THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, BARROW-IN-FURNESS) (CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) VARIATION ORDER (NO.29) 2013

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53, 64 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- This Order shall come into operation on 11 March 2013 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Barrow-in-Furness) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) Variation Order (No. 29) Order 2013
- For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2001 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Barrow-in-Furness) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001
- 3. The 2001 Order shall have effect as though:
 - the lengths of road specified in Schedule IV to this Order were added as item numbers 179 to 181 inclusive to Schedule IV "Limited Waiting Parking Place, Mon-Sat, 8 am 6 pm, 2 hours no return within 4 hours (Permit holders exempt)";
 - (b) the lengths of road specified in Schedule VII to this Order were added as item numbers 1547 to 1596 to Schedule VII "Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time" thereto;
 - the length of road specified in Schedule XII to this Order was added as item number 15 to Schedule XII "Prohibition of Waiting on School Days, 8.30 am 9.15 am and 2.45 pm 3.45 pm" thereto;
 - (d) the following were added as Articles 60A to 60Q inclusive: -

Prohibition of Driving At Any Time (Except Permit Holders)

- 60A. Save as provided in Articles 60B to 60Q inclusive to this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in **Schedule XXXIIA** to this Order.
- 60B. Nothing in Article 60A to this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed along those roads referred to therein so long as that vehicle is necessarily being used for:-
 - (i) Placing and maintaining in a parking place or in the vicinity of a parking place as appropriate, traffic signs of a size and/or colour and/or type prescribed by or authorised under Section 64 or the 1984 Act indicating that the parking place may be used for parking only by such vehicles as may be authorised to use it by virtue of this Order;

- (ii) to carry out any such work as is or may be reasonably necessary to facilitate the satisfactory operation of any parking place;
- (iii) any building or demolition operations in or adjacent to that part of road;
- (iv) the removal of any obstruction to traffic from that part of road;
- (v) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that part of road;
- (vi) the laying erection alteration or repair in or adjacent to that part of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telegraphic lines or traffic sign or telecommunication apparatus; or
- (vii) market trading purposes and is displaying a valid permit in the relevant position.

Application for Exemption Permit

- 60C. Any resident whose normal residence is in the street specified in column 3 of Schedule XXXIIA to this Order and who is the owner or registered keeper of a vehicle, being either a passenger vehicle, goods vehicle, motor cycle with or without side car attachment, not exceeding 2.28m in height and 5.50m in length, may apply to the Council for the issue of an permit exempting them from the restriction specified in Article 60A to this Order.
- 60D. Any application made in accordance with the foregoing Article shall include such particulars as the Council may from time to time require.
- 60E. The Council may require an applicant for a permit to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in support of their application as may be reasonably required by the Council to verify any particulars or information given to it by the applicant.
- 60F. Any resident who is unable to provide the Council with such information as it may reasonably require in connection with his application may apply to the Council for the issue of a visitors permit under the provisions of Article 60H.
- 60G. Residents permits are not transferable nor do they have any effect outside the street specified on that permit.

Issue of Permits

60H. Upon receipt of an application for a permit made in accordance with Article 60C hereof the Council, upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is either the owner or registered keeper of a vehicle referred to in his application, shall issue a permit for that vehicle to the applicant.

60I. A permit issued under the provisions of Article 60H shall allow the vehicle in respect of which the permit is issued to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule XXXIIA to this Order as the Council shall, at its discretion, think fit for the applicant's needs.

Application for Visitor's Exemption Permits

- 60J. Any resident may apply to the Council for the issue to him of one or more permits for any vehicles belonging to and used by persons visiting that resident being vehicles of the types referred to in Article 60C.
- 60K. An application for a permit under Article 60J shall include such information and particulars as the Council may from time to time require and the Council shall be under no obligation to consider any application which is not made in accordance with the provisions of this article.
- 60L. The Council may at any time require an applicant for a permit under Article 60C to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of their application as the Council may reasonably require in order to verify any information or particulars given to them by the applicant.

Issue of Visitor's Exemption Permits

- 60M. Upon receipt of an application for a permit under Article 60J the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident shall issue a parking permit or permits (as the case may be) for the vehicles referred to in that application to the applicant.
- 60N. A permit issued under the provisions of Article 60H shall allow those vehicles in respect of which the permit was issued to proceed in the length of road specified in Schedule XXXIIA to this Order as the Council shall at its discretion think fit for the needs of the applicant and his visitors.
- 600. The Council may, at its absolute discretion, limit the number of visitors permits to be issued to any particular household at any one time and may require any used visitors permits to be produced and surrendered before any further permits are issued.
- 60P. A visitors permit shall be valid on any particular day or days (as the case may be) if and only if the date in question and the registration mark of the vehicle on which the permit is displayed are shown in such manner as may be required by the Council.
- 60Q. Where an application for a visitors permit is made under Article 60F that application shall be treated as an application under Article 60J save that:-
 - (1) any visitors permit issued pursuant to an application under Article 60F shall only be valid for a maximum period of one month; and

- (2) only one such visitors permit may be issued to any one resident.
- (e) Schedule XXXIIA to this Order was added as Schedule XXXIIA "Prohibition of Driving At Any Time (Except Permit Holders)" thereto;
- (f) The following were added as Article 7(12) thereto: -
 - 7(12) Save as provided in Articles 23(a) to 23(i) inclusive, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, at any time, on any day, in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in **Schedule LHA** to this Order: -
 - (a) for a longer period than 10 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than one hour has elapsed since the termination during the said 10 minutes of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same length of road.
- (g) Schedule LIIA to this Order were added as Schedule LIIA "Limited Waiting Parking Place (At All Times) 10 minutes no return within 1 hour" thereto;
- (h) Article 8 was amended to include reference to Schedule LIIA.
- (i) Article 23 was amended to include reference to Schedules XLIV, XLV, XLVI, IL, L, LI, LII and LIIA.
- (j) Item No. 49 of Schedule II "Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon Sat 8am -6pm 2 hours no return within 2 hours" which relates to Market Street, Daltonin-Furness, was deleted in its entirety.
- (k) Item Nos 100 and 127 of Schedule IV "Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon-Sat 8am 6pm 2 hours no return within 4 hours" which relate to Storey Square and School Street, Barrow-in-Furness, were deleted in their entirety.
- (l) item Nos 162, 675, 837, 909, 1098, 1099, 1100, 1101 of 1250 of Schedule VII "Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time", which relate to Lumley Street, Rawlinson Street, School Street, Channelside, Storey Square and Bessemer Way, Barrow-in-Furness, were deleted in their entirety;
- (m) Item No 8 of Schedule XII "Prohibition of Waiting On School Days 8.30am -9.15am and 2.45pm - 3.45pm" which relates to Stackwood Avenue, Barrow-in-Furness, was deleted in its entirety;
- Item No. 27 of Schedule XXIII "Prohibition of Stopping Mon Fri 8am 5pm On School Keep Clear Markings" which relates to Latona Street,
 Barrow-in-Furness, was deleted in its entirety; and
- (o) Item No. 5 of Schedule XXV "Prohibition of Stopping (At All Times) Except Taxis", which relates to Duke Street, Barrow-in-Furness, was deleted in its entirety.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
