THE CITY OF CARLISLE (BLACKFRIARS STREET) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) ORDER 1979

The Council of the City of Carlisle (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972, with the Council of the County of Cumbria in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967 as so amended, hereby make the following Order:-


- This Order shall come into force on the 29th November 1979 and may be cited as The City of Carlisle (Blackfriars Street) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 1979
- (2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order
- Nothing in Article 2 of the Order shall apply to a vehicle in the following circumstances:-
 - (a) if it is necessary for the purpose of actually delivering or collecting goods or merchandise or loading and unloading the vehicle at premises situate on the length of road
 - (b) if the vehicle is a vehicle used for fire brigade purposes or an ambulance or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or statutory undertaker or a vehicle in the service of a police force in any case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - (c) if it is necessary for the purpose of gaining access to off street garaging at premises situate on the length of road
