THE CITY OF CARLISLE (CASTLE STREET AND THE GREEN MARKET) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 1987

The Council of the City of Carlisle ("the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972 with the County Council of Cumbria in exercise of the powers conferred on that County Council under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3), 3 (2), 4 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

 In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Vehicle used by disabled person" means a vehicle displaying an orange badge and being properly used under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 or any subsequent amendment.

- 2. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in any road specified in column 1 of the first schedule to this Order to enter the road specified opposite to that road in column 2 of the said first schedule except buses and coaches and vehicles for loading or unloading and vehicles used by disabled persons.
- 3. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding on any road specified in column 1 of the second schedule to this Order to make enter the road specified opposite to that road in column 2 of the said second schedule except buses and coaches and vehicles for loading or unloading
- 4. No person shall cause any vehicle proceeding in any road specified in column 1 of the third schedule to this Order to enter the road specified opposite to that road in column 2 of the said third schedule.
- 5. Nothing in this Order shall apply to anything done upon the direction or with the consent of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden in uniform.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render

- Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to enter in any of the roads referred to in those Articles for so long as may be necessary to:
 - enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to any of the said roads, of any sewer or any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunication code system or with any service provided by means of any such apparatus as defined in the Telecommunication Act 1984;
 - (b) enable any emergency vehicle to enter those sections of the roads referred to in those Articles if that vehicle requires to do so for the purpose of attending any emergency in those roads, i.e. Police, Fire Brigade and Ambulance vehicles.
- 7. This order shall come into operation on the 2nd day of May 1989 and may be cited as "The City of Carlisle (Castle Street and The Green Market) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1989.
