
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2001 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Barrow-in-Furness) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001
3. The 2001 Order shall have effect as though: -

(a) **The following was added as Part VIIA and Articles 38A and 38B: -**

PART VIIA

PROVISION OF PARKING PLACES FOR HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES
OVER 7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT ONLY

- 38A. Save as provided in Article 38B, no person shall except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a heavy commercial vehicle exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight, to wait at any time, on any day, in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in **Schedule XXA** to this Order.

Exemptions

- 38B. Nothing in Article 38A to this Order shall apply so as to render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified therein if the vehicle is:-
- (a) being used by statutory undertakers or their contractors in connection with any building operation or demolition the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) Waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid accidents;

(c) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(d) if the vehicle is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository; or

(e) If the vehicle is being used for other exceptional loading or unloading purposes.

(b) Schedule XXA "Parking Place for Heavy Commercial Vehicles Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Only" to this Order was added as Schedule XXA thereto.

(c) The lengths of road specified in Schedule XXIV to this Order were added as item numbers 2 and 3 to Schedule XXIV "Prohibition of Stopping on School Days 8am-5pm on School Keep Clear Markings" thereto.

(d) The lengths of road specified in Schedule XXXV to this Order were added to Schedule XXXV "20 Mph Speed Limit (At All Times)" thereto.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Schedule XXA

Parking Place for Heavy Commercial Vehicles Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Weight Only

1. Michaelson Road, Barrow-in-Furness, in a central reserve area, from a point 2.4m north of its junction with Farm Street for a distance of 54.4m in a northerly direction.

SCHEDULE XXIV

Prohibition Of Stopping On School Days 8am-5pm On School Keep Clear Markings

- (2) Mill Lane, Barrow-in-Furness, the south-east side from a point 156m south-west of its junction with Promenade for a distance of 42 metres in a south westerly direction.
- (3) Mill Lane, Barrow-in-Furness, the south-east side from a point 220m south-west of its junction with Promenade for a distance of 42 metres in a south westerly direction.

SCHEDULE XXXV

20 mph Speed Limit (At All Times)

Walney, Barrow-in-Furness

Mill Lane (U6225)	From a point 45 metres south-west of its junction with Promenade (U6231/21) for a distance of 312 metres in a south westerly direction.
Saunders Close (U6249)	From its junction with Mill Lane (U6225/01) for its entire length.
